arlier this year, I mentioned that this was the 30th anniversary of Lake Seminole Resort. Quite a milestone in our history! In fact, it is a bit tricky to determine when our anniversary actually is.

In 1968 Gil and Gary Watkins purchased this property from the Pinellas County Teacher's Association. It had been used as a campground. The campground had gone into receivership and it was on the market.

On April 19, 1984 we were incorporated under the name Lasereno, Inc. Why was this name chosen? We had been known as Lake Seminole Resort North and Lasereno is simply the first two letters of each of the words Lake Seminole Resort North. (At the time there was actually a Lake Seminole Resort South).

Late in May, 1986, the Watkins family offered to sell this park to the "camping" residents at the time and the sale was completed on Sept. 22, 1986.

So, if we choose the date of incorporation...April 19, 2014 is the 30th anniversary of the park. If we choose the time when residents actually purchased shares the date would be September 22, 2016.

So we bit the bullet...and have chosen this year to celebrate. The detail of the dates is much less important than the significance of the establishment of our wonderful community. Please join us at the pool party where we will recognize this special time. In recognition of the anniversary, we are working with Alice Jarvis and her team to plant a tree with a commemorative plaque. Our gardening group will work out the details but I am sure it will be a special tree in a special spot. Once the details are worked out we will let you know!





#### **IRS IMPOSTER SCAMS ON THE RISE**

The Internal Revenue Service (IRS) is the government agency that collects federal taxes. Scammers pretend to be IRS officials to get you to send them money.

#### HOW THE SCAM WORKS

Your caller ID might show it's the IRS calling. The caller might give a badge number and know the last four digits of your Social Security number.

"you owe money." "you better pay now, or you'll be arrested."

"put money on a prepaid debit card or wire it to us."

You find out it wasn't the IRS. It was a scam. The money is gone.

Don't give the caller information such as your financial or other personal information. Write down details such as the number and name of the caller
