





## **Robots taking our jobs? Maybe not**

The robots are coming. Surprisingly, even though they're replacing workers in many areas, they may not be driving down the number of jobs humans do.

A survey of more than 2,000 HR and hiring pros conducted by CareerBuilder and Economic Modeling Specialists found 21 percent of employers overall (and 30 percent of those with more than 500 people in their workforce) had automated at least some jobs. However, 68 percent of the employers said that adopting new technologies had resulted in new positions being added to their organizations, and 35 percent said they had ended up hiring more people. And 35 percent of organizations that replaced workers with machines said they ultimately hired people back because the technology didn't produce the results needed.
