President's Report

all is coming fast and it will be time to head south for the winter. Florida has been getting record amounts of rain this summer. The culvert running from Second Avenue to Third Avenue needed to be cleaned out again to handle the large amount of water going through it. We had it cleaned two years ago and it refilled with dirt from the storm water runoff.

We have been having work done on our water piping. We had six valves replaced in the system. We had a problem with the new valves they were the wrong valves installed. We did not realize they were the wrong

valves and had them replaced as soon as we were told. I am very sorry about this mistake and hope we are more aware of what we are buying to be installed in our park. They were only in a couple of weeks so we hired a water testing company to check out our water.

The board received the proposed budget from Progressive Management for 2016. PMI and most of the board proposed a five dollar increase in maintenance fees for next year. We think it is easier on everyone if these increases are small ones every two or three years than having large increases all at once. Since I have lived in the park we have always voted to partially fund our reserves. The difference between fully funded and partially funded is eighty nine dollars a month in maintenance fees per unit. We are still very well off financially but we are trying to stay ahead because our income keeps dropping every year. The board looks at everything we can to lower our cost for basic services like water, sewer, lawn, gas, and other fixed cost. You will be receiving a copy of the proposed budget next month to go over before the meeting on November 18th.

The last time I talked with Jo Ellen we still only have two places for sale. The selling season will start in the next month or so and these two places will sell fast.

I hope everyone is having a safe and happy summer and will see you soon in Golden Acres our winter home.

Joe and Paula Bunevith will be in charge of the dinner and a notice and sign up will be posted on the bulletin board. Hope to see you there.




Fishing this summer had its ups and downs. Some nice Black Bass, and Striped Bass were caught.

What to Bring*

ELECTRONICS

Any device with a rechargeable battery, cell phones, computer towers/CPUs, drives (e.g. hard drives, CD drives), monitors, smart phones, tablets, televisions.

CHEMICALS

Automotive fluids, batteries (household or vehicle), cleaners, cooking oil, fertilizers, fluorescent bulbs and other mercury containing devices, fuels (e.g. gasoline, kerosene), fungicides, herbicides, insecticides, motor oil, paint (latex or oil), paint remover, paint thinner, pesticides, pool chemicals, rechargeable batteries (button or vehicle), smoke detectors, solvents, wood preservatives.

What NOT to Bring

A/C units, alkaline batteries, appliances, biological/infectious waste, camcorders, CD players, copiers, digital cameras, DVD players, empty paint cans, explosives, fax machines, fire extinguishers, garbage, gas cylinders larger than one pound (e.g. propane tanks), GPS units, marine depth finders, medicine, microwave ovens, pagers, portable players (e.g. MP3, iPod), printers, printer/toner cartridges, radioactive waste, radios, stereo equipment, telephones, tires, VCRs, video game players.

How to Package & Transport Chemicals

- 1. Do NOT mix chemicals together or place in dark plastic bags.
- 2. Keep products in original labeled containers if possible.
- 3. Place containers into cardboard boxes. Use crumpled newspaper in boxes to prevent breakage.
- 4. Place leaky containers in CLEAR plastic bags and transport in boxes with newspaper.
- 5. Put boxes in the trunk or in back of vehicle away from passengers.
- 6. Place individual batteries in separate plastic bags or cover terminals with heavy tape to prevent short-circuits.





Spiders On The Move: Land, Air, And Water

If you're afraid of spiders, this may not be good news: Scientists have discovered that some spiders can actually walk or sail across water, allowing them to travel great distances and colonize new areas of the world.

Spiders have long been known to travel by "ballooning"—climbing to the top of a plant or tree and shooting out a strand of web that catches the breeze, pulling them through the air. But what happens when they land on water? Some species of spiders have water-resistant legs that prevent them from sinking beneath the surface. With specialized "dance" routines, the spiders are able to make their way across the water. In addition, they're able to lift their legs to catch the wind, sliding on the surface as if sailing. Some spiders are also able to lift their abdomens like sails and take advantage of air currents to transport themselves.

All this helps spiders move about, allowing them to take their place as predators keeping insect populations in check. How far they can actually travel is still unclear, as is the question of whether salt water affects their mobility. Scientists are continuing to study the spiders to find out if they can literally sail across the ocean.

Black Holes: The Truth Is Out There (Just Hidden)

he universe is full of supermassive black holes, according to findings from NASA's Nuclear Spectroscopic Telescope Array (NuSTAR). But they're not always easy to locate because they're typically found at the center of galaxies, and hidden by clouds of dust and gas.



Astronomers found several of them recently them by analyzing high-energy X-rays at nine locations throughout the universe. The NuSTAR confirmed the existence of five black holes and determined that they're much more active than previously was known, consuming huge amounts of interstellar material and emitting large doses of radiation.

The NuSTAR's readings confirm theories of the presence of black holes throughout the cosmos and help to explain why many of them are obscured from view.

We can judge our progress by the courage of our questions and the depth of our answers, our willingness to embrace what is true rather than what feels good.
