President's Report

lot has been going on in Golden Acres since the last newsletter. The streets have not been completed to our satisfaction. The repair had to be completely redone in two areas and is still not completed. We are holding payment till everything is completed to our satisfaction.

The tenting of all park buildings is completed, and that project went according to plan. In order to tent the building, we needed to have the Clearwater gas company come and shutoff the gas lines front and back of

the park. It is a safety factor in tenting so if there is a leak the gas does not build up under the tent. The problem started when turning the gas back on. The piping to the front dryers was wrong and we had a gas leak. Also, the piping to the pool heater needed to be changed. In the back-dryer section the tankless water heater to the washer was the wrong type and needed to be changed to an indoor type.

The board decided to check a section of sewer line that we have problems with in the past. It has not been looked at in over ten years. We were being proactive before problem could occur. The line was scoped out with a camera and was found to have blockages all along the line. The Plummer said he did not know why it has not backed up, it was so clogged with tree roots. The line will be water jetted next week as of this writing (November 11th) to get all the roots removed.

The budget meeting will be held on December 4th at 10:00 in the clubhouse. All owners should receive a copy of the proposed budget before the meeting with a ballot and a proxy to fill out or turn it in at the meeting.

Election of the board will be held in February and three positions will be up for election. I am one of those positions and I will not be seeking a position on the board. I have served for twelve years and stepping down to take a break. We need other residents to step forward and submit your name to run for the board.

The board hopes that everyone has a safe trip back to Golden Acres.
