They approached many of you who, at least initially, declined the opportunity to serve. Marcia later distributed an official Nomination Form to residents in an effort to ensure every resident had an opportunity to identify a potential nominee – including themselves. Nominees will be announced at the December meeting; voting will take place at the January meeting. Those who attended the November Meeting heard Marcia describe what would happen to community events and activities if no one stepped forward to serve on the board – there would be none; all group social activities would come to an abrupt halt.

The Park #1 Association was officially organized in 1966 and has undergone minor changes over the ensuing years. Perhaps – because of changes in lifestyles of newer residents – it may be time to again consider changing how the Association is structured and to identify different social activities to sponsor. New leadership, with membership approval, would have an opportunity to make agreed upon changes to the bylaws.

Perhaps you just want to live your life and not be involved—that is certainly your prerogative—but it is my fervent hope that it is not the case. Most of us—particularly those who have lived here more than five years—moved into Lake Haven to experience a community-focused life style—which includes membership meetings (so your opinions/concerns can be heard) and participating in group social activities. If the community lifestyle is one of the deciding reasons you moved here too, I encourage you to consider stepping forward and become actively involved. I hope our community won't allow 54 consecutive years of tradition come to an end. The future of the Paradise Island Association is in your hands.

ELS has not yet given approval to hold our annual Community Sale. In the interim, we are proceeding with plans based on the assumption that it will ultimately be permitted. ELS has concerns about allowing non-resident attendance during a COVID period, and on how to ensure everyone adheres to wearing masks and following social distancing protocols. However, Park Management has stated that the clubhouse cannot be used as a "drop off" point for sale donations. If you have something to donate, please call either Lei or me to schedule a mutually convenient time to meet you at the garage. As the January 30th date nears, we will be requesting volunteers to help with set-up, working at a sale table, and clean-up activities. Since many of our "regular" Community Sale volunteers are snowbirds who have elected to not return this season due to COVID concerns, we need the support of the entire park toward this effort. Revenue from this sale provides funding for the major portion of our social activities.

Extending prayers and best wishes for a healed nation, good health, peace and joy during this very special time of the year and beyond.

#### Health care is changing—will consumers adapt?



T ealth care is becoming more dependent on phone calls and artificial intelligence to treat patients instead of relying primarily on in-person appointments. The public may not be ready, though. A Harris poll, reported on the Xtelligent website, found that only one in five consumers would trust AI-generated health care advice, although responses were different between generations. Among adults 18-34, 22% say they would trust AI guidance, but only 10% of adults 65 or older say the same.

When it comes to phone appointments, a third of consumers actually prefer receiving health care advice over the phone, compared to 30% who prefer in-person visits, 25% who prefer online advice, 6% who prefer mobile apps, and 5% who prefer AI. Women are more likely to prefer the use of a phone for health care advice than men (36% to 28%).

The AI market for health care is expected to increase at a compound annual growth rate of 50.2% between 2018 and 2025, from \$2.1 billion in 2018 to \$36.1 billion by 2025.

#### More attention to health during outbreak

he COVID-19 outbreak has Americans paying more attention to their health, according to a study by Rally Health, Inc. Its survey found that 43% say the outbreak has motivated them to focus on their overall health more than before. Forty-nine percent are more aware of their physical health, and 44% are paying more attention to their mental health.

Many people are striving to take more control of their health these days as a result. Twentyfour percent are eating more healthfully, 21% are exercising on a more regular basis, and 21% are paying closer attention to their mental health — depression, stress, and the like.
