
She enjoys living in Florida and is very impressed with the high level of medical care she feels she gets here. She said seniors don't fare as well in Connecticut.

Say hello to her! She is very easy going and friendly.





## Help for Severe Aortic Stenosis



Severe aortic stenosis is a narrowed aortic heart valve that doesn't open and close properly, reducing blood flow to the rest of the body.

### Thanksgiving and Harvest Festivals Around the World

Te all know how we celebrate Thanksgiving in the United States. Do you ever wonder how other countries celebrate their Thanksgiving, and what they have to be thankful for?

For instance, our Canadian neighbors celebrate their Thanksgiving on the 2nd Monday in October – For 2017, October 9th.

Canada: The first Canadian Thanksgiving was celebrated in 1872 in gratitude for King Edward VII's recovery from a serious illness, but it took until 1957 for Parliament to establish the second Monday in October as the official Thanksgiving Day.

Typically, Canadians eat their Thanksgiving meal on Sunday. Similar to the UK Harvest Festival, they decorate churches with cornucopias. Today, much like its southern neighbor, Canada celebrates its holiday with parades, football, and a big turkey on the table.

### China: "Chung Chiu" Moon Festival

Families gather on the 15th day of the eighth lunar cycle to celebrate the autumn harvest. The Chinese reunite with family for a large three-day feast featuring mooncakes, sweet cakes filled with sesame seeds, ground lotus seeds, and duck eggs embossed with a baker's insignia. The mooncake's center is filled with a salty yolk (an acquired taste) to represent the full moon. Families and friends often exchange them as a sign of unity and peace.

### **United Kingdom: Harvest Festival**

Saxon farmers would offer the first cut sheaf of corn and a sacrificial animal to one of their fertility gods to ensure a bountiful harvest. It was thought that the Spirit of the Corn lived in that first cut, and the tradition of making plaited corn dolls to hang in rafters each year began in order to protect the rest of the harvest.

Today, the English still make the corn dolls and still celebrate the harvest with a supper that features the season's produce. Children also take gifts of fruit and vegetables to churches and schools, which are distributed to the elderly and needy of the community.

### **Germany: Erntedankfest**

The German harvest celebration is observed in September or October. The day begins with a sermon, followed by a procession in which a traditional harvest crown is presented to the harvest queen, Ernteknigin. The day is further celebrated with music, dancing, and a bounty of fruits and vegetables from the harvest. While it's not a grand day of family get-togethers and feasting like Thanksgiving in America, the unused food is distributed to the needy. There isn't a turkey, either. Instead, chickens are fattened up in time for the feast. In some places, there is also an evening service followed by a lantern and torch parade, with fireworks for the children.

### Malaysia: "Kadazan Harvest" Celebration

What is just a side dish to us in the U.S., is a point of celebration in Sabah, Malaysia: Rice. This religious holiday is observed in May, after a season in the rice patties, to honor the rice god, Semangat, to offer gratitude for the good harvest.

Carnivals are an important part of the celebration, as are cultural programs, agricultural shows, buffalo races, and traditional games. Homemade rice wine is distributed among locals dressed in traditional costumes.



### **Greece:** Tsiknopempti

Fans of steak and BBQ probably value this day more than even Christmas or Easter, and there's a good reason for that. In Greece there's nothing similar to Thanksgiving except Tsiknopempti, the closest thing the country has to a Harvest Festival. It's one of the traditional celebrations of February's Carnival season in Greece. It always falls on a Thursday, and this is where it gets its name, since Tsiknopempti loosely translated means "Barbecue Thursday." It's the time for the Greeks to thank the Lord for the bounties He gave them during the year, and to gain strength for the next forty days of fasting, the Lenten days before Easter.

So during Tsiknopempti the mouth-watering aromas of barbecuing meats fill every corner of every street in Greece. At night, the hosts of the family reunions lay out vast amounts of souvlaki, gyros, lamb, and pork. Add lots of wine, and the night ends with plenty of high-

spirited plate smashing and joyous dancing.

