#### Did you know that December is also...

**Buckwheat Month**. Buckwheat has been providing essential nutrients, vitamins, energy, and fiber to humanity for approximately 8,000 years. It contains higher levels of zinc, copper, and manganese than other cereal grains, as well as high levels of zinc, copper, and potassium. From pancakes to soba noodles to blintzes, try adding some more buckwheat to your diet.

**National Impaired Driving Prevention Month**. The month of December is one of the busiest on the nation's roadways, and also one of the most dangerous. Sponsored by Mothers Against Drunk Driving, this month-long event seeks to raise awareness about the consequences of driving under the influence of alcohol and drugs.



**National Safe Toys and Gifts Month**. Keep your family safe during the holidays by buying only toys you can trust. Remember to immediately discard plastic wrapping or other packaging before they become dangerous playthings, and keep toys appropriate for older children away from younger siblings.

**Universal Human Rights Month**. A commemoration of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights, adopted by the General Assembly of the United Nations on Dec. 10, 1948. The need for this document grew out of the human tragedy of World War II and represents the first global expression of human rights.

**National Handwashing Awareness Week, Dec. 6-12**. Fight disease during the winter and all year long by remembering these principles of hand awareness: Wash your hands when they are dirty and before eating; don't cough or sneeze into your hands; and don't put your fingers into your eyes, nose, or mouth.

**Hanukkah, Dec. 6-14**. Beginning at sundown, this eight-day festival in the Jewish faith celebrates the triumph of light over darkness and the rededication of the Holy Temple (the Second Temple) in Jerusalem.



**Computer Science Education Week, Dec. 7-13**. Computer science opens doors for students. Learning even the basics will help in virtually any career. Just as we teach schoolchildren how electricity works, every 21st-century student should have a chance to learn what computers do and how they do it.

**Kwanzaa, Dec. 26-Jan. 1**. A celebration honoring African heritage and African-American culture, culminating in a feast and gift-giving. Created by Maulana Karenga, Kwanzaa was first celebrated in 1966–67.

#### **NEA: Fewer Americans enjoy the arts in person**

When was the last time you went to the symphony, the ballet, or a museum? A National Endowment for the Arts study points to a disturbing trend: The number of Americans attending core arts events like the opera, the theater, and other activities is on the decline.

According to "A Decade of Arts Engagement: Findings From the Survey of Public Participation in the Arts, 2002–2012," only 33.4 percent of U.S. adults attended any arts events between July 2011 and July 2012—down from 34.6 percent in 2008, and down yet again from a decade earlier when the figure was 39.4 percent.

One bright spot in the report: Although only a third of U.S. adults attended a cultural event in person, 71 percent said they had watched, listened to, or downloaded some kind of artistic event via the Internet. That includes streaming pop music, however, lumping Beethoven in with Nicki Minaj.



#### Americans upbeat about science





espite controversies and disagreements about climate change, genetically modified foods, animal testing, and other scientific issues, most U.S. citizens have a positive view of science and scientists, according to a study from the Pew Research Center.



The study found that 79 percent of U.S. adults believe science has made their lives better, and a majority of them have a positive view of science's impact on such matters as food quality, health care, and the environment. Additionally, 61 percent believe that government investment is essential to scientific progress, although 34 percent say that

private investment would be sufficient.

The effort to understand the universe is one of the very few things that lifts human life a little above the level of farce, and gives it some of the grace of tragedy.

#### Get on pace for a healthy new year


