We have only one unit for sale at this time. Two units sold in the last couple of weeks. The virus is not stopping sales. People are coming in every week looking for units. We have more rentals this coming year because they

can't come down and use their places. Karin in the office has a list of people looking to rent next year if you want to rent your unit out.

The board is doing an inspection of units for weed and brushes that are overgrown. A lot of units need attention we still need to keep the park looking nice even with this virus going on. While doing the inspection we checked violations from last spring's inspection that were not completed and turned in to the office.

We still have no functions going on in the park. We are keeping all people at a social distance as much as possible.

The budget meeting is coming up on December 2nd. Please fill out your proxies and get them in the mail. We need 75 proxies to have a quorum at the meeting to be able to vote on next year's budget. We increased monthly maintenance fees by \$5.00 trying to keep our operational account from going in the red due to the money we are not receiving from mortgages since we can't write them anymore.

The board is sending out everything early to give owners more time to return it to Golden Acres. We have two positions opening up on the board of directors. The intent to run must be returned by the end of December along with a resume. The election will be held on February 8th. They will be in the mail this week to give everyone extra time that want to run to get them to the board.

The board hopes everyone is safe and healthy in these trying times.

Those owners who are renting out your unit for the season, please make sure that you request a seasonal rental form from the office. This form must be filled out by the owner and returned to the office. Also, a criminal background check for your tenant must be completed before they take residency. Please request that form from the office. A \$50.00 processing fee is required. Your tenants must be over 55 years of age with no pets and adhere to the Rules & Regulations of the park.

Board Reminders

o cars are to be parked on the street overnight. We need to keep the streets clear in case an emergency vehicle is needed.

No community member should park their car in a neighbor's carport unless they have permission. If the Sheriff is checking on their property, there could be a problem. Many residents enlist the Sheriff's department to check on their property when they are away. If a car is parked there and it has not been permitted, then the Sheriff must inform the owner. This can be alleviated with a phone call or email (preferred) to seek permission to park there. If this is not granted, you <u>must</u> park at the clubhouse and allow your guests to park in your carport even if it's for one night.





Awesome true story: Maizie the Hummingbird

Tuesday evening 8/25/20

DAY 1:

My cat, Abbey, brought me a hummingbird and dropped it on the living room rug. It was crying out mournfully. The cat had ravaged the precious little thing. I didn't see where they encountered each other, or what happened.

I rescued the tiny bird in a towel and told my cat she was a good huntress. I was worried about the wellbeing of the bird, as it was getting dark. I wasn't sure what to do with it, so I

got a soft Micro cloth and put it and the bird in a small box. I wasn't sure if the bird was injured or just stunned, so I covered the box with a dishcloth and kept her inside for the night. I started reading online about hummingbirds; what they eat, where they live, habits, etc. I had no idea.

From my research, I learned it was a female, drank sugar water (I have a hummingbird feeder) and ate small bugs, like mosquitoes, fruit flies, aphids, and small spiders. I tried to feed her sugar water with a dropper, but no luck. I caught a mosquito and a small fly and put them

in the box. She did not touch them.

DAY 2:

She did make it through the night. The next morning, I asked her what her name was, and I heard the name "Maizie". When I uncovered her, she started chirping uncontrollably in a steady, rhythmic chirp. I wasn't sure what she wanted, but I took her outside onto the deck. I sat on the deck bench, tipped the box over on its side to see if she was ready to fly. After a few minutes, she started fluttering, and made it off her towel and onto the deck bench boards. She got wedged between 2 deck boards, then went fluttering until she gyrated herself off the edge to the lawn below. Coincidentally, the cat was right there as she fell, and I jumped over to save her a second time.

"You're not ready to fly yet, Little One, I said. But I see that you like it outdoors, so let's go out in the yard by the picnic table and sit for a while."

Maizie was still chirping uncontrollably. We sat down on the picnic table in the middle of the yard and all of a sudden I noticed several hummingbirds buzzing around us. I wondered if they knew she was in distress. I decided to put her in the grass on her towel, and back away to see what the other birds would do. One female kept buzzing around closer and closer. Finally, she met up with Maizie and started feeding her beak-to-beak. This made me cry. I had worried about what and when to feed her, but clearly this other bird knew. I wondered if this was her Mom, and she was being reunited with her. It was such a sweet moment.

The Mama hummingbird came back again and again, probably seven times and fed Maizie. Finally, she stopped chirping. I guess that meant she was full.

I took her inside and she was quiet. In the evening before dark, she started chirping again, and this time I guessed that she was hungry again. I took her back outside to the same spot by the picnic table. This time I put her on top of the picnic table and sat way down at the other end. Again, the mama bird came and fed her over and over. I was so grateful, and I got video of it.

I did more research. I looked up Wild Animal Rescue sites and called two people who's phone messages said they were at capacity and could not take anyone else. Oh well. I kept looking. That evening, I heard Maize fluttering her wings. I could hear them buzzing inside her little carrier. I guessed she was practicing and getting her strength back. I had moved her to a small shopping bag made of screen so she could see out.

DAY 3:

Similar drill. Took her out to the picnic table, morning, afternoon and evening, offering her hummingbird sugar water from a dropper in between. Again, the mama came and fed her. I was amazed.

That evening I found a gal named Tanya on the animal rescue site who specializes in birds. We talked on the phone, and even though she's 4 1/2 hours away, I learned a lot. She also has a rescue hummingbird that can't be released because it is blind in one eye.

