Spotlight on Residents – Dick Tilton

Last Month's Spotlight Article was incomplete. We are sorry for the omission. The entire article is being republished below:

Dick Tilton is a soft spoken, big man, with a laid back demeanor. He is very quiet until you get him going, and then he is full of laughter and stories.

Dick was born and raised in a little town named Fulton, in upstate New York. Fulton lies between Rochester and Syracuse. While in high school, he drove a cab part time. He was very active in sports. He was on the football team until he and some of his friends got caught smoking, and the coach threw them off the team. Then he made the soccer team, but after being struck by a puck, he suffered a broken foot and that ended his soccer career. He also spent some time playing softball.



A lot of the boys in Fulton became friends with Dick as he is a quite likeable fellow. He referred to this group as a "gang", but not like the "gangs"

of today. They were all Boy Scouts and just hung out together, but sometimes got into a bit of mischief, not to hurt anyone or anything, but just to have fun. His grandmother owned some acreage in Fulton and leased part of it to a man who raised cantaloupe. Dick and his buddies used to go into the field and steal some of the melons. A railroad had been built through town and right through the middle of his grandmother's property. The boys used to get up on a bridge and when the engine passed they would throw cantaloupes on the train. Often they were seen, but never caught. They also threw snowballs in the wintertime. This spot was up on a hill and you could see the town and the police station from that spot. They watched and laughed as the police made their way up the hill, but by the time they got there, all the boys had disappeared. Dick got quite a chuckle telling me about this.

After graduation, he joined the navy in 1941. The attack on Pearl Harbor was over so he felt this would be a good time to enlist. He was in Samson, New York for boot camp, then his group was sent by train to Philadelphia and then on to Rocky Mount, North Carolina. Upon arriving in North Carolina about 30-40 of the men saw a neon sign that said "Beer", so they went hustling over to the little dive to get some beer. Dick was smart enough not to follow them and it's a good thing because the bus left without them and to this day, Dick does not know what happened to those guys left behind. Dick and the others went on to Miami and then Key West where they attended "sound school" where they learned about sonar. Dick chased submarines with a sonar machine while in the Navy.

Dick was an only child and his parents were in bad shape, so the Navy gave him an honorable discharge so he could go back to Fulton. His folks had a little cottage right on the lake so

he did lots of fishing and swimming. Dick drove a bakery truck and Shirley, the girl he married, worked in a bakery for the same company. They did lots of roller skating growing up and later did lots of camping in an RV in New York, after their marriage. They married in 1950 and had two daughters and a son. Their son died quite young. Tragedy stuck again years later when their oldest daughter passed away in Oregon and her son's death followed. Dick's wife passed of a heart attack six years ago in 2009 after 59 years of marriage. His youngest daughter, Sherrie is married and is "head" of the Bay Care corporate office located on Drew behind the park. Her son works at Mease Countryside. Sherrie comes once or twice every week to visit Dick and check up on him and they have a good time together.

Dick had a desire to move to California so he and his folks bought a trailer and moved there, first to a motel, then an apartment in Compton, CA near Los Angeles. He found out that General Motors in Southgate, CA was hiring so he and a group of other guys took tests. Dick had the highest score of all, so he was hired immediately, first as an instructor, then later as a foreman. He worked for Kimberly Clark for the union after the job at General Motors.

After about 4 years the family moved back to Rochester and Dick worked for Spector Freight for 23 years. This company later went out of business. He worked for Preston Freight for about 3 years.

Dick and his family and wife's family. moved back to California a 2nd time and worked for Smith Brothers trucking. This was a fun job setting up props and scenes for movies. He had the pleasure of working with Johnny Weismuller on the Tarzan movie set.

At age 62, Dick and Shirley had lived in the north long enough and was tired of the cold weather, so he retired and they moved here 27 years ago in 1988. They were among some of the first residents in Island in the Sun. Dick and Shirley were both bowlers and he worked as a pinsetter at a local bowling alley. He was in a league with men in Island in the Sun for 20+ years. Their favorite bowling alley finally closed so Dick gave up the sport.

Dick pulled out old pictures of his family, wife and children, bowling pictures, etc.

I was engrossed looking at all of that and spent several hours talking with him. He seemed very pleased that I selected him to write about and told me really enjoyed reminiscing about so many things he had not even thought about in years. Dick has been very lonely since his wife passed and doesn't really have any hobbies or interests now.

- 2. Bake until golden and bubbling, 10 to 12 minutes. With a thin metal spatula, transfer crisps to a serving plate to cool.

Avoiding the dentist? It may cost you

Proper dental care is important to your overall health. Unfortunately, many of us tend to avoid visiting the dentist—often because of the cost.

A survey commissioned by Aspen Dental found that almost two out of five Americans have delayed needed dental work, or had it only partially performed, because of their financial situation. It's a figure that has jumped by almost 8 percent over the last two years, even though 80 percent say they're aware that staying away from the dentist will be more expensive in the long run.



Take one step to lose weight

ant to lose weight? Step onto a scale every day. That may seem like obvious advice, but it's supported by the results of a study reported on the Live Science website.

In the study, researchers challenged 162 people to reduce their weight by 10 percent over the course of the year. They weren't given any specific advice, but about half the participants were given scales and told to check and record their weight every morning.

Although few of the participants in either group achieved their goal of losing 10 percent of their body weight, 29 percent of those given scales succeeded in losing at least 5 percent, but only 11 percent in the scale-free group lost as much. In addition, participants given scales managed to maintain their weight loss for a second year.

The researchers have theorized that checking weight once a day may help people pay more attention to what they eat (and how much), and reinforce positive weight-loss behaviors like skipping dessert.
