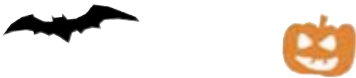

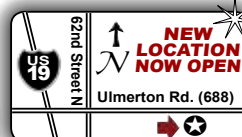

Dog Parade: 6:00 PM

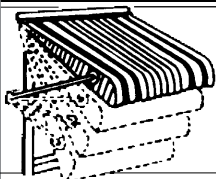
Golf Cart Parade: 7:30

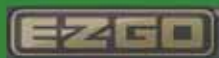

The two topics of discussion were our aches and pains and the best places to get great food with large portions and reasonable prices.

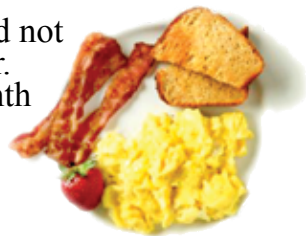
During the aches and pains session, there were some very funny anecdotes told which made us laugh and forget about our health.

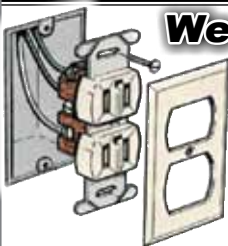

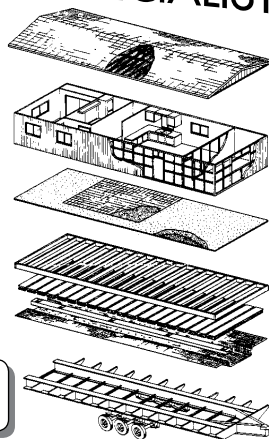

- Keep a small magnet in your sewing basket; it's handy for rounding up wayward pins or dropped needles.

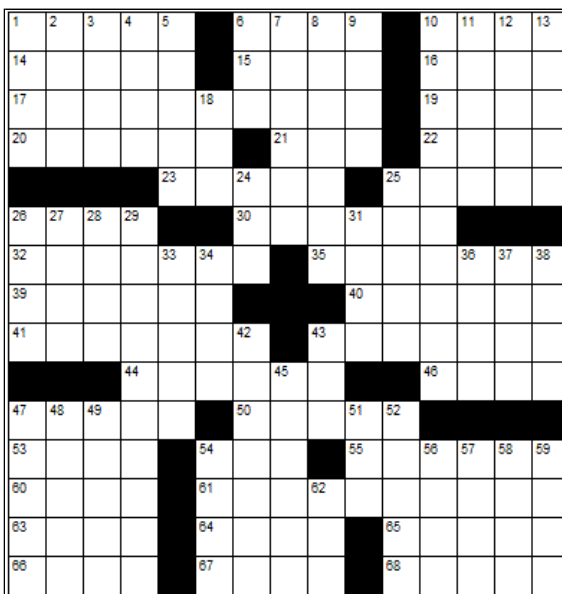

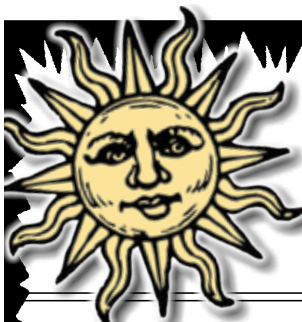
