### **Hurricane Irma Experience**

Tom Lenard shares this story...

Lattricane "IRMA" attacked the Honeymoon Park community beginning late Sunday September 10, 2017. The winds started late in the day but didn't hit Cat.#2 force until after 11:00 PM or so. Most park residents had already evacuated to friends, relatives, hotels or a local shelter; some departed as early as Wednesday. There were a number of us that remained behind to finish last minute preparation to protect our property for both our neighbors and ourselves. Doug Jr. along with his crew spent at least a day and a half running from one unit to the other securing properties for the seasonal residents and checking with those still here to see if they needed help. "HATS OFF TO DOUG JR.and HIS CREW". We can't thank him enough for all he did to assist us in preparing to do combat with the 60 to 85 mph winds of Irma. Some gust seemed to have been stronger. Rains were on and off all day with strong gust of wind in between. It was much like a violent thunder storm but believe it or not, not even that bad, we expected much worse. It just lasted a lot longer. Publix stayed open until 8:00PM Saturday so people could get last minute items. The shelves were completely empty for the most common items.

Not sure exactly when the power went off but it was after the storm pretty much had past. Nancy and I were at our son's home in Palm Harbor, just 2 miles away. We had power throughout the storm hours. It was at 5:58 AM Sunday when power came to an end for an undetermined length of time. I looked out of the window to see that the winds had died down to the point that the streets were already pretty much dry.

It wasn't too much later when folks began to come out to survey damage. Lots of debris, broken branches, several trees down but not as many as you might expect. The clean up started as the hurricane continued to face another group of hurricane soldiers. The battle continued to the east and north of Honeymoon Park closer to Orlando and Lakeland. Flooding did start to take its toll after Irma passed but thankfully not in Honeymoon Park. WE are blessed!!!! We

a while. Heat began to cause concern. We did have water, "Thank You, Lord".

Monday was a day of wondering as folks started to slowly wander from their properties little by little and begin the Clean-Up process. As the day went on traffic started to flow with everyone showing concern for their neighbors. I'm talking everyone and where ever you might go. Stores remained closed but the Mobile on the corner of Alt#19 and Curlew opened to provide food for folks for as long as the supplies lasted. No gas anywhere at this time, but if you filled up before, you were OK. Generators in the surrounding areas were running for those who had one. Many shared the power with neighbors. More and more folks emerged from hiding as traffic slowly increased. Publix opened later on Monday to make available items that were still on the shelves. The busiest area was the deli since they opened to move what they had left before it went bad and to help those that didn't prepare properly beforehand.

Back at Honeymoon Park power still not on and the sun making itself better known, the heat started to become a factor. By mid-day Monday the 11th the folks at Honeymoon MHP were cleaning up in full force. Neighbors helping neighbors and checking properties for friends not here. Marti and Ron were making an initial evaluation and assessing damage. A palm tree rested on the north end of the shuffle broad courts, another on the corner of West and 1st Street; more palms down throughout the park; several of the carport roofs were gone and pieces of siding all over. Several pieces of the perimeter fence was down. One unit on West Street had a pine tree fall onto it and go through the roof and into the bedroom. A unit on 6th Street lost its screening and porch but the chairs and table remained untouched; Weird? It must have been caused by tornado type winds. We all have our various versions and stories to tell.

Tuesday the clean-up continued in a very aggressive fashion. Ron had helpers drag carport roofs and carry debris to a staging area by the dumpsters. Doug Sr., Doug Jr. and crew helped with fine tuning and clearing the damaged units; these guys are something else and no one can say enough good or enough praises for all the hard work they had done before and after Irma. Ron and Marti started a more detailed evaluation of each unit. The Honeymoon Park staff stepped up to the occasion; WOW!!! Thank You so much!!!!

Neighbors acted individually, others in small groups going around to see who they might help. Marti took charge of getting the park's responsibility to get recovery under way. While this was going on someone had the idea that people needed some time together, why not get a grill going and have a B-B-Que. Eddie went around the park letting everyone know that at 6:00 PM we will have a time of fellowship. Bring what you can and we will break bread as we hold each others hand, tell our stories and give thanks. Keep in mind that we still did not have power. Supporting each other was the primary purpose of getting together. Karen and Susan organized the food. Thank You so much!!! Great job Ladies.

Marti drove around the park about 4:30PM letting everyone know that "We have Power!" Also, to keep use of toilets to a minimum. The pump station was not quite up to maximum capacity yet but would be in a few hours. Yes, we were on the road to complete recovery!! I don't know if you know this, but air conditioning is a beautiful thing!!

Post "Irma Celebration!!!" 48 people were in attendance with plenty of food and life experiences to go around. You couldn't hear a pin drop. Eddie led the event bystarting off with a prayer of thanks and to remember those still recovering from this historic hurricane. All were relieved, recharged, and ready to face all that still needed to be done. There is more to tell and



I'm sure we will share that with you as you return for the upcoming season.

Even though I wrote this article on Friday, September 15, 2017, we must be grateful for this experience and learn from it. We must thank the Lord as we ask him not to forget those still without power or water on this day and may not have for a while.

# Help for Severe Aortic Stenosis



Severe aortic stenosis is a narrowed aortic heart valve that doesn't open and close properly, reducing blood flow to the rest of the body.

Morton Plant Hospital is now enrolling eligible patients in the Medtronic Evolut R low-risk trial, which investigates the safety and effectiveness of a transcatheter aortic valve replacement (TAVR) system in patients with severe aortic stenosis who are at a low surgical mortality risk. TAVR is a minimally invasive alternative to open-heart surgery used to treat failing aortic heart valves in patients with severe aortic stenosis. Morton Plant Hospital was chosen as the first hospital in Tampa Bay to offer the TAVR procedure for patients with severe aortic stenosis who were at an intermediate or high surgical mortality risk. Our team has completed more than 700 TAVR procedures over the last five years.

As we came down the mountain I make a comment about how smokey it was. As we got closer down we found out there was a fire burning just up the hill from us. Saw lots of tired firemen and trucks and planes flying over dropping water. Many people were just standing around watching it! We got out as fast as we could! Scary!!

They have lost 42,000 acres of vines and have lost hundreds of houses. Lost within a matter of couple minutes. Twenty-two people have died, caught in their homes or on the roads trying to escape, and hundreds are missing. What a shame.






