

I id you know that you can purchase stamps and mail packages thru our U.S. Mail Carrier? To purchase stamps, all I do is leave an envelope with "Mail Man" written across the front of it. Inside, I place a note letting him know how many stamps I need and enough money to cover the cost of the stamps. The next day he leaves my stamps and any change that might be left.

To mail a package . . . .

- On your computer, Log on to USPS.com.
- Place your cursor over "Mail and Ship" and a drop-down list will appear.
- Click on "Schedule a Pickup" from the drop-down list.
- Fill in the requested information and click "CHECK AVAILABILITY".

Note: This is located below the "Privacy Act Statement".

- Answer the question, "Where should we look for your shipment?"
- Answer the question, "What time should we pick up?"

Note: I strongly suggest that you answer this with, "During your regular mail delivery", as this service is free!

- Answer the question, "When should we pick up?", by clicking on an available date from the calendar provided.
- Roll down to the final question, "How many items are we picking up?"
- Supply the requested information.
- Be sure to click the box in front of the statement, "I have read, understand, and agree . . . ."
- Now, click on "Schedule a Pickup".

Additional information:

- The package must already have the correct postage on it. A lot of the things that I order have a return label which takes care of the postage.
- You can return your package, via the mail carrier, even if it is to be shipped using UPS or FedEx. These two companies have a deal with USPS that any of their packages that are put into the U.S. Mail, will be forwarded.




