

I was able to pick up a rigid can crusher at a garage sale for \$5 and here it is:


So, start saving your cans!! (If you crush them flat by stepping on them, you will minimize the space to store them until I arrive in the fall!)

HIGHWAY 19 ENTRANCE PETITION

ditor's note: This information is being inserted in the DOMEI rather than emailing all the JG residents at the request of Chris Green, President of JG Social Club as she felt it was an important issue concerning all residents. It is a response (email) from the Florida Department of Transportation sent to Pat Murphy at the JG Office.

FROM PAT MURPHY:

Below is what I received regarding our highway 19 entrance petition.

Steve thought it would be better to share with you and have you bring up at coffee hour rather than emailing it to all of the residents. We wanted everyone to know that I did email several departments and we have gotten a reply (albeit late). Unfortunately they are not providing us with a good solution.

FROM FDOT:

Dear Pat Murphy:

Thank you for your patience as we investigated your request. The Florida Department of Transportation appreciates that you have reached out to us to tell us of your concerns and those of the residents of the Japanese Gardens Mobile Home Estates. Your request was summarized in two areas: one pertains to increased traffic due to a new apartment complex being built on US 19 North near your MHP; and the other pertains to the access/driveway of Tropic Hills Drive that your residents use to enter and exit your MHP.

The Florida Department of Transportation Traffic Operations Office (Department) discussed in much detail the existing access point to your development and the exit ramp from US Highway 19 for SR 60. Based upon the current configuration of the ramp and the proximity of your driveway, the Department reviewed the geometry, distance between the ramp and your access driveway as well as all traffic operations features to determine any remedial actions that could be performed to improve this area.

First, to address the new apartment complex, please note that the City of Clearwater regulates the type of development allowed within their municipal boundaries and processes each request through their development regulations. The Department of Transportation does not regulate any property as to how it can be developed (such as, into a school, hotel, restaurant, etc.). Some types of developments might need zoning changes, others can be much simpler, but all must go through the local municipality for approval. The Department reviews only those developments that require access onto the state roadway system. As part of the Department's review, each development on the state highway system is reviewed for the number, the location, and the type of access (driveway) that will be permitted. Questions related to the type of development and the number of units should be directed to the City of Clearwater.

The Department then reviewed your concern pertaining to the difficulty of residents entering and exiting the Japanese Gardens MHP. First, the Department reviewed the crash data near this



 ramp and your park and found no crashes in this area. The Department also observed traffic movement by placing a video camera at the exit ramp just south of your MHP on May 18th, 19th, and 20th, 2018. The videos revealed that traffic volumes fluctuate throughout the day. Traffic volumes increase during rush hour which tend to reduce the vehicular speed on the ramp towards SR 60. When traffic volumes decrease, the speed of vehicles increase. It was also noted in the videos taken in May, that there were gaps in traffic thereby allowing vehicles to enter and exit from your MHP.

The Department also reviewed the construction plans for US Highway 19 for other possible improvements. The Department reviewed the geometry, signing and striping plans, the offramp and the access points. Relocating the exit ramp further south and the installation of a right turn lane into the Japanese Gardens development were some of the options considered. Significant changes would be required to construct either of these alternatives, but they were considered regardless of cost or right-of-way considerations for this review. The intent of these alternative concepts would be to reduce the speed of vehicles near your development to improve the ease of access to and from the Japanese Gardens development. Relocating the exit ramp from US Highway 19 further south would influence drivers to select the lane that they intend to be in earlier than what they currently do. Based upon historical data, this change would increase the speed of drivers near Tropic Hills Drive. The addition of a turn lane into the Japanese Gardens development would assist vehicles entering your MHP, but not exiting. The signing and striping in the area for possible improvements was also reviewed. The frontage road is posted 35 mph and the mainline of US Highway 19 is posted at 55 mph. An additional 35 mph speed limit sign was added recently and placed directly under the ramp sign. This speed limit sign was installed in November of 2017. The Department is also considering the placement of 35 mph pavement messages as supplemental to the posted signs.

