Dave is working on a number of projects starting with a new electronic key system for the work shop. He is trying to eliminate having to turn in

Dave is also working on the storm water culvert to get the water to flow out of the park at a faster rate. He is having cement work done to repair washed out areas of the culvert. We will have the final updates to the rules and regulations completed by July and mailed out to all shareholders. The new rules will take effect ninety days after the mailing.

Florida passed a law that requires us to have a vote on the sprinkler system. We need a majority of the shareholders to vote against the sprinkler system that is not needed.

The oak trees were trimmed before I left the park also a tree was planted to replace the oak we cut down. The city of Dunedin required us to plant a certain type of tree to replace the oak.

Teach children or grandchildren this important skill

Problem solving is a skill that's valuable throughout your children's lives, from school to their adult careers. You can teach your children how to tackle any problem they're facing by sharing these steps:

- Identify the problem. This is the most important step, and often the most overlooked. Your child can't solve a problem until he or she can state what it is.
- Come up with a list of solutions. Brainstorm possible solutions, even ones that initially seem farfetched. Just keep the ideas flowing.
- Assess each idea. Now is the time to evaluate the merits of each idea, weighing the pros and cons thoroughly.
- Pick one or two ideas. Have your child pick the top two solutions and give his or her specific reasons for choosing those possible solutions.
- Put the decision into action. Before going forward, talk about possible outcomes. What are the potential obstacles? What help can you expect? How can you avoid traps?
- Evaluate and learn. How did the solution work? What changes need to be made to make it work better? What would your child try the next time?



Coffee may keep you healthy

s drinking coffee good for you? A recent article on The New York Times website linked to a number of different studies touting the positive effects of caffeine on several different health problems. They include:

- Liver damage. A review of data collected by studies of more than 430,000 people found that coffee may lower the risk of cirrhosis of the liver, a disease associated with overindulgence in alcohol (among other causes).
- Tinnitus. Researchers kept track of more than 65,000 women and found that those who drank more than one 8-ounce cup of coffee a day were less likely to suffer from tinnitus, that persistent ringing or buzzing in your ears.



- Auto crashes. A study of truck drivers who routinely work on long hauls found that coffee drinkers (or consumers of other caffeinated drinks) seem 63 percent less likely to be involved in crashes while driving.
- Melanoma. An analysis of health and dietary data involving more than 400,000 people ages 50-71 found that those who drank four or more cups of coffee a day were 20 percent less likely to develop skin cancer. (The researchers cautioned that avoiding exposure to the sun's ultraviolet rays is still the most important way to avoid melanoma.)

The least healthy state, according to the Index, was West Virginia. The Index looks at a variety of factors, including purpose, social relationships, financial stability, community, and physical health.



Get more from your to-do list

to-do list can help you organize your time and energy effectively, but successful people know that it's just a start, not an end in itself. Get the greatest impact from your list by following this advice:

- Start the night before. Instead of making your list in the morning, finish your day by planning tomorrow's work. You'll arrive fresh and ready to tackle your most important tasks right away.
- **Keep it short**. A list of 100 items is intimidating. Limit your to-do lists to tasks that add maximum value to your organization, not routine busywork.
- **Prioritize your tasks.** Don't list items at random. Decide which job to tackle first, second, and third so you don't waste time on less important tasks.
- Categorize your tasks. After you've identified your two or three most important jobs for the day, go through your list and group similar tasks together—answering phone calls and emails, meeting with co-workers, organizing various projects. You'll get more done by not switching between different kinds of tasks all day.
- **Get specific**. Include the results you want, not just the name of the task. "Work on Johnson report" doesn't give you a goal; "Finish Johnson report by 3:30" will help you focus on what you want to achieve.
- Expect the unexpected. No matter how organized you are, interruptions will occur. Build in enough time to deal with them so you're not thrown off by the day-to-day demands of the workplace.

mericans tend to be an impatient bunch. A study by fulfillment software vendor Temando found that 80 percent of U.S. consumers want same-day shipping from retailers, and 61 percent want their purchases shipped out even faster, within three hours.

Retailers haven't responded, at least not yet. The study noted that only 53 percent offer same-day shipping even though 55 percent of buyers indicated they'd be willing to pay for it, and only 20 percent send products within three hours, although 31 percent said they'd be ready to pay for that.

Watch your words when talking to doctors

ommunicating with your doctor is important, but you can overdo it. From the Prevention.com website comes this lists of things doctors don't want to hear from their patients:

• "I'm sure I have ____." Researching your symptoms online is fine, but most doctors want to diagnose illnesses themselves. Don't walk into the doctor's office insisting you know what's wrong.

• "It's probably just stress." Writing off your problems to stress might keep you from fully describing what's going on. Be ready to tell your doctor all your symptoms so he or she can get a clear idea of your illness.



- "Haven't you heard of this new drug?" Doctors are busy people who don't have time to keep up with every new medication, no matter how hard they try. Don't insist that your doctor prescribe something you saw on TV, but do print out articles that might be helpful in treating your illness.
- "You're supposed to be the expert." Again, doctors are human, and they sometimes miss things. Have realistic expectations, and talk openly about your needs so the doctor can make an informed decision.