### Thanksgiving- Who Came First?

s Americans, we all enjoy our Thanksgiving holiday and everything it entails – a good Thanksgiving meal, with all Lathe trimmings: turkey or ham, potatoes, stuffing, green bean casserole, pumpkin or pecan pie, or whatever is traditional for your family. Whether it is cooked at home with other family members, eaten at a restaurant (easy clean up!), or prepared as part of a community meal, like we have at IITS, the tradition is the same – celebrating 'Thanksgiving', whatever that means to each individual. Also, watching the Macy's Thanksgiving Day Parade is a huge tradition –

and to all the football fans out there, endless games!

I thought it would be interesting for everyone to see and compare the differences between Jamestown and Plymouth, the earliest settlements in North America. Which are you descended from?

Jamestown and Plymouth: Compare and Contrast

Traveling aboard the Susan Constant, Godspeed and Discovery, 104 men landed in Virginia in 1607 at a place they named Jamestown. This was the first permanent English settlement in the New World

Thirteen years later, 102 settlers aboard the Mayflower landed in Massachusetts at a place they named Plymouth. With these two colonies, English settlement in North America was born.

### LÓCATION OF THE SETTLEMENTS

Jamestown offered anchorage and a good defensive position. Warm climate and fertile soil allowed large plantations to prosper.

Plymouth provided good anchorage and an excellent harbor. Cold climate and thin, rocky soil limited farm size. New Englanders turned to lumbering, shipbuilding, fishing and trade.

### REASONS FOR THE COLONIES

Economic motives prompted colonization in Virginia. The Virginia Company of London, organized in 1606, sponsored the Virginia Colony. Organizers of the company wanted to expand Continued on page 17

English trade and obtain a wider market for English manufactured goods. They naturally hoped for financial profit from their investment in shares of company stock.

Freedom from religious persecution motivated the Pilgrims to leave England and settle in Holland, where there was more religious freedom. However, after a number of years the Pilgrims felt that their children were being corrupted by the liberal Dutch lifestyle and were losing their English heritage. News of the English Colony in Virginia motivated them to leave Holland and settle in the New World.

### EARLY SETBACKS

Inexperience, unwillingness to work, and the lack of wilderness survival skills led to bickering, disagreements, and inaction at Jamestown. Poor Indian relations, disease, and the initial absence of the family unit compounded the problems.

Cooperation and hard work were part of the Pilgrim's lifestyle. Nevertheless, they too were plagued with hunger, disease, and environmental hazards.

### RELIGIOUS DIFFERENCES

The settlers at Jamestown were members of the Anglican faith, the official Church of England.

The Pilgrims were dissenters from the Church of England and established the Puritan or Congregational Church.

### GOVERNMENT

In 1619, the first representative legislative assembly in the New World met at the Jamestown church. It was here that our American heritage of representative government was born. Since New England was outside the jurisdiction of Virginia's government, the Pilgrims established a self-governing agreement of their own, the "Mayflower Compact."

### NATIVE AMERICANS

The Virginia colonists settled in the territory of a strong Indian empire or chiefdom. English relations with the Powhatan Indians were unstable from the beginning. Vast differences in culture, philosophies, and the English desire for dominance were obstacles too great to overcome. After the Indian uprising in 1622, the colonists gave up attempts to christianize and live peacefully with the Powhatans.

Prior to the Pilgrims' arrival, an epidemic wiped out the majority of the New England Indians. Several survivors befriended and assisted the colonists. Good relations ended in 1636 when the Massachusetts Bay Puritans declared war on the Pequot Tribe and Plymouth was dragged into the conflict.

### LEGENDS

Who married Pocahontas? Some erroneously believe John Smith did. In actuality, she married John Rolfe, an Englishman who started the tobacco industry in Virginia. The John Smith connection stems from Smith's later writings relating an incidence of Pocahontas saving his life

According to Longfellow's epic, The Courtship of Miles Standish, John Alden proposed to Priscilla Mullins on behalf of Standish and she replied, "Why don't you speak for yourself, John?" Priscilla did in fact marry John Alden at Plymouth. The records do not mention Standish ever courting Priscilla.

