NEIGHBORHOOD "WATCH TALK"

reetings from your Neighborhood Watch Rep. I hope you're having a wonderful summer and staying safe.

Do you have a phone where you are able to see the telephone number that is calling you? Do you recognize the telephone number as one that you know?

Does your phone show you where the telephone call is coming from? Do you know anyone from that State or Country? If the answer is no or maybe, then DO NOT ANSWER YOUR PHONE!!!

More likely it's a scam and by answering your phone you are letting the dialer know that the telephone number is a good number. When in doubt, let it go to voice mail. If it's someone you know, you can call them back. More likely there will be no message left and you will know that it was someone phishing for a victim.

SIMPLE PRECAUTIONS:

1. Whenever you leave your vehicle to step into a store for a moment, run by a friend's house to just pick something up, or parking your vehicle in your driveway or any other place, **LOCK YOUR VEHICLE!!!**

Most vehicle thefts are crimes of opportunity from people not locking their vehicles. Save yourself a whole lot of aggravation by "Locking before walking!

2. Neighborhood Watch..."the eyes and ears of law enforcement" by the Reporting of Suspicious Activity. Members participate in crime prevention by knowing what to report and how to report it. Don't worry about "bothering" the Sheriff's Office, or being embarrassed if your suspicions prove unfounded.

What is suspicious activity?

Suspicious activity is any event that seems out of the ordinary, or may be the precursor to criminal activity. The resident knows better than anyone else what is normal for your neighborhood.

What are some common examples of suspicious activity?

A stranger loitering in your neighborhood; strangers knocking on doors or soliciting; a vehicle cruising the streets repeatedly; someone peering into cars or windows; strange odors coming from a building; open or broken doors or windows at an unoccupied residence; etc.

How to report suspicious Activity? Pinellas Sheriff's Office (non-emergency call) 727-582-6200

The resident should be prepared to answer a series of questions so the dispatcher can determine the nature and priority of the call. The resident should be prepared for questions similar to the following:



- **Location of the activity?** An exact address or cross street ensures the deputy's response is timely.
- **Description of the individual(s)?** Suspicious persons could include race, sex, age, height, weight, hair, clothing, complexion, speech, distinguishing features, etc.
- **Description of the vehicle(s)?** The license plate (tag), color, make, vintage, distinguishing features, etc.
- What is suspicious about the person(s) or vehicle(s)? Many residents feel uncomfortable or are unable to articulate the purpose of their call. Explain the facts accurately of what was observed. Let the dispatcher decide the nature of the call.

• Do you want to be contacted by the deputy responding to the area? — Residents are not obligated to leave their name. However, the Sheriff's Office would prefer to be able to contact the resident observer if further information may be helpful. Residents may request that the deputy contact them in person or by phone following resolution of the concern.

Residents are reminded to **avoid any form of confrontation** relating to suspicious activities. Your job is to observe and report only.



Irrigation system

ce reporter Tom Lenard sent photos and an update on the "new look" for the front of the clubhouse. As of June 23rd, the irrigation system was installed.

While the plants were expected to be arriving shortly thereafter, Tom's last report on July 10th indicates that it is too hot to plant things now. But the sprinkler system is ready! The plan is to have the work completed by the time the part-time residents return.





MICROWAVING CORN

Tt's sweet corn season in Indiana! I want to share a great recipe I picked up from one of our local growers, Sweet Corn Charlie's.

1-2 ears per recipe, but can do as many as will fit in microwave and just increase the time.

Put 1-2 ears of sweet corn (leaving it in the husk, silk and all) in the micr0wave on a plate. Cook on high for 3-4 minutes per ear, or 7-8 minutes for 2ears. Remove the sweet corn (it will be HOT) and put on a cutting board. Using a heavy serrated knife, cut through the entire base of the cob, (throwing this part away). Hold the ear by the silk, cut end down, and shake lightly. The whole ear will fall out, leaving the husk and silk away from the cob. Discard the husk and silk, and enjoy delicious corn on the cob!

It doesn't work quite that easy for me. I hold onto the silk and peel

away the husk. The silk comes off the corn easily.



An excerpt from "A Walk Through Time" Honeymoon Park 1968-1998

In 1979, residents voted 229 to one in favor of water meters. Howard Anderson, a former resident and retired plumbing contractor, negotiated an excellent price for the bulk purchase of 230 meters. Honeymoon became the first mobile home park in Florida to have water meters. When they were installed, water use decreased by two-thirds.

