

The first notice of the Annual Meeting to be held on February 20, 2018 will be mailed or distributed to all shareholders on or before December 22, 2017. This notice describes the procedure to be followed in qualifying to run for the Board of Directors. At that Annual Meeting it will be necessary to elect two directors to our Board. The terms of Mike Sorenson and Don Kuzmickas will expire in February, 2018. Jim Alaimo will remain on the board for one more year as his term will expire in February 2019. Paul Carter and Dennis Dufault will remain on the board for two more years as their terms will expire in February 2020.



Recycling on Wednesday

To plastic bags please!

Aluminum Cans – Empty aluminum cans used for drinks or food. Rinse and crush if possible.

Cartons – Empty gable-top beverage containers such as milk, half and half or orange juice cartons. Rinse and crush if possible.

Glass – Empty glass bottles or jars (all colors). Labels okay. No caps or lids.

Mixed Paper – Any clean, dry paper item that tears, such as white or colored paper, shredded paper, office paper, magazines, catalogs, phone books, junk mail, envelopes, wrapping paper, or paperboard items such as cereal boxes. No paper towels or tissues.

Newspapers – Clean and dry newspapers (including inserts). No string or twine. It's okay

to put the news-papers inside a paper bag.

Plastic Bottles - Empty bottles such as water, soda or mouthwash bottles. Rinse and crush if

possible. No need to check for a number—just "check for a neck" (i.e., an opening smaller than the base). Bottles only; no tubs, cups or bags. Labels okay. Caps okay but remove the cap from the bottle so that liquids dry out. Place the cap and the bottle in the bin.

Steel (Tin) Cans – Empty steel cans used for food such as soup cans. Labels and lids okay. No paint cans. Aerosol cans okay. Rinse if possible.

Per Golden Gate Rules and Regulations...

14. PETS: The following Rules are specific to residents / pet owners of Golden Gate Community; and have been listed to reinforce the Pinellas Park Animal Control Laws. Residents may call the town hall or look on the Internet to obtain a complete list of the Pinellas Park Animal Control Laws. The Internet address is http://pinellas-park.com/ in the center of the page, click on Code of Ordinances, scroll on the left and click on Chapter 5 Animals and fowl. Only one pet per household. No pets weighting over 20 pounds are permitted. The feeding of non-domesticated animals or birds or roaming cats and dogs



is not permitted on Association grounds. City ordinance requires that dogs and cats be licensed and leashed. No animal shall roam the Community at large. At large shall be deemed to be "at large" when it is off the property of its owner, and not under control of a competent person. Roaming dogs, cats or other non-domesticated animals should be reported to Animal Control. Pets may not be tied unattended outside of residents' home at any time. Pets brought into Golden Gate Community with guest must follow the community pet rules already in effect.

Book Recommendation:

Here Vultures Fly

by Rudy Rodrigues

This is the narration of the personal experiences of the author, Rudy Rodrigues, during his ten years of service with the United Nations in Afghanistan, where he was engaged in emergency relief and later rehabilitation programs in close collaboration with the Communist government, the mujahideen, the Taliban, and the post-Taliban government.

The author was responsible for opening the first UNICEF office in Kyrgyzstan soon after the collapse of the Soviet Union in a unique environment and culture. During this time, he was working with a government unfamiliar with the United Nations and its goals and objectives. In addition, the Kyrgyz population was traumatized by this sudden period of transition and uncertainty. A major focus of the author's work was gaining the



confidence of the government in Uzbekistan and to ensure the building of meaningful partnership programs for women and children.

This book also covers the adventures, romance, and thrill of being born and raised in Kenya; serving as an officer in the army; the challenges of working in Papua New Guinea; and having the glorious opportunity of working in the UN in different parts of the world with a multiethnic/multicultural community.

About the Author

Rudy Rodrigues was born and raised in Kenya. He graduated from the Royal Military Academy Sandhurst and the British Army Staff College. He was commissioned and served as an officer in the Kenya Army in both command and staff appointments. Resigning after sixteen years of active service, he then immigrated to Canada with his wife and three children.

Later, Rodrigues was appointed country director of a Canadian NGO in the Sudan, with a mandate to provide leadership, strategic planning and the delivery of UN (WFP) emergency relief supplies to the more than three million starving people displaced by the famine of 1985. He did so using a fleet of 350 cargo vehicles and a staff of over 3,000 people. This trucking operation was later taken over by the UN, and Rodrigues served as its Director.

In 2006 Rodrigues ended his career, and moved from Afghanistan, where he was last working with the United Nations. He retired to Winter Park, Florida where he lives today, and enjoys traveling, writing and spending time with his family, children and grandchildren.
