

Many Americans still worried about their finances

The stock market may be up, but many Americans are still struggling with financial security, according to a story on the USA Today website. A September 2018 Bankrate. com survey found that among people earning less than \$30,000 a year, 78 percent said that their financial situation has failed to improve over the past two years, and many said it had gotten worse. On the other hand, people earning \$75,000 a year or more reported feeling better about their money.

The survey found other divides as well. People 65 and older reported the least financial improvement, and millennials ages 28–37 felt the most improvement. In addition, men reported doing better in earlier years than women did.

Coffee still in demand

National Coffee Drinking Trends report says that the number of Americans who drank coffee in the past day is the highest it's been in six years.



According to the report, based on a study of more than 2,700 adults 18 or older, 64 percent said they drank coffee within the past day, the highest amount since 2012. This is higher than the growth from 57 percent in 2016 to 62 percent in 2017. The study also found that past-day consumption traditional coffee, defined as "regular coffee" brewed from "gourmet quality" beans, held steady over the previous years, at 16 percent. Similarly, consumption of espresso-based drinks held steady from 2017, at 24 percent.

Try these tips for healthy eating habits

If you've already slipped off your New Year's diet, it's not too late to get back on track. Just follow these tips for healthy weight loss from the Harvard Health Publishing website:

- Make a list. Keep track of what you eat and drink for at least three days. Include what you consume, where, how much, and so forth.
- Set a goal. Be specific—do you want to lose a certain number of pounds, lower your blood pressure, or something else? Identify strategies for reaching your goal in a reasonable amount of time.
- Anticipate obstacles. What might prevent you from hitting your goal? If a busy schedule might keep you from working out, plan to get up a little earlier. If an empty pantry tempts you to order take-out, spend some time looking up healthy recipes, then go to the grocery store for ingredients and make enough for a few nights of leftovers.

Start on the path to better heart health

aking control of your heart health is one of the best ways to lead a long life. It's not that hard, especially if you follow this basic advice from the Time magazine website:

• Eat more plants. Fruits and vegetables contain fiber, antioxidants, and lots of vitamins and minerals.

• Limit animal fat. Butter and other forms of fat from animals have been linked to higher cholesterol and increased risk of heart disease. Stick to monounsaturated fats found in olive oil, avocados, and many nuts, along with polyunsaturated fats from fish like wild salmon and sardines.

• Watch your sugar intake. Many foods add sugar, which can add calories and weight. The American Heart Association recommends that women have no more than six teaspoons' worth of added sugar a day and men stick to nine—although the average intake for all Americans is roughly 22 teaspoons per day. Check the labels on everything you buy.

• Exercise often. You don't have to run for five miles every day. The American Heart Association advises about 150 minutes of moderate exercise a week, or 30–60 minutes every day.

- Stand up. Sitting for hours at a time has a negative impact on your heart. Even if you work at a desk job, make a point of getting up and moving around regularly for five to 10 minutes every hour.
- Watch your stress. Stress can heighten your heart disease risk at a rate similar to smoking and diabetes. Practice meditation and yoga to keep yourself calm and reduce your heart's workload.





Mystery of the mummified priest

The mummified remains of an 18th-century Austrian priest have been identified, the Fox News website reports, as well as the reason behind the mystery of why the priest's body hasn't decayed for more than 300 years.

The priest, Franz Xaver Sydler von Rosenegg, lived from 1709 to 1746 in the district of St. Thomas am Blasenstein in Upper Austria. He was a heavy smoker who died of tuberculosis and was interred in a church crypt in his lederhosen, his body stuffed with branches, wood chips, and scraps of cloth. Along with the conditions in the crypt, this prevented the body from decomposing over time, instead mummifying and preserving the body.

Examination of the skin and bones showed that the priest was well fed and probably didn't have to do much physical work. Abrasions on his teeth suggest that he smoked a pipe for many years.

In another mystery, a glass bead was discovered in the priest's lower abdomen. Some suspected a poisoning attempt, but researchers have determined that the bead was probably from a rosary and fell into the body during the stuffing process.

Ozone layer is recovering, scientists report

ome good news about the environment comes from the UPI website: Scientists say that the hole in the ozone layer above Earth's Northern Hemisphere is expected to disappear in the 2030s.

