GOLF: HOLIDAY CHIPPERS



DID YOU KNOW...

Coffee, tea, and the benefits for better mental health

A cup of coffee or tea helps many people wake up in the morning, but they may also have health benefits later in life, according to recent research reported in Scientific American.

One project by the National Institutes of Health studied the relationship between different kinds of beverages and depression, and found that coffee consumption was associated with slightly lower rates of self-reported depression. A Chinese study found that adults who drink tea on a regular basis had a smaller risk of depression.

Other research suggests that caffeine may play a role in preventing cognitive decline, but the evidence remains inconclusive.







IRS IMPOSTER SCAMS ON THE RISE

The Internal Revenue Service (IRS) is the government agency that collects federal taxes. Scammers pretend to be IRS officials to get you to send them money.

HOW THE SCAM WORKS

Your caller ID might show it's the IRS calling. The caller might give a badge number and know the last four digits of your Social Security number.

You find out it wasn't the IRS. It was a scam. The money is gone.

GOT A CALL?

Don't give the caller information such as your financial or other personal information.

Write down details such as the number and name of the caller.

Hang up

Contact the IRS directly

If you're worried the call is real, contact the IRS directly at 800-829-1040 or go to irs.gov. Report the call

File a complaint with:

- 1. the Treasury Inspector General for Tax Administration (TIGTA) at tigta.gov or 800-366-4484.
- 2. the FTC at ftc.gov/complaint or 877-FTC-HELP.


