

JOYCE HUNTLEY RECEIVES AWARD

I have come to appreciate the richness of her lineage. One ancestor, her great-grandfather Major James Henry Whitmore, was part of Company B of the Maine 15th Volunteer Infantry Regiment during the American Civil War. The unit saw much action and in a historically-significant event they were able to raise the first Union flag over the shores of Texas during the Civil War in 1862. After the war the flag was presented to Major Whitmore. The flag was passed down to Major Whitmore's daughter, Emily Whitmore Morton, then to her daughter Nadine Morton Meshko, and finally to her son George Meshko (Joyce Huntley's cousin). George passed away in 2014. His widow Nancy then became the possessor of the flag.

Before his death, George paid to have the flag framed and hermetically sealed behind glass. His cousin Joyce told him about the Maine Military Museum and its reputation for preserving military history but the donation to the museum did not happen during his lifetime. In March, at Joyce's encouragement, Nancy Meshko arranged to have the flag shipped to the museum. Much hoopla accompanied the donation with television and newspaper coverage. "The flag has come home" was the excited headline.

The Daughters of the American Revolution heard about the donation and decided to award Joyce and Nancy the Women in American History Award and Medal which honors those individuals who have significantly advanced the understanding of America's past. Joyce and Nancy were both awarded the medal in separate venues on April 15: Joyce received hers from the Caladisi Chapter DAR in a ceremony in Dunedin and Nancy received hers in a ceremony in Colorado.

MEMORIAL DAY

or as long as I can remember, Memorial Day was the holiday which signified the beginning of summer. We always had a family picnic and the end of the school year was just around the corner. On the serious side, graves were decorated, and we remembered those who died in service to our country. Since 1970, Memorial Day has been celebrated in the U.S. on the last Monday in May. Prior to that it was celebrated on May 30.

In my family, we remembered my Dad's only brother who died at the close of World War II. He was on Luzon in the Philippines. A letter to his mother for Mother's Day stated, "I am in the best of health and we are now in a comparatively safe place on another and higher mountain – 4000 feet up." At that time the 136th Infantry, of which he was a part, was rooting out the Japanese troops which had fled into the mountains.

My uncle wrote home one last time on May 8, 1945. He stated his company was patrolling the mountains during the day and sitting up on watch during the night. He said, "As far as I'm concerned, this is the way I like to fight the war. During the day we have nothing to do but sit around and play cards, write letters, clean our guns, and cook our meals. At night we have three men in a pill box and take turns watching. My CP (command post) is a sand bagged cave dug in the side of a hill which I occupy with my Sgt. and the aid man. It is complete with telephone but no lights or running water. Freedom from running water is an asset when it rains, and that we get for an hour or two every day right on schedule after supper time. Each of us takes two 1½ hour shifts. This is a monotonous life, but someone has to do it. Anyway, it is better than being up about where the boys are fighting. You're probably reading in the papers that this campaign is ended, but there are still a lot of Japs to be cleaned out of the surrounding mountains. This Regt. didn't share in the glory of any triumphal entry, but continues to fight in some of the worst terrain of the Philippines. The mountains are beautiful, yes, but what a job climbing them. Besides, there are Japs up here. I've seen them myself."

From a history of my uncle's division, The Golden Cross: A History of the 33d Infantry Division in World War II, I was able to find out copious details about the events of that time. In brief, beginning on May 11 the troops confronted the enemy and Companies C and F were in a constant state of tension with no opportunity to rest. The next day my uncle and another platoon leader were killed by machine gun fire.

My grandparents were informed of their son's death by their daughter-in-law on Memorial

Day. Upon hearing the news, my grandfather went out into the yard where a flag was flying on a pole and lowered the flag to half-mast. The neighbors knew by the lowered flag that one of their sons had been killed in action and they shared the family's grief.

We all have been touched by the lives of men and women who have sacrificed their lives in defense of our freedom. I, for one, am very grateful we have a day in which we can remember them and their valor.





Burma Shave probably saved some lives. People laughed and then were more careful! It was a REAL service to America, even though it was an advertisement and it was one of the RARE useful ones!

As a reminder, here is a quick lesson in the history of Burma Shave signs. In the 1930's and '40's, when everyone drove down the old two-lane roads and before the interstates, Burma Shave signs would be posted all over the countryside in farmers' fields. They were small red signs with white letters. Five signs, about 100 feet apart, each containing one line of a four-line couplet and the obligatory 5th sign advertising Burma Shave, a popular shaving cream. Here are some good ones:
