## LA PLAZA HOA EMERGENCY COVID-19 POWER NOTICE

The HOA needs to continue operating in this new COVID-19 environment. Limited gatherings, canceled activities, restricted access or closed clubhouse has prompted the HOA Board to take the suggestion of the FMO to declare these emergency "Stand in Place" powers.

It is the FMO's Attorneys opinion that we can rely on the "Not-for-Profit" laws, in Section 617.0207, F.S., (Emergency Bylaws) and Section 617.0303, F.S., (Emergency Powers) to allow Chapter 723 HOAs to operate their Association.

In this regard, we are advising our members that the Board is declaring an "emergency" and the Board would, under its Emergency Powers, adopt and initiate a "stand in place" for the remainder of 2020 and 2021 and will terminate this Emergency Notice as specified in 617.0303. Simply stated, annual elections, Open Meetings, and large gatherings would be postponed for a year. The effect would be that the same Board, its officers, and committees, would continue in place until the end of 2021 or the termination of this notice. Vacancies that might occur during this period would be filled by the Board.

For Your Reference:

#### 617.0207 Emergency bylaws.—

(1) Unless the articles of incorporation provide otherwise, the board of directors of a corporation may adopt bylaws to be effective only in an emergency defined in subsection (5). The emergency bylaws may make all provisions necessary for managing the corporation during an emergency, including:

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- . (a) Procedures for calling a meeting of the board of directors;
- . (b) Quorum requirements for the meeting; and
- . (c) Designation of additional or substitute directors.

(2) The board of directors, either before or during any such emergency, may provide, and from time to time modify, lines of succession if during such emergency any or all officers or agents of the corporation are for any reason rendered incapable of discharging their duties.

(3) All provisions of the regular bylaws consistent with the emergency bylaws remain effective during the emergency. The emergency bylaws are not effective after the emergency ends.

(4) Corporate action taken in good faith in accordance with the emergency bylaws: August 10,2020

(a) Binds the corporation; and

(b) May not be used to impose liability on a corporate director, officer, employee, or agent.

(5) An emergency exists for purposes of this section if a quorum of the corporation's directors cannot readily be assembled because of some catastrophic event.

617.0303 Emergency powers.—

(2) During an emergency defined in subsection (5), unless emergency bylaws provide otherwise: (a) Notice of a meeting of the board of directors need be given only to those directors whom it is practicable to reach and may be given in any practicable manner, including by publication and radio; (b) One or more officers of the corporation present at a meeting of the board of directors may be deemed to be directors for the meeting, in order of rank and within the same rank in order of seniority, as necessary to achieve a quorum; and

(c) The director or directors in attendance at a meeting, or any greater number affixed by the emergency bylaws, constitute a quorum.

(3) Corporate action taken in good faith during an emergency under this section to further the ordinary affairs of the corporation: August 10, 2020

. (a) Binds the corporation; and

. (b) May not be used to impose liability on a corporate director, officer, employee, or agent.

(4) An officer, director, or employee acting in accordance with any emergency bylaws is only liable for willful misconduct.

(5) An emergency exists for purposes of this section if a quorum of the corporation's directors cannot readily be assembled because of some catastrophic event.

(6) To the extent not inconsistent with any emergency bylaws so adopted, the bylaws of the corporation shall remain in effect during any emergency, and upon termination of the emergency, the emergency bylaws will cease to be operative.

#### COVID-19 EMERGENCY-2021

Although there will not be functions or events to generate money in the near future, the HOA will still have to meet the financial obligations that we have every year. That would include insurance, fees and taxes in addition to any other expenses.

## WHY WE HAVE A HOME OWNERS ASSOCIATION?

HOA FUNDING REQUIREMENT & HOMEOWNERS MEMBERSHIP INFORMATION George Silverman

e are in very uncertain times with SOCIAL DISTANCING and COVID-19 that negatively impacts HOA FUNDING. The HOA



BOARD has looked at every item in the budget for the past two years for items to eliminate. We have agreed to a minimum operating budget of \$2000.00 annually. Bonding, insurance, state fees and taxes represent the majority of the budgeted items.

Our funding history has always come from volunteer DUE'S and social activities profits in the clubhouse. Social distancing is now forecast to be with us into the future which will impact clubhouse activity. We need to increase the number of dues paying members in the HOA. At the current dues rate of \$10.00 per year, we need 200 volunteer dues paying members.

All persons owning a mobile home in the park are eligible for membership. The law requires the HOA to account for members in good standing. To maintain a voice with WILDER LLC a viable HOA is required. That gives us by law the annual rent, amenity, services meeting in the right to maintain the Pinellas County Circuit Court filing to protect members with Right of First Refusal on a sale of the park property or a change of land use. Florida law does NOT require a park owner to deal with individuals other than to provide notice of what is about to happen. We invite you to pay your 2021 annual dues by filling out the homeowners membership form in the La Plaza Ledger and returning it to Michele Gardner at lot # 609. We encourage you to be an active voting member of the La Plaza HOA and look forward to you sharing your skills, talent, expertise and becoming a valuable asset to our organization.



Our voice with Wilder, LLC (La Plaza MHP) requires by law a viable HOA. To be viable, we need everyone who owns a home in La Plaza MHP to pay their **2021 \$10.00 annual dues**.

Having a HOA gives us the right by law for the annual rent, amenity and services meeting. More important, it gives the HOA the right to maintain the Pinellas County Circuit Court filing to protect members with Right of First Refusal on a sale of the park property or a change of land use. This is how the HOA ensures rights for our homes on Wilder, LLC (La Plaza MHP) property. Florida law does NOT require a park owner to deal with individuals on the above underlined issues or with any other issue other than to provide notice of what is about to happen.

## **ANNUAL HOA 2020 REPORT OF ACCOMPLISHMENTS**

The food events before everything was closed down in mid-March, included 2 Potluck Dinners, 2 Ladies Luncheons, a *Pre-Super bowl Tailgate Pot Luck Dinner*, a *Valentine Death By Chocolate Event*, the HOA's Famous *Poverty Dinner* with its many soup, bread and dessert choices and finally, the Winter season of HOA events was brought to a close with the delicious and *Irish Corn Beef Sandwich Take Out Dinner* on St Patrick's Day. Our timely scheduled *Leap Year Carport Sale*- February 28 & 29,went on without a hitch.

In addition to these special events we continued to offer a card game called *Pepper* in the Club House on Monday evenings, a weekly coffee hour on Tuesday mornings that began in January through March 10th. On Tuesday evenings, we held *Cribbage and Chickenfoot Dominoes*.

The HOA has been advised that the annual Motorcycle Parade will take place in December. If you are new to *La Plaza*, this fun event brings many Christmas holiday decorated motorcycles to our park for a parade around the park and a display in front of the Clubhouse with the requirement of Social Distancing and wearing of face masks in place. I think this will be a fun way to end the 2020 HOA year on a positive and fun note. See you there.

Florida Housing's Coronavirus Relief Fund for Impacted Homeowners and Renters

Governor DeSantis has authorized \$120 million of the State of Florida's Coronavirus Relief Fund (CRF) allocation to assist Floridians that have

been negatively impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic. It is intended for those struggling to pay housing expenses such as: rent, mortgage payments, and emergency repairs that will keep families stably and safely housed. This program may be used by manufactured home owners in land leased communities as well as for those directly renting manufactured homes. In general, your income must be no more than 1.2 times the median income for your area and your income has been adversely impacted by the Covid 19 pandemic. The call center will be available to you Monday – Friday 9 am. to 7 p.m.