I learned that they sleep heavily at night. Almost like hibernation. It's called Torpor. So, after feeding, I covered her carrier with a dishcloth and made it dark. She was quiet all night. I learned that Maizie is a young adolescent, and that the parents feed and help them until they are independent.

I believe that Maizie will fly again. She is young and resilient. I learned that she might have some neurological issues from getting ravaged by the cat. Tanya said it would just take time. If I continue to see improvement each day, and that is hopeful.

DAY 4:

Today we went out to the picnic table so Maizie could eat breakfast. Again, the Mama hummingbird came and fed her. I went to the pet food store and bought some "flightless fruit ...continued on page 16



flies". (Yes, there is such a thing) They are small, can't fly away, and evidently hummingbirds love them. We will see...

Maizie also went out in the evening, and the mama came, dutifully, to feed her. Maizie seems happiest when she's outside. But without yet being able to fly, I cannot just leave her out on her own. I feel committed to her healing now. Yet feeding her through the Mama is a blessing, but not a timely process. It usually takes at least an hour for her to feel satisfied. She chirps and calls the Mama, and eventually the Mama comes. But the Mama flies around numerous times from tree to tree and whizzes past sometimes without landing. I wonder if she is concerned with my presence, even though I am still and quiet. Finally, she comes in and connects with Maizie, feeding her beak-to-beak. I have learned the sounds they both make. I never knew the sounds of a hummingbird before.

Once Maizie eats, then she starts preening, testing her wings, smacking her lips (beak) and wagging her tail. She seems so happy then.

Tonight, after eating, she just sat on her towel on the picnic table and gazed up at the sky. She knows she's supposed to be up there. I'm guessing she'll make it.

Please pray for her to get well enough to go back to the wild, and to fly with her family.

DAY 5 update: 8/28/20

Maizie slept quietly thru the night. When I pulled the cover off her carrier, she started chirping. She took some hummingbird sugar water from the dropper, which I now call "sweet water". She kept chirping, so I took her out as soon as possible to see if the Mama would come. As soon as we got outside, she stopped. It was if she was just basking in the sun, looking around, preening, getting her wings buzzing without taking off. After about 30 min. she started chirping again. The Mama came and fed her. Each time this happens, I'm astonished and so grateful. She did not eat the fruit flies. So, I am still depending on the Mama to give her protein. She does seem better; more active, busy, and a little sassy. After holding her and watching her flight practice last night, it appears that she has some injury on her left foot and left wing doesn't retract correctly. But her spirit is amazing and determined. This morning I fed her first little bug with the tweezers. She spit it out. Ha Ha Ha

Oh, friends, I am so shocked and saddened to have to share this...

When I arrived home from swimming and grocery shopping today, Maizie was dead in her carrier. No struggle, no signs, no clues.

I am so shocked and saddened. I have been crying most of the afternoon. I took her out to the picnic table and tried to call the Mama to let her know. She didn't come. Then I brought out my laptop and played a loop of a baby hummingbird calling. The Mama came. She did not







land, as Maizie lay lifeless on her towel, but she hovered over and saw her baby. I cried out to her, apologizing out loud.

So many emotions at once: grief, sadness, regret, despair, and embarrassment. I feel like I let all of you who were rooting for her down as well.

I called a couple of friends and cried to them. Then I called Tanya, the bird rehab specialists at "with feathers". Tanya said only 40% of birds in rehab make it. She also said that we didn't know what happened to Maizie before the cat got her. Since she could not fly with me, it's possible that she had not yet learned to fly. Maybe she fell out of the nest, and then the cat found her. Maybe she had broken her leg and wing from the fall. Maybe she had a concussion or internal injuries. We just can't know. Tanya reassured me that I did everything right. That she lived as many days as she did was amazing. Tanya was available to me anytime I reached out to her with questions. I decided to donate to her 501(c)3 nonprofit, "With Feathers Avian Rescue". (also, on FB) Www.withfeathers.org. If you'd like to donate something in Maizie's name, there's a donate button on the first page of the website underneath the owl picture. Maybe support and education will save the next one. Tanya also has a hummingbird who is blind in one eye, so cannot be released back to the wild.

I am sad, but I am also so grateful to have had this experience.

DAY 6:

I said a few prayers out loud and spoke my sorrow into the wind. I picked a leaf from each of the three trees that the mama flew from. I got 3 sweet nectar flowers from the Hosta.

Then I dug a hole directly in front of the picnic table where I fed her every day.

I laid her little body on one of the leaves, put another leaf beside her. I surrounded her with the white nectar flowers. One for her mama; one for me; and one for Maizie. The one for her was not quite open in full bloom yet, just like her. I said everything I could think of to her, to her mama, and to the wind. Then I covered her body with a leaf from the other tree and buried her. I put a purple flower on her grave.

I hope she comes back as my guardian angel. I could use that. I heard that hummingbirds come back every year, and that they never forget the kindness you show. I will miss the opportunity to see her in the years to come. I could've used a friend. It's such a tragic ending and feeling of emptiness. I really thought she was going to make it.

As you can see in the previous videos, she was so happy with herself practicing flying, and being outside enjoying the sun. We are all going to die, so I guess it's good to die happy...

Farewell Maizie. Unforgettable. Life-changing experience. In five days. What a difference a day makes...

I'm sorry. Please forgive me. I love you. Thank you. Debra Farris


