





Our Opinion

uring the HOA meeting on November 3rd, the by-laws committee presented proposed changes to the HOA by-laws. One of the proposed changes was very surprising to us. It reads as follows, "In order to be able to perform the duties required of them as a member of the Board, anyone nominated to the board should be a full time resident of the park".

This proposed by-law change is not a move forward for neither current nor future residents. Florida Statutes state that no resident can be prohibited from seeking to serve on the Board of Directors; however, this proposal is recommending all board members be full time residents. Why is this recommendation contrary to Florida Statutes?

In this case, the term "full time resident" is ambiguous. For example, if any of us decide to be away from our home here, just say 2 months or some other period of time, to enjoy an extended vacation, does this disqualify them from serving on the board too?

Let me tell you why we oppose this recommended change from the by-laws committee.

We all live in a neighborhood that is made up of residents that come from many different areas. From its inception, it has been comprised of people from other areas of the US and Canada. As time goes on, we have more and more year round residents coming to live here. Also, we have many residents who live elsewhere during the summer months but they choose to live here to enjoy our beautiful warm climate and socialize with friends until the summer heat arrives again when they "migrate" to a cooler climate. What a welcome sight when we begin seeing the first snowbirds arrive! Those of us who live here year round feel the "buzz" in the air! Many of our friends from the north want to be involved and participate in activities, actually, the winter activities have a much greater attendance because of them. Some of them want to participate in the business decisions the HOA board conducts. Why should our by-laws recommend they not be allowed to serve on the board? They pay the same amount of rent as year round residents and they have the same vested interest in the success and future improvements that we all strive for. Why should they be discriminated against just because their physical presence isn't here 12 months out of the year?

We should use 21st century technology to embrace everyone that owns a home here and not shun those who are not year round residents. Our by-laws require our HOA meetings adhere to Roberts Rules. Roberts Rules are current with the times and have an entire chapter regarding the use of electronic participation in meetings. Roberts Rules also state that there must be provisions in the by-laws authorizing electronic communications. Electronic communications can be as simple as a speaker telephone or free video conferencing available on the internet. The by-laws committee should step into the 21st century and utilize free and current technology to include all homeowners instead of recommending exclusion of those that are not year round.

It is our opinion that we vote NO to this by-law petition and step into the 21st century and request by-law changes that will allow our friends from the north to be nominated to participate on the HOA Board of Directors.





Get on pace for a healthy new year




