### LA PLAZA HOA EMERGENCY COVID-19 POWER NOTICE

The HOA needs to continue operating in this new COVID-19 environment. Limited gatherings, canceled activities, restricted access or closed clubhouse has prompted the HOA Board to take the suggestion of the FMO to declare these emergency "Stand in Place" powers.

It is the FMO's Attorneys opinion that we can rely on the "Not-for-Profit" laws, in Section 617.0207, F.S., (Emergency Bylaws) and Section 617.0303, F.S., (Emergency Powers) to allow Chapter 723 HOAs to operate their Association.

In this regard, we are advising our members that the Board is declaring an "emergency" and the Board would, under its Emergency Powers, adopt and initiate a "stand in place" for the remainder of 2020 and 2021 and will terminate this Emergency Notice as specified in 617.0303. Simply stated, annual elections, Open Meetings, and large gatherings would be postponed for a year. The effect would be that the same Board, its officers, and committees, would continue in place until the end of 2021 or the termination of this notice. Vacancies that might occur during this period would be filled by the Board.

### For Your Reference:

### 617.0207 Emergency bylaws.—

(1) Unless the articles of incorporation provide otherwise, the board of directors of a corporation may adopt bylaws to be effective only in an emergency defined in subsection (5). The emergency bylaws may make all provisions necessary for managing the corporation during an emergency, including:

- . (a) Procedures for calling a meeting of the board of directors;
- . (b) Quorum requirements for the meeting; and
- . (c) Designation of additional or substitute directors.

(2) The board of directors, either before or during any such emergency, may provide, and from time to time modify, lines of succession if during such emergency any or all officers or agents of the corporation are for any reason rendered incapable of discharging their duties.

(3) All provisions of the regular bylaws consistent with the emergency bylaws remain effective during the emergency. The emergency bylaws are not effective after the emergency ends.

(4) Corporate action taken in good faith in accordance with the emergency by laws: August 10,2020

- (a) Binds the corporation; and
- (b) May not be used to impose liability on a corporate director, officer, employee, or agent.



(5) An emergency exists for purposes of this section if a quorum of the corporation's directors cannot readily be assembled because of some catastrophic event.

#### 617.0303 Emergency powers.—

(2) During an emergency defined in subsection (5), unless emergency bylaws provide otherwise: (a) Notice of a meeting of the board of directors need be given only to those directors whom it is practicable to reach and may be given in any practicable manner, including by publication and radio; (b) One or more officers of the corporation present at a meeting of the board of directors may be deemed to be directors for the meeting, in order of rank and within the same rank in order of seniority, as necessary to achieve a quorum; and

(c) The director or directors in attendance at a meeting, or any greater number affixed by the emergency bylaws, constitute a quorum.

(3) Corporate action taken in good faith during an emergency under this section to further the ordinary affairs of the corporation: August 10, 2020

. (a) Binds the corporation; and

. (b) May not be used to impose liability on a corporate director, officer, employee, or agent.

(4) An officer, director, or employee acting in accordance with any emergency bylaws is only liable for willful misconduct.

(5) An emergency exists for purposes of this section if a quorum of the corporation's directors cannot readily be assembled because of some catastrophic event.

(6) To the extent not inconsistent with any emergency bylaws so adopted, the bylaws of the corporation shall remain in effect during any emergency, and upon termination of the emergency, the emergency bylaws will cease to be operative.

#### COVID-19 EMERGENCY-2021

Although there will not be functions or events to generate money in the near future, the HOA will still have to meet the financial obligations that we have every year. That would include insurance, fees and taxes in addition to any other expenses.

The board thought long and hard on this and has determined that the HOA dues will remain at \$10.00 for 2021 and we will spend down the treasury. We hope that our home owners will support the decision and support the HOA.

### Governor Ron DeSantis Announces Florida Housing Approval of Additional \$45 Million Coronavirus Relief Funds

Florida Housing's Coronavirus Relief Fund for Impacted Homeowners and Renters Governor DeSantis has authorized \$120 million of the State of Florida's Coronavirus Relief Fund (CRF) allocation to assist Floridians that have been negatively impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic. It is intended for those struggling to pay housing expenses such as: rent, mortgage payments, and emergency repairs that will keep families stably and safely housed. This program may be used by manufactured home owners in land leased communities as well as for those directly renting manufactured homes. In general, your income must be no more than 1.2 times the median income for your area and your income has been adversely impacted by the Covid 19 pandemic. The call center will be available to you Monday – Friday 9 am. to 7 p.m.



### **Christopher Columbus**

hristopher Columbus was an Italian-born explorer who set sail in August 1492, bound for Asia with backing from the Spanish monarchs <u>King Ferdinand and Queen</u> <u>Isabella</u> aboard the ships the Nina, the Pinta and the Santa Maria.



Columbus intended to chart a western sea route to China, India and the fabled gold and spice islands of Asia. Instead, on October 12, 1492, he landed in the Bahamas, becoming the first European to <u>explore the Americas</u> since the <u>Vikings established colonies in Greenland and Newfoundland</u> during the 10th century.

Later that October, Columbus sighted Cuba and believed it was mainland China; in December the expedition found Hispaniola, which he thought might be Japan. There, he established Spain's first colony in the Americas with 39 of his men.

In March 1493, Columbus returned to Spain in triumph, bearing gold, spices and "Indian" captives. The explorer crossed the Atlantic several more times before his death in 1506.



It wasn't until his third journey that Columbus finally realized he hadn't reached Asia but instead had stumbled upon a continent previously unknown to Europeans.

The first Columbus Day celebration took place in 1792, when New York's Columbian Order—better known as <u>Tammany Hall</u>—held an event to commemorate the historic landing's 300th anniversary.

Taking pride in Columbus' birthplace and faith, Italian and Catholic communities in various parts of the country began organizing annual religious ceremonies and parades in his honor.

In 1892, President <u>Benjamin Harrison</u> issued a proclamation encouraging Americans to mark the 400th anniversary of Columbus' voyage with patriotic festivities, writing, "On that day let the people, so far as possible, cease from toil and devote themselves to such exercises as may best express honor to the discoverer and their appreciation of the great achievements of the four completed centuries of American life."

In 1937, President <u>Franklin D. Roosevelt</u> proclaimed Columbus Day a national holiday, largely as a result of intense lobbying by the Knights of Columbus, an influential Catholic fraternal organization.

Columbus Day is observed on the second Monday of October. While Columbus Day is a federal government holiday meaning all federal offices are closed, not all states grant it as a day off from work.


