FROM THE OFFICE

Tell I know some "snow-birds" will be starting to plan for their journey back north. Here are a few reminders for your attention:

V • Please remember to sign out in the office. Your signature is needed to stop the Water/Sewer/Trash Bill. Per the Golden Gate Rules & Regulations: (#16 Home sites): Shareholders will be exempt from billing for City utilities for any month which the home is occupied less than 7 days providing the sign out procedure with the office has been properly completed. There is a city charge of \$25 to reactivate the water bill.

• When signing out please check to make sure we have an "away" contact number and

address to reach you.

- "Weeds Needs" Once again, the Weed program is available for \$40.00. This covers spraying for weeds in your front planters from May through September. If you choose not to participate or if someone is watching out for the upkeep of your property, if there is an issue, the "Friendly Reminder" will be sent to you. Please accept the reminder in the spirit it was intended......just a friendly notice that your property may need a little attention.
- Hurricane Season Please put away or secure all outside items that may become a projectile during a Hurricane. Even items that you may think are heavy (patio chairs/tables, flower box pots or ornaments, etc.) will become airborne in 40+ mph winds. Your neighbors appreciate your consideration. It also does not invite potential thieves in to take your "stuff".
- Don't forget to get a forwarding mail package from either the mail man or there is a limited supply in the Office. If you do forget, you can forward your mail on-line at www. usps.gov.

This is probably a good time to give a refresher on how the Water/Sewer/Trash bills work. If you are here more than 6 days in a calendar month, you will get a bill from the city. The bill date is always 1 month past the usage month. For example, if you were here more than 6 days in April, you will get a bill in May, with a bill date of May. The payment will be due in June. To make it a little more confusing, if you have an electronic debit from your checking account, you will see the payment in June, (because that is the due date) for April's usage. Hope this helps.....if not give Jane a call.

SHUT OFF WATER VALVES

If you are using the water outdoors, please remember to shut off the valve at the house instead of just turn the nozzle on the hose.

If anyone comes to your door trying to sell anything, please be safe and just say no thank you; close your door and call the police non-emergency number (on page 2 of the Golden Gate Telephone Directory (727) 541-0758. Do not confront the solicitors.

WEED PROGRAM

s most of you are aware, we have a problem with the growth of weeds during the summer months, typically May through September. The weed problem we are concerned about Lis in the planter boxes and the front of the homes. Even those homes that have mulch or stones in the planter boxes will have weed growth.

The board does send "friendly reminders" to alert residents as stated in rule #16..."Each shareholder is responsible for the neat and orderly appearance of his or her premises at all times. However, the general response to the friendly reminders has been less than satisfactory.

We would like to aid in solving this problem by having our maintenance staff spray weed killer in the planter boxes or in front of the home for any resident that desires to participate. There will be a \$40.00 per year fee to cover the cost of the material for spraying from May through September. If you wish to participate in this program, send a check or pay cash to Jane

in the office. If you choose to participate in this program, our maintenance staff will spray, beginning in May and ending in September. However, if you have ornamental plants that could be harmed by the spraying, you will have to make other arrangements, since we will not be responsible for any damages.

If you choose not to participate, the weed issue for planters and the front of your home will continue to be your responsibility, and be subject to the terms of rule #16 concerning work done in your absence.







"This is a little embarrassing," the minister said. "Since you're the only one here, would you really like to hear my sermon?"


The farmer said, "Well, I'm not too smart, but if I went to the barn to feed my cattle and only one showed up, I'd still feed him."



Exercise: More isn't necessarily better

osing weight is just a matter of exercising, right? Actually, that may not be the case, according to a study of exercise and weight loss reported on the CNN website.

Researchers looked at 332 adults in the U.S., Jamaica, and Africa, measuring their activity level over a week. The volunteers displayed a variety of exercise levels from sedentary to active. Although those who exercised and were active more burned away more calories than the others, their activity tended to hit a plateau—after a certain level, more exercise didn't produce more weight loss.

Switching exercises helped a little, since using different muscles can make your body use more energy. But in the long run, a combination of exercise and a reduced-calorie diet may be your best bet for losing those unwanted pounds.

