An excerpt from 'A Walk Thru Time'

Honeymoon Park 30th Anniversary, 1968 - 1998

Off Dunedin's west coast was a long, narrow strip of land. Some early settlers in the 1800s homesteaded there and raised not only crops but hundreds of hogs. Hence its name, Hog Island.

In 1918 a devastating tornado-like storm swept water across the island and made a 225-yardwide channel. Two island were created when the narrow channel was widened even more by dynamite and a second severe storm, the hurricane of October, 1921.


The southern island was renamed Caladesi Island. It remains one of the few large undeveloped barrier islands off Florida's gulf coast and currently ranks second best beach in the United States. This island is still accessible only by ferry or private boat.

The northern island retained the name of Hog Island until the 1930s. By this time hograising had dwindled. The Island was purchased by a New York developer who constructed 50 palm-thatched "honeymoon" bungalows for use by couples chosen through a contest. Soon thereafter, the island was officially renamed "Honeymoon Island and remained a romantic getaway for some time.

The Dunedin Causeway, built in the 1960s, made Honeymoon Island accessible by car. The island now holds a few condominiums, but most of it is owned by the state of Florida. As a state recreation area, Honeymoon Island now offers quiet, relaxation, sun bathing, shelling, fishing, and hiking or biking on nature trails. Armadillos, nesting osprey, storks, horned owls and many water fowl can be seen in their natural habitat. Picnic shelters and ample facilities for large family gatherings are also available.

It is from Honeymoon Island that the Park gets its name. Thank heavens its name was changed back in the 1930s. If the name Honeymoon Park seems odd for a retirement community, just imagine a five-star park named after a hog!


