





THEN & HOW DO YOU AS A PARK OWNER OBTAIN A COPY OF THE PROSPECTUS

V Since many home owners don't have a prospectus, it is good to know this in the event that you choose to sell your unit.



When new residents purchase homes from **park owners or developers**, the law requires that the park owner deliver the prospectus to the new resident prior to the execution of the lot rental agreement or at the time of occupancy, whichever comes first. The prospectus contains the tenant's rights and obligations and the rules and regulations that govern a specific park. After the prospective lessee receives the Prospectus, he or she has up to 15 days to void the lot rental agreement.

The park owner is only responsible for delivering the prospectus to the first owner of the manufactured mobile home in the park. Thereafter, when a homeowner sells his home in the park and the lot rental agreement is assumed by the new homeowner, the seller SHOULD give the prospectus to the new homeowner.

If you have any further questions, you should consult your attorney or review Florida Statute 723. I have posted a two page document on the Bulletin Board in the Club House that is widely distributed by the FMO. 
