President's Report

he election of board members is on tomorrow and the newsletter has to be in today. I wish to thank all the four people that have placed their names on the ballot for showing interest in how our community is run. Without people stepping forward we would not be able to function as an association. I would like to thank Don Webb and Joe Lemon for their three years of service on the board of directors. We lost one of our board members last month. We as a board will miss him rest in peace Skip.

This is the time of the year we have a lot of projects going on in the park. We are looking at oak trees to trim and one big oak to be removed.

Also looking at planting more palm trees to replace some of the holly trees removed.

We are still moving forward with our water project. We need to replace four of our isolation valves that are not working properly. We need to schedule time with the Plummer to get them changed. We also did a water survey on each unit and found some with leaks. We need to go back and check on the progress of fixing these leaks. The water bills are still dropping compared to the bills we received last year.

We did a sewer line survey on two sections of the park. They have tree roots in the pipe and will be removed as soon as the plumber can get to them. We will need to think about replacing this line in the near future. It will be a major project to get this done because of all the trees in the areas.

The inspection of each unit was completed last week. We need to do this inspection to keep our community looking great. The people that come into the office looking to buy say we are the best kept park around the area. We have very few units that go on the market for more than a month and we have a waiting list of preapproved buyers looking for certain types of units. If you get a letter on some problem please try to let us know at the office when it will be completed.

The ancient Romans insisted that all wars cease during the time of celebration between the old and new years. Since March was the first month of the new year in ancient Rome, some historians believe the Romans named March after Mars, the Roman god of war.

The birthstone of March is aquamarine, derived from the Latin word aqua, meaning water, and marina, meaning the sea. This gemstone was believed to protect sailors, as well as to guarantee a safe voyage. The serene color of aquamarine is said to cool the temper, allowing the wearer to remain calm and levelheaded. The second birthstone for March is bloodstone, a dark-green jasper flecked with vivid red spots of iron oxide. This ancient stone was used by the Babylonians to make seals and amulets and was believed to have healing powers — especially for blood disorders. It is sometimes called the martyr's stone as legend tells that it was created when drops of Christ's blood stained some jasper at the foot of the cross.

The birth flower of March is daffodil (also known as Jonquil or Narcissus), meaning spring, rebirth, domestic happiness, and vanity. The colors of the bloom include white, yellow and orange.

Within this newsletter are articles and pictures from some of our residents, including an article and picture from Fraser Muir who has been awarded a Knight of the National Order of the Legion of Honour, France's Highest National Order. Congratulations to Fraser for his involvement in the liberation of France during WWII! Pointers on Making Extra Payments on Your Loan from the PMI Controller
In the Promissory Note/Collateral Pledge Agreement and Assignment of Occupancy
Rights, which is the document you all receive with your loan payments at closing, it
states:

Prepayments of Principal may be made without penalty under the following terms:

- A. Prepayments may only be made in increments of ONE THOUSAND AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$1,000.00).
 - B. Prepayments may be made not more frequently than one (1) per month.
 - **1. Prepayments of Principal require special handling.** Do not send Principal Prepayments to the same address you send your regular maintenance. *Do not include Principal Prepayments with your monthly regular fee.* **Principal Prepayments** must be made by *separate check*, noted as "Principal Prepayment" and mailed to the Property Management firm as follows:





This is France's highest National Order and was created by Napoleon Bonaparte on May 19, 1802 as a general military and civil order of merit.


Although it took 70 years to happen Fraser was still honoured and pleased to receive this award. However, he added that he was saddened being the only member of his

We accomplish the latter through strictly legal and non-violent means.

To those of you who are currently serving and fighting for the freedoms of others, at home and abroad, please know that we are backing you. We honor and support you with every mission we carry out and we are praying for a sage return home for all.

The PGR will stand a flag line for all our military, veterans and those that have been killed in action. It is a dedicated group of volunteers that show dignity, honor, and respect in all kinds of weather. Rain, snow, cold, heat makes no difference, if invited to stand for a veteran, we will be there. The Patriot Guard Riders have a national website that you can check for more information and that is www.patriotguard.org. The site describes the missions, how to join, and who to contact if you would like to have them honor a loved one. They will stand for any veteran from any branch with dignity, honor and respect.




