Clearwater residents can obtain a Resident Recreation Card by completing an application and showing two proofs of residency (utility bill, voter I.D., tax receipt or rent slip). Non-Resident Recreation Cards are for persons living outside Clearwater city limits and not paying Clearwater property taxes.

Profile on Stann Chernicak, New Activities Director Lot # 299, 727-599-4144

I had the pleasure of interviewing Stann (he spells his name with two n's), and found out he is a most interesting person with personality plus. Stann was born in New York City, grew up there and in New Jersey. He attended a military high school and was active in ROTC. He later attended college in San Diego, California. He is a veteran of the US Air Force and after 4 years, he finished his hitch as a 1st Lieutenant.

His sister came to this area in 1965 to attend the University of Tampa and his parents moved to New Port Richey, so Stann vacationed here and fell in love with Florida.

In 2010 Stann retired at age 62. He and Laura moved here in 2009 to help care for Stann's sister who had dementia. They previously lived at Top of the World before moving to IITS.

A couple more interesting facts are that Stan had driven cross country 30 times and he is a Harley enthusiast. Stann is the talker in the family. He is knowledgeable in so many areas. Laura sits fairly quietly by his side and smiles. She appears to love all the stories he tells about his life. When they bought their home, they got a golf cart as part of the deal, and riding around the community is a favorite pastime. Laura still works at Mease Countryside, but Stann is home a lot during the day, so stop and chat and share your ideas for activities. His mission is to make Island in the Sun a really fun place to live.

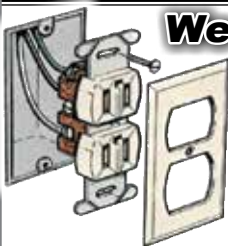

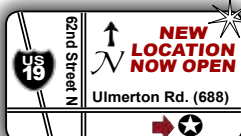

It's that time of year Hurricane Season

High winds, heavy rains or possible tornadoes are not the deadliest hazard during a hurricane. The deadliest hazard is the storm surge – a dome of water pushed ashore by high winds. In a worst case scenario, this can mean a surge of 29 feet above the normal water level, causing tremendous damage and danger of drowning. While those residents who can see the gulf or the bay have a visual reminder of how vulnerable they are to the water, residents who live miles from these bodies of water can still be vulnerable to storm surge. That's why it's critical to identify your evacuation level and act appropriately should an order go into effect. Even if you have lived in Pinellas County for a long time, it's more important than ever to check your home's evacuation level. To find your level: • Visit www.pinellascounty.org/emergency, click on Know Your Zone. • Look up Know Your Zone on the Pinellas County Doing Things for Your app. • Call (727) 453-3150 and enter your 10-digit home phone number (does not work for cell phone numbers). • Look on your Pinellas County water bill. • Look on your Truth in Millage (TRIM) notice. • Call (727) 464-3800 and speak with Emergency Management staff.

We normally have the Red Cross come in, talk with us and you can ask questions.

Hurricane Preparedness



Making sure you and your loved ones will survive the storm is a year-round task that requires attention to your personal business, your family members, your home and your vehicles. It is not a task that can be done in just 24 hours, so start your planning now!

Complete a disaster plan BEFORE the chaos of an approaching hurricane to be sure you have time to do it right. Do home improvements during the cooler days of the year. Pack your Emergency Survival Kits before June 1st to be sure you have what you need. Organize important papers so you can grab them quickly.
