### **Manufactured Homes vs Flatpack**

The advantages of a manufactured home over the usual site-built home are obvious to us who live in them. They are made under controlled conditions in a place where the workers just make houses and get very efficient at what they do. They cost less and you know what you are getting when you order one. I'm pretty happy with mine, which was built by Jacobsen, in Palm Harbor.

But manufactured homes are just one option on a gray scale of prefabrication. They are at the "build and ship" end of that scale. There are various levels of "some assembly required" houses, ranging from modular, where the wall components fit together like pieces in a kids' construction kit, to flatpack, where the entire house, roof, walls, floor and interior, is shipped flat in a single truckload.

The latest developments in flatpack homes range from Cubicco, a Florida builder, to Britespace, a high-end product that looks like a piece of furniture, inside and out.

Cubicco houses range in price from \$58,000 to over \$100,000, making them roughly comparable to a manufactured home. They are designed and rated to withstand a Category 5 hurricane. Assembly takes a small crew several days. Otherwise, the carport, ground prep and landscaping are the same as any other home.

Britespace make an open, airy home that is priced on the higher end of the scale. However, they are exemplars of modern design, using bamboo and engineered wood structures that are quite appealing.

Decades ago I owned a franchise for Green Mountain Homes. They were modular, built with panels of a standard 16 foot size, and ranged from under a thousand square feet to over 3000 square feet. They were heated and cooled by a "basement" full of fist-sized river rocks and a clever heating/cooling system that stored heat or chilled the rocks to compensate for the weather. They were very well insulated and had many innovative features, but outside they looked a bit like a nice dairy barn in Vermont. It took two weeks to assemble a mid-sized house with a crew and a crane.

We sold them but I never got the chance to live in one.

Since then I have investigated many housing options, including my design, (with Chandra) a modular house made of our unique Hodari Strongboards. That series of inventions is intended to create a complete and decent shelter in an African village for about \$2500 US dollars.

The quest for shelter is basic, and our options are slowly improving.

### **For Men Who Cook**

In this enlightened age, men learn to cook simply in order to get their favorite meals. Especially if your wife is on a diet and her average dinner plate looks like a white space punctuated by three vegetables and one bite of chicken. But even the average Joe cannot live entirely on delivered pizza and hot dogs. So we cook our own recipes.

Here are two of mine: Golden Curry Chicken	
Ingredients (serves 3 or 4):	
1.5 lb skinless boneless chicken breast	

6 oz mushrooms, sliced

8 oz broccoli, cut in pieces

8 oz potatoes cut into 1" cubes

1 medium Spanish onion, chopped fine

large sliced carrot
tbsp Sesame oil
tbsp vegetable oil
squares of S\$B Golden Curry sauce mix
Curry powder to taste

Cut the chicken into 2" cubes. Heat up the sesame oil (for the flavor) and the vegetable oil on high heat in a wok or large frypan to the point of fragrance. Add the chopped onion slowly. A curry requires onion or it isn't a curry. Brown the onion slightly.

Add the cut up chicken and stir fry until it is lightly cooked (all white). Add the vegetables and stir fry them until they are lightly cooked. Add some curry powder (I use a tbsp) and stir a bit more.

Add 2 cups of water and return to a boil. Add in the golden curry cakes (the cakes are in sections, use two sections).

Turn down the heat to medium and boil for 20 minutes to half an hour, until the sauce thickens. Adjust the seasoning by adding curry powder to taste. Serve over rice or noodles.

Pairs well with pinot noir or a good IPA beer.

### Sauce and Shreds

I found this prize-winning recipe in a newspaper I was using to wrap glassware. It seems too simple to be believed, but it is good!

Ingredients (serves 2 or 3):

<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> large cabbage, shredded

1 lb Italian sausage (or your favorite spicy sausage) cut in small slices

<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> stick of butter

1 tbsnp vegetable oil

Salt, pepper, seasoning to taste

Heat the oil in large frypan or on high. Add the sausage and brown well. Add the butter and the cabbage. Stir fry for about ten minutes, or until the cabbage is softer but still crisp. Add salt, pepper, seasoning (I like Badia Saizon Completa). Serve in bowls.

The surprising flavor of cabbage sautéed in butter and oil combines with the spice in the sausage.

Pairs well with Mexican cerveza.

I bought my wok from the curb of someone here in IITS that wanted \$5 for it. Best investment I ever made.


