

A message from the Fire Chief of Seminole:

Recently a resident died in an apartment fire in Seminole Garden Apartments and, as with every fatal fire, I asked the question, "what could have been done to prevent this death?" 100% of the time fatal fires deemed "unintentional" or "accidental" are preventable. Prevention is accomplished by actively living a safe life: by having working smoke alarms; by practicing safe cooking; by using extension cords in a safe manner; by cleaning dryer vents regularly; by storing flammable liquids carefully and by ensuring those around you do the same. We know this, but why do some of us not live safe lives?

Part of the answer is in the phenomenon known as "optimism bias." This is a cognitive bias that causes someone to believe that they themselves are less likely to experience a negative event, especially if the event is unlikely to occur, as in a house fire which has a relatively low probability of happening. It is the "it's not going to happen to me" thinking. We all have it, as optimism bias transcends gender, ethnicity, nationality and age.

Preventions that work must motivate safe living practices in spite of human tendency for optimism bias. We have to motivate ourselves to check smoke detectors periodically, even if we believe they will never be needed. Migrating to a "it can happen to me" and "I better be ready for it" thinking can ultimately save our life. In the next issue I will address "Prevention that Overcomes Optimism Bias." A watch is given 72 hours ahead, a warning is given 48 hours ahead, so there is ample time to leave and go inland or to a friend/family member who has a safe structure. Refer to the newspaper found in the laundry and tv alerts as they are given.

"Indeed not," said the leader, and showed the coin—which had heads on both sides.



The history of Labor Day

abor Day is a creation of the labor movement, a yearly celebration of the American worker, and a national tribute to the laborer's contribution to the social and economic achievements of the United States. There is some uncertainty about the origins of Labor Day. Some records show that Peter J. McGuire, general secretary of the Brotherhood of Carpenters and Joiners and a co-founder of the American Federation of Labor, was first to suggest a day to honor those "who from rude nature have delved and carved all the grandeur we behold." Other research suggests that machinist Matthew Maguire, later the secretary of Local 344 of the



International Association of Machinists in Paterson, N.J., proposed the holiday in 1882 while serving as secretary of the Central Labor Union in New York.

The first Labor Day holiday was celebrated on Tuesday, Sept. 5, 1882, in New York City, in accordance with the plans of the Central Labor Union. In 1884, the first Monday in September was selected as the official holiday. The first governmental recognition of Labor Day came through municipal ordinances passed in 1885 and 1886. The state of Oregon passed the first law recognizing the Labor Day holiday on Feb. 21, 1887. Four more states—Colorado, Massachusetts, New Jersey, and New York—followed suit that same year. On June 28, 1894, Congress passed an act making the first Monday in September of each year a legal holiday in all the states, the District of Columbia, and all U.S. territories.