### THANKSGIVING

On December 4, 1619 settlers stepped ashore at Berkeley Hundred along the James River and, in accordance with the proprietor's instruction that "the day of our ship's arrival ... shall be yearly and perpetually kept as a day of thanksgiving," celebrated the first official Thanksgiving Day.

In the fall of 1621, the Pilgrims held a celebration to give thanks to God for his bounty and blessings. This occasion was the origin of the traditional Thanksgiving as we know it today.

### CONCLUSION

The growth and development of these two English colonies, though geographically separated, contributed much to our present American heritage of law, religion, government, custom and language. As Governor Bradford of Plymouth stated,

"Thus out of small beginnings greater things have been produced by His hand that made all things of nothing, and gives being to all things that are; and as one small candle may light a thousand, so the light here kindled hath shown unto many, yea, in some sort, to our whole Nation."

The charter of the Virginia Company stated,

"Lastly and chiefly the way to prosper and achieve good success is to make yourselves all of one mind for the good of your country and your own, and to serve and fear God the giver of all goodness, for every plantation which our father hath not planted shall be rooted out."

### **Opossums**

The possum that used to live under my house is gone now, trapped by the city. He, more likely she, left her little splayed sandy footprints across my driveway every morning. I called her "Edith" because she edith just about anything.

The Virginia Opossum is the only marsupial left in the United States, having migrated here from Central America when that land bridge was established.

They range in size from mouse to large cat. They are omnivorous, but prefer fruit and human food waste. They are primarily nocturnal. Until recently, possum was a popular food animal in the South and even the Joy of Cooking had a recipe for possum pie. Apparently, hawks, large snakes, and alligators also like possum on their menus.

Yes, a frightened possum plays dead and actually emits a foul liquid from its anus. It smells dead. It's not an act, it's a wired-in response. A threatened possum will hiss and show sharp teeth before it plays possum.

The possum has a very tiny brain and a very short life, only two years. A single female can have as many as 39 young every year, although few will survive. They are immune to snake and frog venoms and poisons. They rarely transmit diseases to humans and are surprisingly resistant to rabies, most likely because they have lower body temperatures than most placental mammals. In addition, opossums limit the spread of Lyme disease, as they successfully kill off most disease-carrying ticks that feed on them. They will, however, nest in the insulation under your house and tear up the poly liner.

We don't often see Perergrine falcons in IITS. The one I saw was perched on a 4 x 4 in one of our empty lots. I tried for a picture but it was too wary.

The Peregrine is a ferocious feathered missile that punches way above it's 3-pound weight. Not much bigger than a seagull, it power dives, ("stoops") at twice the speed of a pitched fastball and knocks ducks and pigeons right out of the air, breaking their bones on impact. They have been observed going 240 miles per hour in a stoop, making them the fastest creatures on Earth. Any bird of equal size is prey, even small owls and falcons.

Prey is typically struck and captured in mid-air; the peregrine falcon strikes its prey with a clenched foot, stunning or killing it with the impact, then turns to catch it in mid-air. If its prey is too heavy to carry, a peregrine will drop it to the ground and eat it there. If they miss the initial strike, peregrines will chase their prey in a twisting flight.

Peregrines are found everywhere except in the polar regions. They nest in tall buildings, trees and cliffs. They mate for life, and live about 15 years. The mated pair returns to the same site every year at nesting time. The falcons will defend their nests against foxes, bears and wolves. They have been known to attack and kill bald eagles that raided their nests.

Peregrines are highly desirable birds for falconry. They are relatively easy to train and always eager to hunt. They are used to control the pigeon populations at airports in order to reduce bird strikes on aircraft.

For you scrabble players, the smaller male is called a tiercel. The larger female is the falcon.