Although Honeymoon Park offers retirement living at its finest, it appears that many residents have stayed in high gear. Truth be told, some Honeymooners have a common affliction known as "lead foot". Despite signs and warnings, residents often exceed the 10 mph speed limit. Speed bumps, installed in August 1972, may have helped a little, but there are still those who are trying out for the Indy 500.

When Honeymoon Park was built, the northern entrance was open to vehicles. Residents were able to enter and exit directly onto Alternate 19. Unfortunately, many locals began using East Street as a bypass, and traffic in the Park became quite heavy and hazardous. In September 1971, this access was modified, and restricted to walkers and bikers only. Plans are now underway to restore the entrance to Alt 19. A gate with personal openers for residents will add convenience and limit access, preventing flow-through traffic.

Kudos to Georgia Marcum who made 75 dresses for Our Lady of Lourdes Church in Dunedin to distribute to girls in Haiti. What great way to use your talent!

Columbus' anchor salvaged from the depths

team of explorers believe they've discovered an anchor from one of Christopher Columbus' ships in the Caribbean. According to a story on the Fox News website, an analysis of the anchor shows that it dates from somewhere between 1492 and 1550. It weighed 1,200-1,500 pounds and probably belonged to a 300-ton vessel, typical of Columbus' time.

The anchor is believed to come from a fleet of smaller ships called caravels, which included the Pinta. Captained by Vicente Pinzon on one of the "minor voyages" of Columbus' third expedition to the New World, the ship sank in a hurricane near the Turks and Caicos islands in 1500.

In addition to the anchor, the team brought up other artifacts at the shipwreck site, including grappling hooks used for salvaging cargo from shipwrecks, as well as pieces of pottery and an olive jar painted with indigo.

Scientists create negative mass in the laboratory

Tegative mass might sound like something out of science fiction, but physicists have created it in a laboratory. The BBC News website reports that scientists at Washington State University have created a particle composed of negative mass by using lasers to trap atoms of rubidium and then cooling them down to just above absolute zero. This caused the atoms to behave as a superfluid liquid, flowing without losing any energy.

Paradoxically, if you push something with negative mass, it accelerates in your direction, following behavior predicted by quantum mechanics. Scientist expect the technique to help them solve questions about black holes, neutron stars, and dark energy in the cosmos.

Ancient bone raises modern questions

n artifact unearthed in Crimea may shed new light on our Neanderthal ancestors, according to the Sci-News website. It's a bone fragment from a raven, and it's approximately 38,000 years old. A mere 18 mm long, the bone bears a series on notches that are too evenly spaced to be the result of everyday butchery. Archaeologists believe that two notches on the raven bone could have been made intentionally by Neanderthals to create a pattern meant to be consistent or symbolic. The bone may have worn as a personal ornament, some speculate.

Traditional books are alive and well

Publishers and traditional readers alike have long been worried about the rise of electronic books as sales of Amazon's Kindle and other devices have grown, but their concerns may have been at least somewhat overblown. New studies suggest that the growth of e-book sales is leveling out—and possibly declining.

According to the Chicago Tribune website, during the first nine months of 2016 e-book sales dropped by 18.7 percent compared with the same period a year earlier. On the other hand, hardcovers, paperbacks, and audiobooks did not suffer a similar decline. In the same time frame, e-books' share of the total market fell to 17.6 percent from 21.7 percent. In addition, sales of hardcover books in 2016 outpaced e-books for the first time in five years.

Don't panic—books don't look like they're being replaced any time soon.

More Americans taking advantage of technology

he digital revolution continues gaining ground, according to the Pew Research Center. Seventy-seven percent of Americans own a smartphone, a figure that's almost doubled since Pew began tracking smartphone ownership in 2011.

Similarly, broadband access is on an upswing, with home broadband service rising 6 percent in 2016 (after a slight decline from 2013 to 2015). In November 2016, nearly three-quarters (73 percent) of Americans reported having broadband service.

Finally, 69 percent of U.S. adults are using social media, especially young people—86 percent of 18- to 29-year-olds are on at least one social media platform.

New hope for headache sufferers

luster headaches, such as migraines, are rare, but they can cause intense pain to the people (mostly men) who suffer from them.

But there's hope. According to the NBC News website, the Food and Drug Administration has recently approved a device known as the vagus nerve stimulator for treatment of cluster headaches. Sufferers place the small device, named gammaCore, against the neck and send a mild electrical stimulation to the vagus nerve—a large nerve that runs from the brain to the colon. The jolt disrupts signals along the nerve, reducing the pain.

Vagus nerve stimulation is already used to treat ailments such as epilepsy and depression. Gammacore, manufactured by the organization electroCore, is available in Europe, but electroCore plans to begin offering it in the United States later this year.