The ozone layer protects the surface of the Earth from hazardous ultraviolet rays from the sun. When the rupture was measured in the late 20th century, many nations joined the Montreal Protocol, which sought to reduce the use of chlorofluorocarbons and other ozone-depleting substances from aerosol cans, cooling and refrigeration systems, and other sources. A second measure, the Kigali Amendment, is expected to reduce even more ozone-eroding gases in refrigerators, air conditioners, and other products.

The Southern Hemisphere's ozone layer is expected to fully recover in the 2050s, followed by polar regions in the 2060s.



One sweet, simple thing

Ten years after John Chhan and his wife, Stella, emigrated to the United States from Cambodia, they opened a small doughnut shop in the southern California town of Seal Beach. They are there seven days a week and arrive at 2:30 every morning to make sure there are plenty of doughnuts ready when the shop opens at 4:30 a.m. This is how it's been since 1990, and they've enjoyed the love and support of loyal, longtime customers.

When Dawn Caviola, a customer of 13 years, noticed Chhan alone in the shop one morning, she inquired about Stella. Chhan explained his wife was recovering in a rehabilitation facility after suffering an aneurysm. Upon hearing this, Caviola realized she had to do something for this beloved, hardworking couple who are a fixture of the community.

Caviola took to the social media platform Nextdoor to spread the word in Seal Beach about Stella's illness. As awareness increased, customers of the doughnut shop began brainstorming ways to help. Chhan respectively declined when some of the regulars offered to start a GoFundMe campaign to raise money to help with expenses. Chhan told them what he wanted more than anything was time to be with his wife.

More social media posts followed. Soon people of the community were lining up to buy doughnuts and lots of them. Even people who didn't eat doughnuts were frequenting the shop to buy a dozen just to give away. "People can just do a simple thing for their neighbors," Caviola says.

On good days, John Chhan is sold out by 8:30 a.m. Whatever the time, as soon as all of the doughnuts are gone, Chhan closes up shop and goes to the rehabilitation center to spend time with Stella. He says his wife is getting better. She can speak again and has also relearned how to feed herself. He looks forward to the day that she is fully recovered and can once again be by his side in their shop. He is also grateful for all of those people who have given him this precious gift of time.

Sometimes the things that are most helpful result from simple gestures or small acts of kindness that create their own momentum and have a huge impact on the lives of the people we love and respect.

Meditation, yoga on the rise

ore and more people are practicing meditation and yoga, according to the CNBC website. The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention's National Center for Health Statistics reports that the number of U.S. children and adults practicing "mindfulness" exercise has jumped significantly in the past five years.

Researchers studied how many people practiced meditation or yoga or visited a chiropractor within the past year. Yoga was the most common technique among adults, with 14.3 percent practicing it in 2017, up from 9.5 percent in 2012. Meditation came in a close second, with 14.2 percent of American adults saying they meditated within the past year, an increase

from 4.1 percent in 2012. Also, 10.3 percent of adults visited a chiropractor, up from 0.1 percent in 2012.

up from 9.1 percent in 2012.

Yoga among teens and younger children rose from 3.1 percent in 2012 to 8.4 percent in 2017, and meditation by adolescents increased from 0.6 percent to 5.4 percent over the same period.

The researchers did not report on any reasons driving the growth beyond noting that some teachers have started incorporating yoga and meditation in their lesson plans.

Print books remain in the lead

Books are alive and well in the digital age, but we're consuming them differently from the way we have in centuries past. The Pew Research Center reports that 74 percent of Americans say they've read a book in the past year, a figure that's remained fairly constant since 2012.

We're not all "reading" the same way, though. Print books may be the most popular format, with 67 percent of Americans reporting they've read one in the past 12 months, but the share of Americans consuming audiobooks has increased from 14 percent to 18 percent since 2016.

E-books are also a factor in our reading choices, though they're not taking the place of paper for now. Thirty-nine percent of readers say they read only physical print books, although 29 percent say they read both print and digital books. Just 7 percent report reading books exclusively in digital format and say they haven't read any dead-tree books in the past year.