The Department performed a speed check of this area and found that a large percentage of motorists travel well above the posted speed limit of 35 mph. Should the Department perform a speed check of this segment of roadway, we would be obligated to raise the speed limit. Since raising the posted speed limit would be contrary to what is wanted by the residents of the Japanese Gardens MHP, it was not pursued.

The Department also considered the installation of tubular delineators to prevent lane shifting once vehicles are on the ramp. If delineators were installed, they would need to extend past the entrance of your MHP. This would prohibit vehicles, including emergency responders, from entering the MHP from this exit ramp. This channelization option would require that all vehicles wanting to access your MHP would have to do so from the frontage road. These delineators would also restrict lane changing of traffic in the right lane that want to get in the left lane at Gulf to Bay. This does not provide a positive alternative.

After review of the area in question, there are no simple improvements that could address the speed of drivers on the ramp and frontage road. The most effective way to reduce the speed on this ramp segment and on the frontage road near your development is by enforcement. The Department will move forward with the installation of "SLOW 35 MPH" pre-formed

My Hep-C Adventure - Part 5 of 5

y last round of treatments started as what was going to be a 6-month round of the new treatment. I thought the previous treatment were bad but this new treatment was much worse! I was so weak and I couldn't eat. Everything that I put in my mouth tasted terrible. I dropped a lot of weight and, of course, I started losing my hair much worse than I had with my previous treatments.

One day Bonnie, my wife, was getting ready to go to the store and before she left, I asked her, "How thin is my hair getting?" She said, "Well, it's getting pretty thin!"

While she was gone to the store, I got the clippers out, went out on the back porch and clipped all of my hair off. When Bonnie got back from the store, she walked into the house, took one look at me, and said, "Oh my God, you are so ugly!" For the rest of my treatment, I used my razor and kept my head shaved.

During this treatment, Bonnie had to take me to the hospital for out-patient care every Monday, Wednesday and Friday. Three times a week they had to hook me up to IV's so they installed a stent. I was told, later that I looked like a walking ghost. My skin was very gray! The medicine, along with killing the Hep-C, was also killing my blood cells. It is normal for this medication to attack your blood cells but in my case, it was affecting me much worse than they had expected.

As it turned out, I only took the treatment for 2 months. After these 2 months, I went to the hospital for what turned out to be my last visit there. They had drawn my blood and when they got the results, I was suddenly surrounded by a couple nurses and a doctor and we were told that they were contacting my doctor, Dr. Fern.

I was told, later by Dr. Fern that they had not given me my medication that day. They had only given me IV's and blood. He also told me that we were stopping the treatments because they were making me too sick. I told him, "No... don't stop... I can take it... I want to kill this thing!". He told me that if we continued the treatments they could kill me and, if that happened, he would lose his license!

So, I was sent home and Dr. Fern arranged for a visiting nurse to come to my house twice a week to check on me and give me whatever IV's I might need. I was to stay in bed and rest. They sent out a potty chair for my bedroom. I was not allowed to walk to the bathroom. It took another 2 months to recover from the treatments.

As it turned out, I had been on the treatments just long enough! My Hep-C viral load tested zero and continued to test zero!

We did discover that in addition to the liver disease that the Hep-C had caused, somehow during all of this madness, I had also developed a kidney disease. My kidneys were only functioning at 15 percent.

So the Hep-C was - and still is - gone! But I still have to watch out for the liver and the kidney diseases which I will have for the rest of my life. In addition, I recently suffered a heart attack. My heart doctor tells me that there is no way to identify the cause of my heart attack but those treatments could have weakened my heart just enough to make my heart vulnerable.

The bottom line is... Over 10 years ago, I was given 5 years to live - and I am still here! Actually, more important than that is the fact that Bonnie and my other relatives and my friends are all free of any signs of the Hep-C virus. I did NOT, accidentally, pass the virus on to anyone else!
