

**President's Report** 



The holidays are over and all the people that went home are returning to Golden Acres. They are returning at the right time as it is getting cold up north this time of the year.

We have elections for the board of directors on February 10th. We will have met the candidates after coffee on January 27th. We have four candidates running for two positions. The ballots with the resumes will be mailed out in a week. It good to see people interested on how our community is run.

The committee for changes to the rules and regulations will be meeting to discuss the proposed updates and to make some of the

present rules easier to understand. We have some rules with a lot of grey areas in them. We want them to be clearer to understand also to bring them up-to-date with the changing times of our community.

We will be starting inspections of each unit in the park. We want to get them done before the end of January to give anyone who receives a letter ample time to complete the violation before they head home for the summer.

We are also going to complete phase two of the water survey. We will be checking all units for internal leaks. We will not have to go into any units to do this as the gage to test for leaks will be on the outside of the unit. The leaks we find we will send out letters informing the owners of the problem and asking when it will be repaired.

The floor in the clubhouse will be cleaned and waxed on Sunday February 21st. The clubhouse will be closed all day Sunday till noontime Monday February 22nd.

The annual board picnic will be held at the clubhouse on March 21st at noontime. We will have a tent set up on First Street with tables and chairs so the clubhouse will not be as congested as it has been in the past two years. The turnout seems to be larger when held at our clubhouse rather than at the park.



Violets will bloom in very cold weather. Seeing their bright petals pop up in the snow is a picture of hope, inspiration and promise. Spring is not far when the violets come to call. The Primrose is included in February birth flower because it's one of the first indications of the approaching of spring. Its name, primrose, is derived from the Latin primus meaning first. Primrose symbolism includes courage because it takes determination to blossom in the face of stark cold conditions. It also takes resourcefulness to be the first to come out in the open. Primrose symbolism also includes renewal, love and devotion.

### The history of Black History Month

We owe much of our greater understanding of black history to Carter G. Woodson. Born to former slaves, Woodson worked hard and against the tide of prejudice to obtain his own education. In earning his doctorate from Harvard, Woodson was disturbed to find that during his studies, history books virtually ignored the black American population. So he decided to take on the challenge of writing black Americans into the history books.

He established the Association for the Study of Negro Life and History (now called the Association for the Study of Afro-American Life and History) in 1915, and a year later founded the widely respected Journal of Negro History. Then in 1926, he launched Negro History Week, the precursor to Black History Month, as an initiative to bring national attention to the contributions of black people throughout American history.

February was chosen as Black History Month for the significant events and people who figured prominently in black American history. For example:

- Feb. 23, 1868: Civil rights leader and co-founder of the NAACP, W.E.B. DuBois, was born.
- Feb. 3, 1870: The 15th Amendment was passed, granting blacks the right to vote.
- Feb. 25, 1870: The first black U.S. senator, Hiram R. Revels (1822-1901), took his oath of office.
- Feb. 12, 1909: The National Association for the Advancement of Colored People was founded by a group of concerned black and white citizens in New York City.
- Feb. 1, 1960: A group of black Greensboro, North Carolina, college students began a sitin at a segregated Woolworth's lunch counter. The event marks a watershed moment in the civil-rights movement.
