## June is the start of hurricane season so let be ready

#### After the storm-THE RECOVERY TEAM

The are gearing up for the hurricane season and in order to better prepare you, your homes and the Park, the Disaster Recovery Team has devised a plan.

If Lake Highlander was struck by a Category 1 or worse storm and there was

some damage done in the Park and we may not have utilities in operation, then the following scenario might take place.

When mandatory evacuation order has been given by the local authorities, then our readymade Shutters will be placed on all windows in the Clubhouse and the Multipurpose Building. Remember none of our buildings are to be used as a hurricane shelter.


The Recovery Team will have the following job to do.

1. To re-enter the Park each member will have an Identification card that identifies them as members of the Recovery team. They will have an official letter from the Park that identifies them as a member of the Recovery team. They will also need their driver's license to show to the nice policeman. The members of the Recovery team are:

- 2. The Recovery team will inform all recovery team members of their location during evacuation and remain in contact with each other by cell phones. The Recovery Team will make every effort to return to the Park as soon as the "All Clear" is given from local authorities to re-enter the Park. Whoever is here first will take the lead in the recovery operation until the Park Manager, Beth Carroll or Directors Warren Bowman or Fred Wimmer or Dick Duclow or Dusty Rhodes or Myron Paris has returned. The rest of the recovery team will assist them.
- 3. The Multipurpose building will be used as the Command Post on provision that there has not been extensive damage. The CONTACT NUMBERS will be 727 733 5522 and 727 733 4890 and a voice message will be put on the phone stating the condition of the Park.
- 4. The following Emergency Supplies/Equipment will be stored in or near the Multipurpose room when a storm is beginning to threaten our area.
  - a. generator and fuel
  - b. propane or charcoal grills
  - c. walkie talkies
  - d. first aid kit
  - e. water and portable coolers
  - f. & phone numbers of all residents and employees
  - g. gloves, hard hats, vest, flashlights, batteries, lamps
- 5. The Recovery Team will have the following responsibilities:
  - a. Co-operate with the local authorities
  - b. Check each coach to see if any residents are there
  - c. police the park to prevent looting
  - d. Contact local authorities for help (could be FEMA)
  - e. Staff the Command Center for incoming calls.
  - f. Pass on information to returning home owners
  - g. Authorizing expenditures could be done by Park Manager, Beth Carroll or President, Dick Duclow. If they are not available, then there are other Directors on the Recovery team.
  - h. Repairs of the common areas of the Park will be made by contractors that Beth will contact. With the owner's approval, contractors of your choice could make the necessary repairs to their property. The resident has the right to decline repairs unless the damage poses a threat to surrounding neighbors and/or the park which will be determined by the Recovery team.
  - i. Contact Susan Zerbe to put updates on our web site.

to make sure that the community "elders" had a good time. However, in the process they truly seemed to enjoy all of the action themselves!



#### Scientists delve deep into the heart of the world

Jules Verne's Journey to the Center of the Earth described an inner world of jungles, seas, and dinosaurs. The reality is quite different, but no less interesting to scientists, and it's changing all the time. The latest discovery about the nature of the Earth's core comes from a professor at the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign. The inner core, about 3,000 miles beneath the world's crust, actually contains a second core about half the radius of the outer one. This inner core contains iron crystals, which are oriented in an east-west alignment. The outer inner core's crystals align north-south, although they appear to have flipped several times in the distant past.



Scientists liken the twin cores to the rings on a tree, which allow researchers to peer directly into the past. The discovery could provide important clues to the formation and development of our world.

#### 'New' solar system is the oldest ever found

The oldest solar system in our galaxy is 11.2 billion years old, according to data from NASA's Kepler space telescope. By comparison, our home solar system is about 4.5 billion years old. The new find is about 117 light-years from Earth, with five Earth-sized planets in an orbit too close to their star to allow for life. But the discovery of a solar system's formation only a few billion years after the Big Bang some 13.8 billion years ago suggests that life could have proliferated throughout the cosmos much earlier than scientists previously believed.

#### Sophie the Stegosaurus steps on the scale (sort of)

ow much did the dinosaurs weigh? That question has been answered—at least for one specimen at London's Natural History Museum.

Sophie the Stegosaurus is about 150 million years old, and was discovered in 2003 by pale-ontologists in Wyoming. It now resides at the British museum, its skeleton 85 percent intact. According to the Yahoo News website, British researchers created a 3-D digital version of the

skeleton, then calculated the amount of flesh it would have had around its bones, and compared that with data from modern animals

of a similar size.

The result? Sophie tipped the scales at about 1.6 tons, with a body mass roughly equivalent to a small rhinoceros. Knowing its weight will allow paleontologists to learn more about stegosaurus metabolism, food needs, and growth rate.


