t the Shareholder's Budget Meeting December 15, 2020, was held as a combination with Zoom attendance of 22 shareholders and 6 shareholders present. The shareholders ▶ voted to adopt the proposed 2021 Budget with 225 proxy votes and 2 present votes for total of 227 votes.

REMEMBER: that January 1st, 2021 the monthly maintenance will increase to \$115.00.

Also, at the Board of Directors Monthly Meeting held on December 15, 2020. Our financial report for the month of November 2020 shows that income for the month was \$36,406.19 with expenditures of \$28,970.16. The financial statement for each month is posted on the bulletin board at the rear of the hall for everyone to review.

Reminder:

R ule #16. HOME SITES (Excerpt from rule). "Any additions or revisions to your exterior property, including outside painting of any type, must be approved by the Board of Directors and a permit obtained from the office before starting work. The permit must be displayed in a clearly visible area. No fences permitted without approval of Board of Directors."



Rule #5. EXTRA OCCUPANCY FEES and GUESTS <u>Guest(s) must be registered upon</u> <u>arrival and they must agree to abide by all rules of the Association</u>. Occupancy by guests of the shareholder shall be for a period of time not exceeding 15 (fifteen) consecutive days and 30 (thirty) days total per year, unless a longer period is approved, in writing, by the Board of Directors. <u>A</u> <u>Shareholder who has a guest approved to stay longer than 30 days will be assessed \$40.00 per</u> <u>month for each guest</u>. Any visit of a guest will be terminated immediately if they fail to abide by the Association Rules and Regulations. Any permission for an approved extended guest who fails to follow the Rules and Regulation will be revoked. Use of the unit by a shareholder's family members is permitted, provided the shareholder notifies the office prior to arrival of the family members, assumes responsibility for water, sewer, and garbage charges, and designates the length of stay. Guest(s) must be registered upon arrival and they must agree to abide by all the rules of the Association.



How to pay your monthly maintenance fees

olden Gate residents use many different methods to pay their monthly maintenance fees

1. Write a monthly check, place in the mail, or deliver to the office before the 1st of each month to avoid late charges

- 2. Write one check to cover two, three, six or twelve months mail or deliver to the office
- 3. Pay with twelve separate checks. Checks postdated to be applied monthly relying on the Office Manager to correctly apply your monthly checks
- 4. Pay in cash or money orders monthly or annually

Cash payments are discouraged as the homeowners' association incurs a bank charge. The bank charges approximately \$10 for large cash deposits. Seems outrageous but they must call for a pickup to deposit extra cash in the federal reserve bank and remove it from their premises.

BEST OPTION TO PAY YOUR MONTHLY MAINTENANCE FEE

Use Bill Pay at your bank (most banks offer this service at no charge and saves postage) If you have a computer you can do it yourself or go to your bank, they will assist you. Sign on to your account


Date to mail on the 25th to 28th of the month to ensure payment received by GG by the 1st of the month to avoid late charges. Checks are never deposited by GG before the 5th of the month.

Parking Request

henever you, your guests, or contractors need to park out on the street, please follow Community Rules!

NO PARKING

 \mathbf{V} **V** No parking on the sidewalks. Your maintenance fees pay for all repairs.

Please use common sense and do not park near or on corners or close to intersections. We would encourage parking on the same side of the street to avoid traffic having to "zig-zag" to get by. This causes obstructions and creates a dangerous situation for cars, golf carts and bicycles trying to proceed by the vehicles.

Recycling on Wednesday

T o plastic bags please!

Aluminum Cans – Empty aluminum cans used for drinks or food. Rinse and crush if possible.

Cartons – Empty gable-top beverage containers such as milk, half and half or orange juice cartons. Rinse and crush if possible.

Glass – Empty glass bottles or jars (all colors). Labels okay. No caps or lids.

Mixed Paper – Any clean, dry paper item that tears, such as white or colored paper, shredded paper, office paper, magazines, catalogs, phone books, junk mail, envelopes, wrapping paper, or paperboard items such as cereal boxes. No paper towels or tissues.

Newspapers – Clean and dry newspapers (including inserts). No string or twine. It's okay to put the news¬papers inside a paper bag.

Plastic Bottles – Empty bottles such as water, soda or mouthwash bottles. Rinse and crush if possible. No need to check for a number—just "check for a neck" (i.e., an opening smaller than the base). Bottles only; no tubs, cups or bags. Labels okay. Caps okay but remove the cap from the bottle so that liquids dry out. Place the cap and the bottle in the bin.

Steel (Tin) Cans – Empty steel cans used for food such as soup cans. Labels and lids okay. No paint cans. Aerosol cans okay. Rinse if possible.




