Interstellar asteroid is a first

A steroids can be found throughout our solar system, but astronomers have recently discovered one in interstellar space. The Science News website reports that the object, first believed to be a comet, is approaching the solar system at an unusually steep angle. Dubbed A/2017 U1, the asteroid is about 400 meters across and traveling 25.5 kilometers per second on a slingshot path past the sun. Astronomers plan to measure the colors in its reflected light to determine what it's made of and seek clues to its origins.

Red sky in Asia mystery solved

t's a centuries-old mystery: In the year 1770, skies over Asia turned a bright red for nine days. The cause of this unusual phenomenon has never been identified. Now, though, scientists believe they have an answer.

As reported on the Slate website, researchers recently uncovered a collection of 111 contemporaneous documents from that time, and learned that the red sky had lasted longer than previously thought (just two days) and was much larger as well.



Scientists' conclusion: The effect was created by an aurora caused by solar activity, sparking the longest geomagnetic storm in recorded history.

A similar aurora was observed on two nights in 1859 by a massive solar storm known as the "Carrington Flare." Analysis of records of sunspot activity in 1770 suggests that the Asian aurora was caused by sunspot twice as large as those that created the Carrington event.

If such an event happened today, it would likely have catastrophic effects, knocking out satellites crucial to communications and GPS instruments.

New mineral found on Martian surface

ASA has discovered evidence of an ironoxide mineral on the surface of Mars, the Sci-News website reports. The mineral, called hematite, was detected by spectral analysis of photos taken by the space agency's Curiosity rover in an area known as the Vera Rubin Ridge.

Curiosity zeroed in on a rock dubbed "Christmas Cove," and used its dust removal tool, a wire-bristled brushed, to uncover an area some 2.5 inches across.

Observations made the rover's Mast Camera (Mastcam) and its Chemistry and Camera (ChemCam) confirmed the presence of the hematite, a mineral that may provide information about ancient environmental conditions on the red planet.

Can beet juice keep your brain young?

Beet juice may keep your brain young and fit, according to an article on the Runner's World website. The article cites a study reported in the Journal of Gerontology: Medical Sciences that found that a shot of beet juice an hour before exercise can have positive benefits to brains as they get older.

In the study, 26 sedentary men with an average age of 65 participated in six weeks of exercise. Some took daily shots of beet juice; others received a placebo. The participants walked on a treadmill three times a week for six weeks, building up to 50 minutes per session at increased effort. Comparing MRIs from before and after the trial, researchers found that the group that drank beet juice had significantly higher levels of "community consistency" within their brains.



The nitrate in beet juice, which converts to nitrite and then nitric oxide in the blood, has a strong positive affect on responsiveness in blood vessels, which in turn can increase the amount of oxygen reaching the brain and boost aspects of cognitive function.

Make sure drinking glasses are safe

Take a look in your kitchen cabinet at your drinking glasses. Do you have decorative glasses for water, wine, beer, or whatever you drink during the day? They may be hazardous to your health.

The Medline Plus website reports that researchers at the University of Plymouth in the United Kingdom analyzed more than 70 new and used drinking glasses and found that seven out of 10 tested positive for lead or cadmium—both toxic metals.

Lead was found in all colors and goldleaf designs. Cadmium was found in the highest concentrations in red enamel.

Lead in children's bodies can cause growth and developmental difficulties. Cadmium can cause cancer. Studies have also linked it to bone softening and kidney problems.

Keep deadly chemicals out of your body

- The list of chemicals that can cause cancer is intimidating, and keeping them out of your food can seem like an impossible task. The Fox News website, though, offers these tips for keeping your food and water free of toxic chemicals:
- Buy a water filter. A good filter can remove many cancer-causing chemicals.
- Eat organic foods. You'll cut your exposure to pesticides and other chemicals and support an industry that doesn't pollute the environment.
- Bring your own mug. Foam cups from most coffee shops contain styrene, which gets pulled out when in contact with hot liquids. Take your own travel mug when you go out for coffee, tea, or other hot beverages.



A tireless fighter for a cause


B orn Feb. 15, 1820, Susan B. Anthony devoted her life to the fight for social justice and reform. She began her activism as a member of the American Anti-Slavery Society in the years leading up to the civil war. In 1866 she founded the American Equal Rights Association with Elizabeth Cady Stanton, and the pair embarked on a mission to secure civil liberties for all citizens regardless of their gender or race. This work would lead Anthony and Stanton to found the National Women's Suffrage Association, where they continued to advocate for women's voting rights.

Anthony died on March 13, 1906, 14 years before her work would be realized. In 1920, the 19th Amendment was added to the U. S. Constitution, giving women the right to vote. In 1979 the U.S. Treasury Department honored Anthony by placing her image on the dollar coin.

Happy Fat Tuesday

his year the revelry of the carnival season will culminate on Tuesday, Feb. 13, in celebrations around the world before the start of Lent.

In the United States, the city of New Orleans is the capital for all things Mardi Gras, which is French for "Fat Tuesday." Although the city has roots deeply centered in French heritage, it was not the first American city to host this event. French-Canadian explorer Pierre Le Moyne d'Iberville is rumored to have held the first Mardi Gras in a location about 60 miles downriver. Years later, settlers along with French soldiers would continue the practice by donning masks and enjoying festivities in the newly established town of Mobile, Alabama.





Help somebody

Thile he was serving in the Navy during World War II, an unfortunate accident resulted in the death of several of Thomas Cannon's shipmates. Because Cannon's life was spared, he felt a duty and purpose to be in the service of others.

Over 33 years, Cannon gave away over \$150,000. He made donations to people in his hometown of Richmond, Virginia; most of them had been profiled in the local newspaper. He'd often mail \$1,000 checks to the staff of the paper with instructions about who should receive the money. His charity helped support a local group that volunteered in the



elementary school, a woman who started a youth center in her low-income neighborhood, and an orphaned teen who was active in his community.

Cannon never owned a fancy house or drove a flashy car. His \$20,000-a-year salary as a postal worker allowed him to provide the necessities for his wife and sons, while his generous spirit inspired him to help others who were not as fortunate.

Though his benevolence garnered him a certain amount of accolades, Cannon made it clear that he didn't want the bureaucracy of a foundation to carry on his work, nor to have his name commemorated in any way once he was no longer living. Cannon suggested the best way to honor his memory would be for others to just "Help somebody."


Find your own path

rench entomologist Henri Fabre once conducted an experiment that illustrates why it's best to distance yourself from the crowd and follow your own path.

Fabre observed the actions of a group of processionary caterpillars that travel in a line head to tail with no clear sense of a destination. Their path is determined by the "leader" ahead of them.

Fabre lined the rim of a flowerpot with an unbroken chain of caterpillars. Inside the pot he placed a plethora of food. Without breaking the chain, the caterpillars began their slow track around the rim of the pot. There was no way to distinguish the leader in this group, and the caterpillars kept moving around the rim of the pot at a steady pace.

After several days, the caterpillars—who had never stopped their trek—began to die and fall off the rim. All the while, the food they needed lay inches away. This thoughtless mass movement caused them to lose even the most basic instincts to allow them to change their behavior in order to survive.
