From your Board of Directors

Board of Directors meeting was held on October 17, 2017 and 8 residents attended. The following items were discussed and approved: reinvested a CD from Bank United that matured on 10/15/17; to reinvest a CD from Freedom Bank that will mature on 10/27/17; approved the upgrade of our Spectrum network to 100mps. Authorized the following expenditures utilizing Outside Contractor funds: renewing a 2yr. Lawn contract at \$43,800. Utilized Capital funds to upgrade our camera security system with 4 new digital HD cameras at the Front entrance to 82nd Avenue plus added 4 digital HD cameras at the Walmart path and replaced 3 analog cameras with digital HD cameras at the front entrance for a total of \$13,679:

Friendly Reminders





Help for Severe Aortic Stenosis



Severe aortic stenosis is a narrowed aortic heart valve that doesn't open and close properly, reducing blood flow to the rest of the body.

Morton Plant Hospital is now enrolling eligible patients in the Medtronic Evolut R low-risk trial, which investigates the safety and effectiveness of a transcatheter aortic valve replacement (TAVR) system in patients with severe aortic stenosis who are at a low surgical mortality risk. TAVR is a minimally invasive alternative to open-heart surgery used to treat failing aortic heart valves in patients with severe aortic stenosis. Morton Plant Hospital was chosen as the first hospital in Tampa Bay to offer the TAVR procedure for patients with severe aortic stenosis who were at an intermediate or high surgical mortality risk. Our team has completed more than 700 TAVR procedures over the last five years.



rivers can't wait for self-driving cars, according to a survey by Bosch Mobility Solutions. Out of 1,000 U.S.-based new car buyers 18 years or older, 52 percent said they expect to own a self-driving vehicle within the next 10 years. Only 14 percent said they'd never buy a self-driving car, and 14 percent were undecided.

Although 72 percent of survey participants signaled worries about lack of control in a vehicle they don't drive themselves, 61 percent said they believe self-driving cars could lead to a decrease in traffic accidents, and 55 percent highlighted more free time and less stress as a benefit to driverless cars.

Why kids stay home longer

It's not just a stereotype: More and more young Americans are living with their parents, the U.S. Census Bureau reports. According to a recent study, one in three Americans age 18-34 were living in their parents' home in 2015—some 24 million people. In 1975, the figure was closer to one in five.

One reason: Young people are delaying marriage longer than their older counterparts did. Eighty percent of Americans were married by age 30 in 1975, but nowadays that 80 percent figure isn't reached until age 45.

Younger Americans are also dealing with high student loan debt, which makes staying at home a convenient way for them to pay bills and save to rent an apartment or buy a house.

Coffee + nap = more energy

ant to take a nap that will leave you refreshed and ready to go again? Try drinking a cup of coffee first.

It sounds counterintuitive, but that's the advice from the Health.com website. The reason why it works: The caffeine in a cup of coffee takes about 30 minutes to kick in. After a 30-minute nap, you'll wake up just as the caffeine takes effect.

Research backs the idea up. In 1997 the journal Psychophysiology reported that sleepy adults who drank 200 mg of caffeine (twice the amount in 8 ounces of brewed coffee) and then took a short nap performed better on a simulated driving test than people who got only the caffeine.

Keep your naps short—15-30 minutes—and take them at least six hours before your regular bedtime so the caffeine doesn't keep you up at night. If you're sensitive to caffeine, try green tea instead.

Overcome the power of negative thinking

B eing creative calls for positive thinking, but optimism isn't always easy. Negative thoughts can creep into your mind when you least expect them. The trick isn't to fight them, but to manage them so they don't paralyze you. Here's what to do:

- Identify the triggers. When you have a negative thought, stop and ask yourself what's bringing it on. You may be tired or stressed out, or you may be affected by someone else's perspective. If you can locate the cause, the thought itself won't have as much power over you.
- Focus on the now. Worrying about the past or the future isn't productive. When you start chastising yourself for prior mistakes or seeing disaster around every corner, stop and take a breath. Ask yourself what you can do at that moment to succeed. Giving yourself something to do will distract you from destructive thoughts.
- Replace the negative. If you find yourself plagued by a recurrent worry, train yourself to think of something else. Memorize a short poem, phrase, or meditation that you can repeat to yourself when you have negative thoughts. Your conscious mind can concentrate on only one thought at a time, and driving the negativity away will free you up to move forward again.

Get past the obstacles when you paint

Just because you're not Picasso doesn't mean you can't find satisfaction and enjoyment in art. A course in drawing or painting can get you started, but when you're searching for ideas or subjects to work on, consider some of these approaches:

- Seek inspiration. Spend time looking at art—paintings, sculpture, drawings—for ideas. Listen to music to stimulate your creative juices.
- Start small. If you're hesitant, or blocked, don't tackle a big art project. Start with something small and easy. Work on one section of your painting, and don't think about the rest of the project. You'll make progress and your success may give you the momentum you need to continue.
- Switch things around. If you usually paint or draw horizontally, switch to vertical. Instead of painting what you see, paint what you feel. If you draw with your right hand, try switching to your left. A small change can make a big difference.
- Try an exercise. Find inspiration in a common phrase such as, "Once in a blue moon." Draw or paint your interpretation of that saying. What kind of rare occurrence springs to your mind? How would the world look under blue moonlight? Choose other clichés and catchphrases to illustrate, and you'll keep your perceptions sharper.



eeping your bones in good shape is vital to your health as you grow older, especially for women. Research reported on the Medical News Today website suggests that women may be able to keep their bones strong by running just one minute a day.

Examining data from more than 2,500 women, researchers found that women who participated in high-intensity, weight-bearing physical activity like running 60-120 seconds a day had 4 percent better bone health than women who took part in less than a minute of physical activity. Women who performed more than two minutes of exercise had 6 percent better bone health.

The researchers cautioned, though, that they can't be sure whether highintensity exercise leads to better bone health, or whether people with better bone health tend to exercise more.

New findings about the solar system intrigue scientists

ur solar system is full of interesting places—maybe not to live or even visit, but locations where life might flourish under the right conditions, or may once have been present. Two recent examples from the Science News website:

• Life on Titan? Scientists have discovered that the atmosphere of Saturn's moon Titan contains vinyl cyanide—a molecule that forms membrane-like structures and could support life. Computer simulations suggest the molecule is capable of forming flexible bubbles known as azotosomes, that could serve as an outer shell "protecting" genetic material from biochemical reactions in the moon's frigid methane seas. No one knows whether azotosomes actually

exist on Titan, though. A probe would have to check out the seas to detect them.

• Water on Venus? With a surface temperature of 460 degrees, Venus is too hot to support water or life as we know it, but scientists speculate it might not always have been so inhospitable. The second planet's slow rotation—116 Earth days for a single Venusian day—might have led to a gradual cloud buildup in its atmosphere some 750 million years ago, bringing surface temperatures down to approximately 15 degrees Celsius—enough for the formation of a shallow ocean. What happened to the oceans, or whether they even existed, isn't clear. Scientists speculate they may have boiled away or been absorbed into the planet's interior.
