Have a very merry Christmas and New Year's, may God be with everyone and protect us during and after the Holidays.




November Spotlight On Kathy Reed

All garbage in Pinellas Co is incinerated. The process runs 24/7; with a 2 week break in the spring and fall for maintenance. After each burn the metal is collected to sell and

the burn creates electricity which is purchased by Duke Power.

The byproduct of the burn is ash. The capacity to store the ash at the current rate of burn is 83 years. Periodically trash is opened and analyzed to determine it's % of recyclables. The last time it was 75%. If more recycling is done it will lengthen the life-time of the ash pile.

Recycling tips:

Keep food out of recycling bins.

Do not recycle pizza boxes, the oil and food on the cardboard cause contamination.

Do rinse plastic containers once or twice and put the lid back on before recycling. It is ok if some of the liquid soap or beverage is inside.

Lids reapplied, keep the other recyclables dry.

Do not put plastic bags of any kind in recycling bins, it wraps around the sorting machines and requires a machine shut down and manual removal.

Do not attempt to recycle rubber hoses.

Plastic bags, plastic wrappers from toilet paper and paper towels can be taken to Publix, Target and Walmart for recycling.

Here is something interesting! They will bring a mobile hazardous waste truck, for one day, to our community at no charge. That would be convenient!

John and I put on events for 4 years till we were asked to step down. We graciously did. Yet we still volunteer. Not because the event wants our help or they do not have enough volunteers but because of what volunteering means to us.

We have always pushed for our IITS Community and the great people here. A community should be a strong togetherness of individuals, families and friends, neighbors who live and play together. We need no other incentive, just being good neighbors.

Being a volunteer in a Community like IITS is a rewarding experience IF you volunteer for the right reasons.

Those who are new to having events sometimes have to learn "the hard way". And they will. Some people who put on events do not have an idea of what they are doing. It's their first time but they did volunteer to provide some type of program for you.

Membership

John Hisiro, FMO Regional President, presented his experiences as an MHP resident and FMO officer to the IITS community on October 25. A dozen or so IITS residents agreed to sign up for FMO membership due to that meeting.

I will attend the FMO representatives meeting in Clearwater on November 15.

Retention of HOA Records

The HOA is required to retain certain records, such as contracts and meeting minutes, for at least 7 years. Any resident may request these records for inspection on 10 days notice.

Certification of Board Members

As of October 1, 2017, all elected HOA Board members are required to be certified under Florida State Law 723.0781. The FMO conducts these seminars and has certified 1,303 persons to date. Six seminars are scheduled for 2018, the nearest of which is in North Fort Myers on Friday, January 19, 2018. Pre-registration ends on January 5. The \$25 per person charge may be paid by the HOA, if approved.







Book Recommendation:

Here Vultures Fly

by Rudy Rodrigues

This is the narration of the personal experiences of the author, Rudy Rodrigues, during his ten years of service with the United Nations in Afghanistan, where he was engaged in emergency relief and later rehabilitation programs in close collaboration with the Communist government, the mujahideen, the Taliban, and the post-Taliban government.

The author was responsible for opening the first UNICEF office in Kyrgyzstan soon after the collapse of the Soviet Union in a unique environment and culture. During this time, he was working with a government unfamiliar with the United Nations and its goals and objectives. In addition, the Kyrgyz population was traumatized by this sudden period of transition and uncertainty. A major focus of the author's work was gaining the



confidence of the government in Uzbekistan and to ensure the building of meaningful partnership programs for women and children.

This book also covers the adventures, romance, and thrill of being born and raised in Kenya; serving as an officer in the army; the challenges of working in Papua New Guinea; and having the glorious opportunity of working in the UN in different parts of the world with a multiethnic/multicultural community.

About the Author

Rudy Rodrigues was born and raised in Kenya. He graduated from the Royal Military Academy Sandhurst and the British Army Staff College. He was commissioned and served as an officer in the Kenya Army in both command and staff appointments. Resigning after sixteen years of active service, he then immigrated to Canada with his wife and three children.

Later, Rodrigues was appointed country director of a Canadian NGO in the Sudan, with a mandate to provide leadership, strategic planning and the delivery of UN (WFP) emergency relief supplies to the more than three million starving people displaced by the famine of 1985. He did so using a fleet of 350 cargo vehicles and a staff of over 3,000 people. This trucking operation was later taken over by the UN, and Rodrigues served as its Director.

In 2006 Rodrigues ended his career, and moved from Afghanistan, where he was last working with the United Nations. He retired to Winter Park, Florida where he lives today, and enjoys traveling, writing and spending time with his family, children and grandchildren.
