Biggest bird ever lived long ago

The largest known bird to ever soar the skies lived about 28 million years ago in North America, according to paleontologists (and the Sci-News website). Pelagornis sandersi had a wingspan of close to 21 feet, more than twice the span of the largest living bird, the royal albatross. With such massive wings, it could have flown great distances over the ocean in search of prey. The pelagornis belongs to a category of ancient birds called Pelagornithidae, which once ruled the skies but went extinct about 3 million years ago.





Believe it or not? We're going with 'not'

istory is full of practical jokers, some more successful than others. Check out these three tales of hoaxes that seemed plausible—before they fell apart:
