Te now have 3 Emergency 911 call boxes. One inside the hall, one outside the Hall in the entrance way facing the shuffle courts and the original one on the wall between the offices and card room doors. They are all clearly marked with a sign.

These are very easy to use. If there's an emergency, all you do is push the silver button, listen to the dial tone and you'll hear it automatically dial 911. Quickly, an operator will ask "is your emergency Fire, Medical or Police"? You answer the questions then quickly make sure someone is visible on the street to intercept and direct the responders.

The boxes will be tested monthly to ensure they are in working order.



The farmer came back smiling the next day. "It's amazing! The house is quiet and we have room to spare! Thank you, rabbi!"


Not so obvious


