Dog Parks in the Pinellas Area

The are very fortunate to have several great dog parks in our area. Many breeds and larger dogs need more exercise than just a walk around our community. These parks allow the dogs to be off leash and run free and have fun with other dogs. The following is a list of dog parks and where they are located.

- 1. Enterprise Dog Park 2671 Enterprise Rd E Clearwater
- 2. Park Hours: Mon 9:00 am sunset, Tuesday Thursday sunrise sunset
- 3. Friday 11 am sunset, Saturday & Sunday sunrise sunset
- 4. This is probably the biggest dog park in our area and boasts walking trails, doggie water fountains, rinse station, doggie waste bags, 2 canopy covered picnic tables, agility equipment and lots of room for Fido to run free.
- 5. Crest Lake Dog Park (Doggie Days Dog Park) 201 S Glenwood Avenue, Clearwater
- 6. One of the most popular dog parks in Clearwater, this one has four enclosed areas for dogs to run according to weight. Water stations are available as well as poop bags. There are benches and shaded areas and the grass is well kept. You also have a fantastic view of Crest Lake and a path that leads around the lake and back to the park. Free parking is available.
- 7. Safety Harbor Dog Park located 940 7th Street S. Safety Harbor. This park is well hidden behind the baseball fields and family park area. There is lots of shade and the park is divided into two sections for large and smaller dogs. Not as big as many but it's never busy and provides benches and washrooms nearby.
- 8. Eagle Lake Dog Park is located at 1800 Keene Rd in Largo. There are three enclosed ...continued on page 14



areas for different size dogs. Located in the center of Eagle Lake Park this is a serene beautiful place. Large areas for dogs to run. Not as much shade but benches are provided. Washrooms available nearby.

- **9.** Happy Trails Dog Park is located at 3051 Garrison Rd in Dunedin. A further drive but a nice park.
- 10. This is a well-hidden gem located behind the ball fields. There is plenty of room for the dogs to run and sections for large and small dogs. Well shaded and plenty of seating, with water hose and hand sanitizer available.
 - 11. Sand Key Dog Park located at 1060 Gulf Blvd Clearwater. This a large well-kept dog park divided into two sections for large and small dogs. A water station is available. Located at Sand Key Park, there is a fee for parking. Dogs are not allowed on the beach, but this park has water stations and shaded areas. Lots of room for the dogs.

These are just a few of the wonderful dog parks available in our vicinity. Be sure to check them out and one day soon perhaps we will boast about our own Island in the Sun Dog Park.





Beach Safety

very summer, people pack their bathing suits, sunscreen, flip flops and a good book for a trip to the beach. Or, perhaps where you live, you are fortunate to have beach weather for the greater part of the year. Regardless of how often you get to sink your toes into the sand, the American Red Cross has some beach safety tips and steps you can take to be make sure you and your family remain safe.

Ocean Safety

Swimming in the ocean takes different skills, so before you get your feet wet, it's best to learn <u>how to swim</u> in the surf. You should also swim only at a lifeguard-protected beach, within the designated swimming area. Obey all instructions and orders from lifeguards.

While you're enjoying the water, keep alert and check the local weather conditions. Make sure you swim sober and that you never swim alone. And even if you're confident in your swimming skills, make sure you have enough energy to swim back to shore.

Other beach safety tips to keep in mind:

- Have young children or inexperienced swimmers wear U.S. Coast Guard-approved life
 jackets in and the around water. No one should use any other type of floatation device
 unless they are able to swim.
- Don't dive headfirst—protect your neck. Check for depth and obstructions before diving and go in feet first the first time.
- Pay especially close attention to children and elderly persons when at the beach. Even in shallow water, wave action can cause a loss of footing.
- Keep a lookout for aquatic life. Water plants and animals may be dangerous. Avoid patches of plants. Leave animals alone.

Rip Currents

Rip currents are responsible for deaths on our nation's beaches every year, and for most of the rescues performed by lifeguards. Beachgoers should be aware of how dangerous rip currents are, and swim only at beaches with lifeguards in the designated swimming area. Rip currents can form in any large open water area, such as low spots and breaks in sandbars, or near structures such as jetties and piers.

For your safety, be aware of the danger of rip currents and remember the following:

- If you are caught in a rip current, stay calm and don't fight the current.
- Swim parallel to the shore until you are out of the current. Once you are free, turn and swim toward shore.
- If you can't swim to the shore, float or tread water until you are free of the rip current and then head toward shore.
- If you feel you can't make it to the shore, draw attention to yourself by waving and calling for help.
- Stay at least 100 feet away from piers and jetties. Permanent rip currents often exist near these structures.
- If someone is in trouble in the water, get help from a lifeguard. If a lifeguard is not available, have someone call 9-1-1. Throw the victim something that floats a lifejacket, cooler, inflatable ball and yell instructions on how to escape the current.
- When at the beach, check conditions before entering the water. Check to see if any warning flags are up or ask a lifeguard about water conditions, beach conditions, or any potential hazards.
