CYBER SAFETY

any companies and individuals have experienced higher than normal virus and malware activity recently. An organization for which I volunteer recently sent out an email stressing the importance of email safety to prevent cyber-attacks. Here are some of the common cyber-attacks that everyone should be aware of:

- Ransomware is increasingly being used by hackers to extort money from companies and individuals. Ransomware is a type of malicious software that takes over your computer and prevents you from accessing files until you pay a ransom.
- **Phishing** is the most common type of cyber-attack that affects organizations and individuals. Phishing attacks can take many forms, but they all share a common goal; getting you to share sensitive information such as login credentials, credit card information, or bank account details.
- **Spear phishing** is a more sophisticated phishing attack that includes customized information that makes the attacker seem like a legitimate source. They may use your name and phone number in the e-mail to trick you into thinking they have a connection to you, making you more likely to click a link or attachment that they provide.
- **Smishing** is a combination of the terms "SMS" and "phishing." It is similar to phishing, but refers to fraudulent messages sent over SMS (text messaging) rather than email. The goal of smishing is to capture people's personal information.
- **Vishing** is similar to phishing, but refers to fraudulent messages sent to voice mail rather than email.
- **Spoofing** is when the sender address of an email has been altered to hide its true origin, used by virus and spam authors to make their emails look legitimate and lure people into clicking on links or downloading attachments. For example: The email looks as it is from one address but hovering over it reveals a different address.
- **Pretexting** is a social engineering technique in which a fictional situation is created for the purpose of obtaining personal and sensitive information from an unsuspecting individual. It usually involves researching a target and making use of his/her data for impersonation or manipulation. Personal data may include Social Security numbers (SSN), usernames, passwords or other privileged information. The goal of this technique is to sound legitimate to the victim in order to obtain protected information.

Think Before You Click. The most common way a virus a computer is through email. Often, scammers will include malicious links or attachments in emails that look harmless. To avoid this trap, observe the following email best practices;

- Do not click on links or attachments from senders that you do not recognize. Be especially wary of .zip or other compressed or executable file types.
- Do not provide sensitive personal information (like usernames and passwords) over email.
- Watch for email senders that use suspicious or misleading domain names. These email addresses can be spoofed to look like someone you know, but also, they could be one that has a different country's domain on it (example.com.ru, or support@microsoft.com)
- Look at the Subject line. Does it create a sense of urgency? These are typically viruses. Does it have one word in it but appears to be a response like "Re: Document"? This is also a tall tell sign of a virus.
- Look at the body of the message. If the sender is a recognized sender, does it follow their normal emailing criteria? Does it have a salutation? Is it directed to you specifically, or is it generic (Hi, vs Hi Lynne,). Does it have a signature for the person who sent it? Does it match the name of the person you identified in the email address above?
- Look at the direction of the message. Does it ask you to open the attached file? Does it create a sense of urgency? With viruses, the purpose of the body is to entice you to open the attachment. A common method is by fear and urgency.
- Are you getting an email from a Facebook friend that you normally don't correspond with by email? They may ask you to open an attachment or say, "Look at this link." If this is not the normal way of communication with that person, be suspicious.

LOVEBUG SEASON IS OVER AGAIN

May 10, 2019 article in the Tampa Bay Times entitled "Fatal Attraction" talked about lovebugs in Florida. Since we all endured the season and many don't get the newspaper, I thought I would share some highlights of the article with you. The lovebug season begins just about the time many of our snowbirds are leaving in May. But there is also another lovebug season in September.

- Lovebugs are an invasive species which arrived in Florida about 1950.
- Lovebugs thrive in among cow poop and cut grass (actually, any decaying matter).
- They used to be worse than they are now (really!).
- Many service stations used to charge 75 cents to remove lovebug infestation from your car if you did not purchase gasoline.
- Children used to stand along the highway offering lovebug cleaning services for a dollar.