Don't get zapped at work (or home)

lectrical hazards at home and in the workplace injure thousands every year from burns and shocks. Faulty or overloaded wires cause the majority of accidents, so protect your family and your co-workers by following these guidelines:

- Get inspected. If your electrical panel hasn't been inspected for more than 10 years, get a qualified electrician to look it over.
- Unplug heat appliances after use. At home, that includes toasters, hair dryers, and irons, among others. In the office, unplug space heaters or anything else that can cause a fire.
- Use the correct wattage. Putting a 75-watt bulb in a 60-watt light socket is asking for trouble
- Don't overuse extension cords. They're meant for short-term use, not as way to plug in as many appliances as possible into one outlet.
- Use surge protectors. They'll keep computers and other appliances safe from overloaded circuits
- Keep appliances away from water. If an appliance that's plugged in falls into water or gets wet, unplug it before you reach for it.
- Don't yank cords. When unplugging an appliance, always grip the head of the cord. Yanking and tugging can damage the cord's wire and insulation, which can lead to an electrical shock or fire.



Tarantulas have their own 'Man in Black'

new species of tarantula has been identified by a postdoctoral researcher at the Florida Museum of Natural History. Actually, Chris Hamilton discovered 14 previously unidentified species during his Ph.D. researcher at Auburn University, but only one of them was named after one of his favorite entertainers: country singer Johnny Cash.

Aphonopelma johnnycashi can be found, appropriately enough, near Folsom Prison in California, the setting of one of Cash's most famous songs and the site of several concerts the "Man in Black" performed during his lifetime. Tarantulas have more than 50 different species, and Hamilton examined more than 3,000 specimens, narrowing the field initially to 29 possibles and finally to 14 completely distinct species. Given that Hamilton has a tattoo of Cash himself, the name came naturally.



Shark attacks on the rise

he movie Jaws scared lots of people off the beach, but the danger of shark attacks is very real—and it's increasing. Last year saw a record number of shark attacks, totaling 98 around the world, according to the Florida Museum of Natural History.

The U.S. had the most attacks in 2015, with 30 in the waters off Florida, eight in the Carolinas, seven in Hawaii, two each in California and Texas, and one apiece in New York and Mississippi. Other attacks occurred near the island of Reunion in the Indian Ocean, along with Australia, New Caledonia, and Egypt.

Scientists believe that attacks are rising because the shark population is recovering from low levels, and human populations are increasing as well.

Do not sit still; start moving now. In the beginning, you may not go in the direction you want, but as long as you are moving, you are creating alternatives and possibilities.

Space Station experiment points to possible life on Mars

Lungi from the dry, frigid environment of Antarctica took a trip to the International Space Station to determine their ability to survive under the harsh conditions of the planet Mars. Their endurance suggests that primitive life may indeed be viable on the red planet's surface.

As reported by the NBC News website, scientists took samples of the fungus from the McMurdo Dry Valleys in Antarctica, then had them sent up to the ISS, where the crew placed them on a sealed platform outside and exposed them to various types of conditions, including one which simulated the sparse atmosphere and the exposure to radiation present on Mars.

After a year and a half, the fungi had retained 60 percent of their cells, providing evidence that simple forms of life can survive under the toughest conditions in space and on distant planets.

Robot cockroaches could save lives

Evaluation when the spaces are as maligned as the lowly cockroach. But scientists have found something worth emulating about them—their ability to squeeze into even the tightest spaces. Cockroaches on the run are about ½ inch tall, but they're able to compress their bodies to a 10th of an inch when they're trying to hide. Scientists at the University of California-Berkeley have been able to adapt that flexibility in a small, soft, multi-legged robot dubbed CRAM (Compressible Robot with Articulated Mechanisms). Constructed with an "origami-like" manufacturing technique, CRAM is seven inches long, three inches tall, and 1.6 ounces, and it's able to compress itself just like a cockroach to get inside tiny spaces. The scientists hope that CRAMs could be deployed in swarms to search for survivors inside collapsed buildings.

Antilock brakes: Use them properly

ntilock braking systems in cars are designed to improve safety, but they won't do the job unless drivers know how to use them correctly. Here's the right way to use the ABS when you need to stop quickly:

- Apply steady, firm pressure. Never pump or "feather" your brakes. The ABS regulates the braking pressure so the brakes don't lock up. If you pump or slightly release pressure on the pedal, it confuses the computer system and shuts it off.
- Don't let up. The grating noise you may hear is the sound of the ABS working.
- Don't yank the wheel. You can steer your car safely, but if you yank the wheel, you could lose control.
