M obile Home Tie-Down Enhancement Program The program (MHTDP) is funded through the Florida Hurricane Catastrophe Trust Fund from the State of Nevada. It involves the enhancement of the tie-down and anchoring system of your home. **It does not bring existing mobile homes up to code.**

- The program is for mobile homes built in 1999 and prior.
- There is an extensive waiting list. Parks and individuals will have to wait a minimum of three to up to five years from the time of registration until the services can be provided.
- There is no cost to the participant.

It is my understanding that the Park was deemed ineligible for the program because the homes are too low to ground. Kay Tyrrell investigated this program a few years ago. I hope to find a moment over the next few weeks to look through the file and confirm this information. I'll update everyone in the April newsletter and at the Board of Directors Meeting.


