Neighborhood "Watch Talk"...Top Ten Scams #1 IRS / CRA Tax Scams

Imost 100 residents recently attended the annual Sheriff's Office sponsored workshop.

Deputy Jessica Hughey captured our attention with an energetic, personable presentation mixed in with a few humorous takes on real life stories.

Residents interacted sharing experiences and posing excellent questions and answers.

The debate was evidence of the increased level of awareness among members. Very impressive....

Shockingly, Scammers go to great lengths to steal your identity.

Scammers prey on a victim's fear (fines, jail time); or sentimental attachments (family, lone-liness); or the victim's expectation to improve their net worth (give money to get more money).

It is tax time and the scammers are active......

Ranking #1 of the Top Ten Scams of 2015 is the IRS Scam. (the CRA Scam in Canada).

Be alert for callers pretending to be IRs representatives threatening arrest for collecting back taxes.

Be alert for emails appearing to be from IRS and directing you to update your IRS email e-file. The IRS does not use email, text messages or any social media to communicate your personal tax status.



The Canada Revenue Agency (CRA) warns of a scam where a phony text message advises CRA has sent an e-transfer with instructions to click a link "to deposit your income tax return.

Recipients are then asked for personal information like social insurance numbers, credit card and bank account information, and passport numbers.

Canadians are reminded that the CRA will only send payments by direct deposit or by cheque, never by email money transfer.

In brief, do not do any of the following.....

- **Do not** provide personal, financial information over the phone, online, or text.
- **Do not** give money to get money.
- **Do not** fall for a story that appears to be authenticated by supposed verifiable information.
- **Do not** use your bank account to clear funds.





This tip from MaryJo Boyle

ere's an interesting tip from Cook's Illustrated magazine on what to do with the brine that's left in a jar of store-bought pickles after you've eaten them all:

Make quick pickles from leftover pickle brine by tossing fresh cucumber slices with

Make quick pickles from leftover pickle brine by tossing fresh cucumber slices with salt (1 1/2 teaspoons per pound of cucumbers) then placing the slices in a colander. Let them sit for 1 hour; then put them into a clean jar.

Bring the leftover pickle brine to a boil and pour it over the cucumbers.

Seal the jar and refrigerate for 24 hours before eating. The pickles can be kept for up to two weeks.

They don't recommend reusing the brine more than once.

The new pickles will be brightly flavored and well seasoned from the brine.
