WEED PROGRAM

s most of you are aware, we have a problem with the growth of weeds during the summer months, typically May through September. The weed problem we are concerned about is in the planter boxes and the front of the homes. Even those home5 that have mulch or stones in the planter boxes will have weed growth.

The board does send "friendly reminders" to alert residents as stated in rule #16..."Each shareholder is responsible for the neat and orderly appearance of his or her premises at all times. However, the general response to the friendly reminders has been less than satisfactory.

We would like to aid in solving this problem by having our maintenance staff spray weed



killer in the planter boxes or in front of the home for any resident that desires to participate. There will be a \$40.00 per year fee to cover the cost of the material for spraying from May through September. If you wish to participate in this program, send a check or pay cash to Jane in the office. If you choose to participate in this program, our maintenance staff will spray, beginning in May and ending in September. However, if you have ornamental plants that could be harmed by the spraying, you will have to make other arrangements, since we will not be responsible for any damages. If you choose not to participate, the weed issue for planters and the front of your home will continue to be your responsibility, and be subject to the terms of rule #16 concerning work done in your absence.

SUMMER OFFICE HOURS

The Office will be closed on Fridays, starting Friday, July 3, 2015 through Friday, September 4, 2015. Please plan to conduct any office business you may have from Monday through Thursday during this time period. Don't forget, there is a self—serve copy machine in the hall near the entrance to the Patio for your use. If you have an emergency and need something from the Office on a Friday during this time-frame, you can call the out-of-hours number ((727)-578-2891) and the Director on call will assist you. Thank you and have a GREAT Summer.

Sidewalk cleaning

Your board has agreed on the issue of pressure washing our sidewalks. This will begin in this month. The sidewalks in the worst condition will be done first. For anyone who is not in residence at the time of their cleaning, no water will be turned on at your home.

Open Door Policy

The Board of Directors at Golden Gate have always had an "open door policy". There are a number of ways for you to discuss any Community issue with them either during the summer months or during the peak season. At least one Director is in the office between the hours of 9:00 AM and 11:00 AM that you can request to speak to; you can write a letter or email, or there are intake forms to submit issues that will be kept confidential and responded to, and they conduct Director's Workshops on Thursday mornings at 9:30 AM to discuss, plan and schedule work programs on items as they arise. A notice of these workshops is posted on the bulletin board by the Tuesday of the week they are scheduled.

As you know, being on the Board is a volunteer job. Please utilize any way listed above to bring issues to their attention. Please respect that outside of these venues, they are retired citizens just like you and enjoy their "free" time with their spouses in this beautiful Community you all enjoy.








- Guy Garvey, musician. "Just start scribbling. The first draft is never your last draft. Nothing you write is by accident."
- Polly Stenham, playwright. "I'm very fidgety, and I seem to work best when my hands are occupied with something other than what I'm thinking about. During rehearsals, I find myself drawing little pictures or symbols that are somehow connected to the play."
- Tamara Rojo, ballet dancer. "An idea never comes to me suddenly; it sits inside me for a while, and then emerges."
- Mark-Anthony Turnage, composer. "If you get overexcited by an idea, take a break and come back to it later. It is all about developing a cold eye with which to look over your own work."
- Fyfe Dangerfield, musician. "For me, the image of the tortured artist is a myth—you don't need to be miserable to write songs. In fact, if I am feeling down, the last thing I want to do is write; though it's important sometimes just to sit down and get on with it, however you're feeling. 

Trust in others rises as people grow older

In a cynical world, trust can seem hard to come by. But new research suggests it may grow as we get older. The World Values Survey, collecting data from more than 200,000 people in 83 nations, found that more than a third of people 80 years old or older agreed with that most people can be trusted, although just a quarter of 20-year-olds said the same.

The results were consistent regardless of nationality, gender, education, and income.

A similar study, analyzing data from the General Social Survey of 1,230 U.S. citizens over time, also found that our willingness to trust increases as we grow older.

One possible explanation: As time goes on, most people tend to simplify their lives and spend more time with their families, resulting in a more positive and generous attitude about the world.



That morning cup of coffee may be really good for you

A lot of us depend on a cup of coffee or two to get going in the morning. But coffee may have even more significant health benefits. Here's a quick look at what it may do to improve your life:

- Melanoma. A study by the National Institutes of Health and the AARP found that the more coffee people drink during the day, the lower their chances of developing melanoma over a 10-year period. Four cups of coffee a day was associated to a 20 percent drop in melanoma risk.
- Multiple sclerosis. An analysis of two studies of people diagnosed with MS (one in the U.S. and one in Sweden) found that consuming at least four cups of coffee a day appears to delay the onset of symptoms. The caffeine, researchers say, seems to have neuroprotective properties that inhibit MS development.
- Liver cancer. Drinkers of three or more alcoholic beverages a day may be able to cut their risk of liver cancer by drinking coffee, according to a recent World Cancer Research Fund report. Coffee and coffee extracts appear to have a preventative effect on the expression of genes involved with inflammation—an effect that's most prevalent in the liver.


