



The history of Black History Month

Woodson. Born to former slaves, Woodson worked hard and against the tide of prejudice to obtain his own education. In earning his doctorate from Harvard, Woodson was disturbed to find that during his studies, history books virtually ignored the black American population. So he decided to take on the challenge of writing black Americans into the history books.

He established the Association for the Study of Negro Life and History (now called the Association for the Study of Afro-American Life and History) in 1915, and a year later founded the widely respected Journal of Negro History. Then in 1926, he launched Negro History Week, the precursor to Black History Month, as an initiative to bring national attention to the contributions of black people throughout American history.

February was chosen as Black History Month for the significant events and people who figured prominently in black American history. For example:

- Feb. 23, 1868: Civil rights leader and co-founder of the NAACP, W.E.B. DuBois, was born.
- Feb. 3, 1870: The 15th Amendment was passed, granting blacks the right to vote.
- Feb. 25, 1870: The first black U.S. senator, Hiram R. Revels (1822-1901), took his oath of office.
- Feb. 12, 1909: The National Association for the Advancement of Colored People was founded by a group of concerned black and white citizens in New York City.
- Feb. 1, 1960: A group of black Greensboro, North Carolina, college students began a sitin at a segregated Woolworth's lunch counter. The event marks a watershed moment in the civil-rights movement.

Valentine's Day doesn't have to break the bank

ooking for something to do with your sweetheart on Valentine's Day that's not too expensive? Try these ideas:

- Read a story together. Buy two copies of your favorite book or story (or borrow them from your library) and spend the evening discussing it. You may both learn things you didn't know about the story (and each other).
- Team up on a new recipe. Instead of going out to a restaurant, delve into your cookbooks and find a meal to collaborate on. Choose something different and challenging, and enjoy the results.
- Visit a museum. Your town probably has a museum (or two) that you've never been to. Or a landmark you haven't seen yet. Select someplace new and check it out together.

Cold weather dangers to watch for.

inter is far from over, and that means staying safe in cold weather is still important. Remember these tips for getting by until spring:

- Frostbite. Frostbite can occur in a short amount of time, especially with children. They can lose body heat quickly, sometimes in as little as 20 minutes. Dress kids warmly, but don't over bundle them, which can cause sweating and speed the loss of body heat. Also, discourage kids from eating snow, since it lowers body temperature, which can decrease resistance to frostbite.
- Carbon monoxide. Check your furnace and other heating appliances to make sure they aren't creating a danger to your co-workers or family. Carbon monoxide poisoning is often mistaken for the flu. The symptoms include achiness, headache, and nausea. Carbon monoxide is odorless and colorless, and it can affect children before it affects adults.
- Vehicles. We all know to walk carefully on icy roads and sidewalks during winter. But
  injuries can also stem from sliding and skidding vehicles that may not be able to stop
  before hitting someone. Be sure to walk in bright or reflective clothing, and be careful
  when walking near snow piles and drifts that may obscure your view or the view of a
  driver.

#### **Expect to win**

In 1974, Notre Dame's basketball team faced the national championship team from UCLA in a game that everyone expected Notre Dame to lose. According to motivational guru Zig Ziglar in his book, Success for Dummies (IDG Books Worldwide), Notre Dame coach Digger Phelps decided that his team was going to win.

The game was scheduled for Saturday afternoon. At the end of Monday's practice, he told his players to cut the nets from each basket. In basketball, cutting down the nets is a celebration of victory. After Tuesday's practice, he again told the players to cut down the nets, and every day after that. By Friday, they were cutting the nets down with confidence and enthusiasm.

And on Saturday, Phelps' team was able to cut down the nets for real, after beating UCLA in the game that Notre Dame was certain to lose. Although cutting down the nets alone didn't ensure the victory, it did get the players into a positive mindset. By the end of the week they expected to win, and so they did.






#### **Self-employment supports the U.S. economy**

elf-employment is alive and well in the U.S., according to a Pew Research Center analysis of Census Bureau data. Ten percent of Americans workers—14.6 million people—reported being self-employed in 2014, and another 20 percent (29.4 million) said they worked for self-employed bosses.

Although the self-employed do hire others, their hiring is on a smaller scale, with only 1 in 4 having any paid employees: a median of 3 people, and an average of 8.6.



The Pew statistics show that self-employment plays a vital role in the U.S. economy: Eighty-one percent of people in the agriculture, forestry, and fishing industries were either self-employed in 2014 or worked for someone who was, along with 68 percent of workers in the construction field, and 53 percent of those in professional and business services.

#### **Technology taking over the college classroom**

ollege students used to invest in pens, pencils, notebooks, and maybe a pocket calculator before going to class. That's so 20th century. These days 81 percent use a mobile device like a smartphone or a tablet computer to do their studying, according to research by McGraw-Hill Education and Hanover Research.

Smartphones in particular are becoming the tool of choice, with 51 percent of students now using them for study, up from 36 percent in 2013. In general, 77 percent of college students say that technology has helped improve their grades, and 48 percent feel they save time with it.

#### Reduce stress with these simple steps

tress can undercut your effectiveness at work. Every job has less than enjoyable moments, but when you start feeling ready to burst, put some of these techniques into action:

- Take a 15-minute break. Once a day, spend 15 minutes relaxing. Try meditation, a quick walk, or some inspirational reading. Don't think about your problems, just immerse yourself in the activity. You'll feel better when you get back to work.
- Learn to say no. You probably can't turn down orders from your boss, but you can take more control of your time by not letting co-workers bury you with requests. Help out as much as you can, but let people know—politely—that you've got to stick to priorities. You'll avoid being overwhelmed by extraneous tasks.

How TB changed our culture




