



MY HEP-C ADVENTURE - PART 3

A

lright! The fight begins! In this next Part of my Hep-C Adventure, I am going to briefly describe what I went through in my first round of treatments for the Hep-C virus.

My Hep-C doctor, Dr. Fern, wanted to start me on a 6-month round of treatments. At that time, the treatments for "my type" of Hepatitis-C had a cure rate of around 30%. Because I had no insurance to pay for these treatments (the prescriptions alone were over \$5,000 per month), I asked Dr. Fern about any alternatives. He told me that considering the stage of the virus at that time (without a cure), my life expectancy was about 5 years.

(Note: Don't let that 30% scare you! Treatments have improved a great deal, since then!)

He also told me that, if I were not working, he knew of a fund that he could probably get me into, and that would pay for about half of the treatment costs. I was really struggling to work, so I quit my job (on Doctor's advice) and we started planning for the treatment. The treatment consisted of ONE pill every day, ONE shot (which I injected into my stomach) each week and weekly visit to the doctor for blood draws and checkups.

After about 3 months, my body was not dealing very well with the medication and my Hep-C viral-load started testing zero, so Dr. Fern ended the treatments. He told me that if it did not reappear within 3 years, he could then declare it CURED! However, if it is going to reappear, it would normally do it within the first year after the end of treatments.

(Note: When the viral-load tests zero, it does not necessary mean that it is totally gone. It just means that it is either gone or it is so low that the test cannot detect it.)

After a few months to recover from the treatments, I got a job with a consulting company whose health insurance did not have a pre-existing clause. Since the Hep-C could possibly reappear and because of the damage that had been done to my liver, I made sure that I had health insurance. That first round of treatments - even with the help that I received from the fund - had eaten up all of my regular savings and a big chunk of my retirement savings.

The assignment I was working on at that time was out-of-state. That made it hard to do my regular blood draws to check on my viral-load. The good part of this assignment was that the money was very good. In addition to my salary, they paid a generous living allowance. I was hopeful that I could recover financially.

After a few months on this new assignment, I wasn't feeling very well. I told myself that it was because of the extra stress brought on by being away from home. However just to be sure, I made arrangements with a doctor in that area to have a blood draw and send the results to Dr. Fern.

You guessed it! The Hep-C was back!

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR ALL

hanks to Dorothy Ravener, I have prepared helpful information which I have taken from the Florida Consumer eNEWSLETTER.

1 - Hurricane Preparedness Tips

Hurricane season is June 1 through November 30. Weather experts predict that the 2018 hurricane season will be "slightly above average." Hurricane Irma served as a stark reminder that it is imperative to prepare your family and home for potential hurricanes.

Have a Plan – Prior to the threat of a disaster, families can create a personalized Family Disaster Plan at <u>FloridaDisaster.org/GetaPlan</u>. This site provides checklists and important steps to take before, during and after the disaster.

Home Repair – Be cautious of repair businesses or individuals who solicit door-to-door in the wake of a hurricane. Check each contractor's address, license and complaint history prior to hiring by calling the Department of Business and Professional Regulation at 850-487-1395, or visit their website at MyFloridaLicense.com.

Food Safety – Power may go out due to storm winds, potentially affecting food storage. Get food safety tips at FreshFromFlorida.com/Divisions-Offices/Food-Safety.

Generator Safety – Portable generators are useful during power outages, but they can also be dangerous. Carbon monoxide poisoning can occur from generators or grills when they are used indoors, in partially enclosed spaces, or near vents or windows that allow fumes to enter your home.

Visit <u>Carbon Monoxide Safety Toolkit</u> for more information.

2 - Elder Abuse

Abuse can take many forms, among them frauds and scams. Below are some scams that target senior citizens:

- The IRS Phone Scam A scammer posing as an Internal Revenue Service (IRS) agent calls unsuspecting seniors, claims that they owe money and threatens a lawsuit. The IRS will never call to inform you of a pending suit.
- **Medicare Fraud** Someone may pose as a Medicare representative to get seniors to provide their personal information, which is used by the scammer to bill Medicare and pocket the money.
- Tax Fraud A criminal files taxes using a stolen Social Security or Employee ID number to collect a victim's tax return.
- Internet Fraud Pop-up browser windows simulating virus-scanning software will fool victims into either downloading a fake anti-virus program or an actual virus that may gain access to Grandparent Scheme Scammers pose as the victim's grandchild and describe a dire situation involving the grandchild with instructions on how and where the grandparent should send money.

Remember - don't fall victim of a scammer!



3 - Typosquatting

Seniors are encouraged to educate themselves on how to avoid scams and fraud. Technology opens up a new avenue for scams, including "typosquatting."

Typosquatting occurs when scammers trick web surfers into downloading harmful computer viruses and providing personal information. They can also trick vulnerable children into viewing adult content.

These scammers set up web addresses that resemble legitimate addresses but contain a common typo, such as ending a web address with ".cm" instead of ".com." If a user mistakenly types in the wrong address, they may be directed to a website containing viruses and malware, or a website that is designed to gather personal data for scammers.

Consumers can help protect themselves from typosquatting scams by taking the following steps:

- 1. Always double-check the web address before entering a website to help avoid bogus sites that aim to steal personal information.
- 2. Use a search engine. If you are not sure of a certain website address, consider using a search engine like Google or Bing. Search engines, such as Google, have algorithms help point you in the right direction; and
- 3. Be wary of links found in social media posts, which can often lead to typosquatters. Look for red flags in the web address, including:
- Extra text following a ".com," such as www.example. com-(text);
- A misspelling of the company's name; or
- Typos in the domain (.com, .gov, .org, etc.), such as the web address ending with ".cm" instead of ".com."

Spotting fake websites is not always easy. If you realize you have entered one of your passwords on a typosquatter's site, change your password immediately.
