

Carol is a seasoned year round resident having many years experience living in our park. Many thanks to Carol for her valuable time and suggestions.

I went to see Karin Desmone, our Office Administrative Assistant, to discuss the possibility of having Area Printing (the company that prints our Telephone Directories) print this booklet. Her assistance was immeasurable! She not only contacted the printer to request quotes, she submitted the idea to Ray Lamoureux, Board President, and our Board Members to approve the funding to have it printed. She and I had several meetings regarding the booklet cover, organization of the sections, and the title of the booklet. We decided that the title cover should be "Golden Acres Past and Present". Thank you, Karin, for all your help in the success of this project!

Going forward this booklet will be distributed to new residents when they receive their interview paperwork, Prospectus, Rules & Regulations, Phone Directory & Newsletter from the office. However, there are also many new residents who haven't received this booklet and also some seasoned residents who may want to look through it as well. Every unit is entitled to a booklet, but please only one booklet per unit. If we run out, we'll order more. It is available at the Office.



Here Vultures Fly

by Rudy Rodrigues

This is the narration of the personal experiences of the author, Rudy Rodrigues, during his ten years of service with the United Nations in Afghanistan, where he was engaged in emergency relief and later rehabilitation programs in close collaboration with the Communist government, the mujahideen, the Taliban, and the post-Taliban government.

The author was responsible for opening the first UNICEF office in Kyrgyzstan soon after the collapse of the Soviet Union in a unique environment and culture. During this time, he was working with a government unfamiliar with the United Nations and its goals and objectives. In addition, the Kyrgyz population was traumatized by this sudden period of transition and uncertainty. A major focus of the author's work was gaining the



confidence of the government in Uzbekistan and to ensure the building of meaningful partnership programs for women and children.

This book also covers the adventures, romance, and thrill of being born and raised in Kenya; serving as an officer in the army; the challenges of working in Papua New Guinea; and having the glorious opportunity of working in the UN in different parts of the world with a multiethnic/multicultural community.

About the Author

Rudy Rodrigues was born and raised in Kenya. He graduated from the Royal Military Academy Sandhurst and the British Army Staff College. He was commissioned and served as an officer in the Kenya Army in both command and staff appointments. Resigning after sixteen years of active service, he then immigrated to Canada with his wife and three children.

Later, Rodrigues was appointed country director of a Canadian NGO in the Sudan, with a mandate to provide leadership, strategic planning and the delivery of UN (WFP) emergency relief supplies to the more than three million starving people displaced by the famine of 1985. He did so using a fleet of 350 cargo vehicles and a staff of over 3,000 people. This trucking operation was later taken over by the UN, and Rodrigues served as its Director.

In 2006 Rodrigues ended his career, and moved from Afghanistan, where he was last working with the United Nations. He retired to Winter Park, Florida where he lives today, and enjoys traveling, writing and spending time with his family, children and grandchildren.
