t the Board of Directors meeting held on January 15, 2019, there were 12 shareholders present. Our financial report for the month of December 2018 shows that income for the month was \$35,594 with expenditures of \$27,041. The financial statement for each month is posted on the bulletin board at the rear of the hall for everyone to review. At this meeting the Board approve the purchase of 25 new Palm trees and the trimming of the existing Palms trees in the park. The Board also approved to reinvest CD with Freedom Bank and CD with Ameribank. The board also approved the installation of 5 5 new street lights on existing poles at the end of 82nd Ave. The Board also approve the increase of mileage rate to \$.58 effective Jan. 1, 2019.

Running for the Board of Directors

The first notice of the Annual Meeting to be held on February 19, 2019 was mailed or distributed to all shareholders on or before December 12, 2018. This notice describes the procedure to be followed in qualifying to run for the Board of Directors. At that Annual Meeting, it will be necessary to elect three directors to our Board. The term of Jim Alaimo will expire in February, 2019. The remaining terms (2 years) of Don Kuzmickas and Dolores Hathaway will expire in February 2021 but are currently vacant and new Directors must be voting in. Paul Carter & M. Dennis Dufault will remain on the board for one more year as their terms will expire in February 2020.

Important: Your notice of intent to run must be back to the office on or before January 12th, 2019 to be eligible.

Safety & Security

"Remove It!!" "Lock It!!" or "Lose It!!" This is a new campaign to all Pinellas County residents to lock your vehicles. There have been a rash of burglaries to unlocked vehicles. Officers will be using notices on vehicles to instill upon the citizens to lock their vehicles so they won't become a victim.

House Numbers

Just a reminder, while driving around the community there were several homes that did not have the street numbers visible from the street. This could be a problem should Pinellas Park Statutes mandates that all homes MUST have their street numbers Visible from the street.

Parking Request

Whenever you, your guests, or contractors need to park out on the street, please follow Community Rules!

- No parking on the sidewalks. Your maintenance fees pay for all repairs.
- Please use common sense and do not park near or on corners or close to intersections. We would encourage parking on the same side of the street to avoid traffic having to "zig-zag" to get by. This causes obstructions and creates a dangerous situation for cars, golf carts and bicycles trying to proceed by the vehicles.

"Tis The Season"

Just a reminder that once Pinellas County swells with our welcome "snow-birds" criminals use this increase in population to their advantage to increase petty theft and vandalism. It is wise to always keep your home and vehicle doors locked and lock up your bikes, trikes, tools and sheds even when you are home. As always, please remember there is no soliciting allowed in our Community and you should call the Police dispatch number 369-7864 to report all solicitors. Never invite them in to your home.

If you identify a maintenance item around the Community, please ask someone in the office (Jane or a member of the board) to complete a work order for Lam or Les. This allows them to track, prioritize and complete their daily work load. Thank you!

Please remember that bicycles are vehicles and must obey all traffic laws including stopping at all stop signs. This applies to residents and visitors.

If you are returning to the Community after being gone for the summer, please put a note on the outside of your box stating you are back. Also, please remove sticker dot from your box. Thank you.

Recycling on Wednesday

Aluminum Cans – Empty aluminum cans used for drinks or food. Rinse and crush if possible.

Cartons – Empty gable-top beverage containers such as milk, half and half or orange juice cartons. Rinse and crush if possible.

Glass – Empty glass bottles or jars (all colors). Labels okay. No caps or lids.

Mixed Paper – Any clean, dry paper item that tears, such as white or colored paper, shredded paper, office paper, magazines, catalogs, phone books, junk mail, envelopes, wrapping paper, or paperboard items such as cereal boxes. No paper towels or tissues.

Newspapers – Clean and dry newspapers (including inserts). No string or twine. It's okay to put the news¬papers inside a paper bag.

Plastic Bottles – Empty bottles such as water, soda or mouthwash bottles. Rinse and crush if possible. No need to check for a number—just "check for a neck" (i.e., an opening smaller than the base). Bottles only; no tubs, cups or bags. Labels okay. Caps okay but remove the cap from the bottle so that liquids dry out. Place the cap and the bottle in the bin.

Steel (Tin) Cans – Empty steel cans used for food such as soup cans. Labels and lids okay. No paint cans. Aerosol cans okay. Rinse if possible

Many Americans still worried about their finances

The stock market may be up, but many Americans are still struggling with financial security, according to a story on the USA Today website. A September 2018 Bankrate. com survey found that among people earning less than \$30,000 a year, 78 percent said that their financial situation has failed to improve over the past two years, and many said it had gotten worse. On the other hand, people earning \$75,000 a year or more reported feeling better about their money.

The survey found other divides as well. People 65 and older reported the least financial improvement, and millennials ages 28–37 felt the most improvement. In addition, men reported doing better in earlier years than women did.

Coffee still in demand

National Coffee Drinking Trends report says that the number of Americans who drank coffee in the past day is the highest it's been in six years.



According to the report, based on a study of more than 2,700 adults 18 or older, 64 percent said they drank coffee within the past day, the highest amount since 2012. This is higher than the growth from 57 percent in 2016 to 62 percent in 2017. The study also found that past-day consumption traditional coffee, defined as "regular coffee" brewed from "gourmet quality" beans, held steady over the previous years, at 16 percent. Similarly, consumption of espresso-based drinks held steady from 2017, at 24 percent.

Try these tips for healthy eating habits

If you've already slipped off your New Year's diet, it's not too late to get back on track. Just follow these tips for healthy weight loss from the Harvard Health Publishing website:

- Make a list. Keep track of what you eat and drink for at least three days. Include what you consume, where, how much, and so forth.
- Set a goal. Be specific—do you want to lose a certain number of pounds, lower your blood pressure, or something else? Identify strategies for reaching your goal in a reasonable amount of time.
- Anticipate obstacles. What might prevent you from hitting your goal? If a busy schedule might keep you from working out, plan to get up a little earlier. If an empty pantry tempts you to order take-out, spend some time looking up healthy recipes, then go to the grocery store for ingredients and make enough for a few nights of leftovers.



Cave drawing of bull is earliest of its kind

rcheologists have discovered the oldest known drawing of an animal on the wall of a cave in Indonesia, according to the U.S. News & World Report website. It's some 40,000 years old, about five feet wide, and it depicts a bull-like creature in a red silhouette.

Along with similar drawings on cave walls in Borneo, the drawing sparks renewed debate about the role of art in ancient times. Similar cave paintings have been found in France and Spain, though they're just 33,500 to 37,000 years old.

Cave dwellers began sketching humans engaged in hunting activities and dancing some 14,000 years ago in both Europe and Asia. The findings raise the possibility that humans migrated from Africa to Europe and then Asia, bringing their artistic sensibilities with them.

Invasion of the space worms

ong-term space travel poses many challenges, but one of the most daunting is the loss of muscle mass in a zero-gravity environment. On a voyage to Mars, for example, space travelers could arrive on the red planet too weak to stand. Now, reports the Popular Science website, thousands of worms headed to the International Space Station (ISS) may help solve the problem.

Scientists plan to study muscle atrophy in the worms and then treat them with a special brand of RNA designed to stop the breakdown of protein and preserve the muscles in their bodies. If all goes according to plan, this could alleviate one danger to astronauts remaining in space for long periods of time.


