President's Report

The annual Golden Acres budget meeting will be held on Wednesday November 18th in the clubhouse at 10:00 am. A copy of the proposed budget should be mailed out to all shareholders prior to the meeting. The proposed budget includes a five dollar increase in maintenance monthly fees. We have voted every year to partially fund our reserves. We need to keep a close eye on these reserves to make sure we will not be spending the park reserves money to maintain the inter structure of our park.

The palm trees should be trimmed by this newsletter. They seem to have grown faster over this summer than most summers. I was told by many

residents that it was a very wet summer.

The fencing in the whole park is completed. The only part that is not completed and we have not considered installing any is along the culvert by the hobby shop on Third Avenue to San Christopher. Our property line runs down the middle of the culvert and we can't install fencing.

We have two new manufactured homes installed in the park over the summer. These replace some units that were in total disrepair and needed to be replaced.

We are still in the process of upgrading certain parts of our water and sewer lines. Some of the shut off valves were replaced over the summer. The sewer lines in certain sections need to be repaired or replaced in the near future. We still have more work to do on finding water leaks and that will continue when more people return to the park.

As of this writing we still only have two units for sale. The office has people calling every week looking for rentals or to purchase units. These units should not last long on the market.

The board hopes everyone has a safe trip back to Golden Acres.







Moo! Cows may be smarter than you think


hat's the smartest animal you can think of? Dolphins and chimpanzees may spring to mind quickly, but don't neglect one often-overlooked farm animal: the cow.

College students at the University of Sydney (as reported by the Huffington Post) conducted experiments with dairy cows and found that our bovine friends are capable of quickly mastering a maze to find food, and thus may possess better problem-solving skills than previously known.

The cows were tested in a T-shaped maze similar to those used with mice and rats. They learned to follow a sound through the maze to get to their food, with

one of them reaching its goals within the first 20 seconds of the test.

The results suggest that cattle farmers could train cows to obey specific sound signals to come in for milking, producing greater efficiency on dairy farms.



Global warming, not Ice Age, may have killed mammoths

iant wooly mammoths roamed the Earth until about 11,000 years ago, when they abruptly went extinct. For years, scientists theorized that they were killed by the cold temperatures of the last Ice Age. Now some believe the explanation is just the opposite: The extinction event was caused by a sudden warming event known as an interstadial.

> According to research published in the journal Science, DNA studies of ancient animals point to the sudden extinction of many large species in past ages. As more DNA from fossils became available, and carbon dating methods improved, scientists discovered that the wipeouts didn't correspond to the rise of glaciers and cold weather, but rather to periods of rapid global warming.

> > Early humans also contributed to the demise of the mammoths and other large beasts, but the evidence suggests that climate change was a major factor in their extinction—raising concerns about the future of our present environment.

Iving may be the fastest and safest way to travel, but we all have our own preferences and quirks when traveling by air. A survey of more than 1,100 family travelers by ExpertFlyer looked at passenger habits. Their findings included:

- Airline choice. United? American? Southwest? Forty-five percent of participants said that airline mile redemption was a factor in choosing which airline to fly on.
- Storage space. Space is at a premium on most airplanes. Seventy-five percent admitted to "stealing" overhead bin space beyond their authorized allotment.
- Food. In-flight meals aren't the only option if you're hungry. More than one-third of passengers said they bring their own food to eat during flight.
- Complaints. Flying can be stressful. The top complaint: A bad seat or a seat not near companions (35 percent), followed by delays (25 percent), and general discomfort (24 percent).
- Worries. Lost luggage is one thing, but 21 percent of survey participants said that terrorism is their biggest concern when traveling with their families. That was followed by getting lost or separated (19 percent) and crime (19 percent).

Who's drinking all the coffee?

ots of people depend on coffee to get them through the day. According to figures from Gallup, 64 percent of U.S. adults drink at least one cup a day. Some drink more:

- One cup 26 percent
- Two cups 19 percent
- Three cups 8 percent
- Four or more 11 percent
- None 36 percent

Coffee is somewhat more popular with the older generation, with 74 percent of people 55 or older drinking it daily, a habit shared by just 50 percent of the 18-34 crowd. Women drink a little more than men: Sixty-six percent of women report having one or more cups per day, while 62 percent of men say the same. And Caucasians drink more than African-Americans—67 percent to 59 percent.

ilitary Family Appreciation Month. Throughout November, military families serving around the world are honored through a variety of observances and recognized for their commitment and the many contributions they make every day in support of the military and our nation.

National Epilepsy Awareness Month. The Epilepsy Foundation estimates that 65 million people around the world, and 2 million in the U.S., have epilepsy—a neurological condition in which disturbances in the electrical activity of the brain cause seizures.
