

YOU NEED TO KNOW!

By this printing all homeowners would have just received the yearly notice from the park owner concerning rent, compactor fee and the property tax pass-on charge. The property tax pass-on is allowed by Florida statutes for rental mobile home parks like Lincolnshire. This has been in existence for several years. Each homeowner is responsible for 1/464th of the difference in the property tax paid from the basis year of 2006. Our park owner makes the charge to each homeowner once a year in July along with the rental increase. Other park owners may blend it into the rental increase or have 12 month installments. The Board does not recommend putting the pass-on tax in our lot rent. Property taxes are based on the value of the property (including the land) owned and is assessed by local or municipal governments. Resident owned parks also see increases and those charges are seen in increased maintenance fees. The Board is surprised by the number of new homeowners who have no knowledge of this pass-on tax until they receive the yearly notice. Your Board of Directors ensures that this pass-on is calculated correctly each year.

The Board will also exercise our right by Florida statute to schedule a meeting with the park owner or his representative concerning the rental increase notice, property tax pass-on and other issues deemed important to affected members. This meeting must occur before the rental increase takes effect on July 1st.

The 2020 Annual Meeting took place on February 18th. Sadly attendance was less than expected. The Board appreciates those who did come, receive a yearly report from the Board and ask questions. In addition the Secretary provided an update on proposed legislation effecting mobile home parks throughout Florida. Our lobbyist, the FMO (Federated of Manufactured Home Owners of Florida) has been very active this year in advocating for mobile homeowners.

If you are reading this and are not a Member **please** take the opportunity to join. **Ensure** your voice can be heard and also have a vote. The Association strength is in its membership and let's always maintain that. The Board is also a remarkable resource for issues mobile homeowners may have. The Board are all certified as trained and attend other informative meetings.

Board meetings occur monthly, usually the 2nd Sunday of each month and posted in the "Voice" and laundry room. Members are always welcome at Board meeting. Member meetings will resume next December.

LHOA has been in existence for 25 years! Board meetings are generally monthly and Member meetings are monthly from December to March. Members are strongly encouraged to attend.

Dog Aggression

Sadie has been with me for about a year now. She is a rescue and has been surrendered twice before we got her. Shitz Tsus are companion dogs and so can become



very attached to you. I've noticed with all the extra dogs in the park this winter, that she hangs back, and sometimes jumps forward at the other dog aggressively as we stop to visit on the street. We are trying to stop this behavior, but since I don't know her history (she is 7 yrs.old), it is difficult. Luckily, she's so small that picking her up or pulling her back is usually easy, but I still am watching for cues to learn why this is happening.

There are many reasons why a dog may act aggressively toward another. She may be afraid, she may be stressed because her space is being violated. She may feel the need to dominate. At 9 lbs., she's smaller than most other dogs and so may want to assert herself with her posture and bark.

She may be protective of me. These small breeds were often bred to be protective of their royal owners as they were always present when they were in public and sometimes were actually used as guard dogs with their sensitive hearing. Lhasa Apsos are a good example of this. They were often used as inside guard dogs for the Dali in Tibet.

Sometimes, what we perceive to be aggression may be the result of hyper energy, eagerness, or natural inquisitiveness. Therefore, in dog-to-dog aggression cases, it is important to understand what our dog is feeling, and what he is trying to say.

Sometimes, instead of trying to be too protective, allow the dogs to work it out between themselves. When Sadie acts out in front of a dog and I see the other dog stand quietly, I then stop her and then try to allow her to get a sniff and then...all is well. Everyone gets their sniff and moves on. No big deal.

Just another day in dog world.

A Nurse's Self Care Toolbox #22

ast month, March, I went over 4 vital steps in using food (sugar.) What we eat, how much we eat, when we eat (a big deal) and movement soon after we have eaten. This month's target is the damage high blood sugars create and testing blood sugar. Medications to mediate the effects of high blood sugar will be in the May edition.

Blood sugar is absolutely needed for life along with oxygen. Our body cells use both to make the energy needed to do their job. The sugar in the blood gets through the cell "door" by insulin, a hormone produced in the pancreas, which drop kicks the sugar into the cell. A field goal and 3 points millions of times a day everywhere in our body. The blood vessels especially arteries (the smallest pass by each and every body cell) are sensitive to a blood sugar level that stays higher and longer in the blood than usual. Higher blood sugars remaining longer than normal are absolute irritants to the lining the blood vessel. Over time the lining becomes inflamed especially the very small vessels and often becomes "plugged". The blood supply slows and may just stop. That is not good whatsoever! The end result can and usually is damage to vital organs like the eyes, heart, kidneys, arteries in the lower legs, nerves and much more. The hard part to swallow is the damage can be undetected until the damage has started. Another reason to see our physicians on a regular basis. Not just when we are sick.

Basically there are 2 types of diabetes. Type 1 is where the pancreas ceases to produce insulin or very, very little. Found mostly in young people. Why, they didn't live to middle age. No cure yet but they take insulin in various ways either continuously by an insulin pump or injections up to 6 times a day. Life expectancy almost quadrupled, wow. Type 2 can be best described as pancreas fatigue over time. Almost always too much sugar at the wrong times without any upcoming need (movement.) Remember how we were designed, get up, eat, move, eat move and repeat until dusk. Eat a balanced meal!!! Prediabetes is simply a warning that our blood sugars remain elevated but just below graduating to diabetes. You don't want that diploma!

There are 2 basic blood tests for sugar. Yes, blood as that is where we find it. HgbA1c or just "A1c." started about 20 years ago. It measures on a scale of 5 to 16. It is the average "weight" if I can say that of the sugar in the blood over the last 90 days. 5.5 to 6 is normal and the higher the number the higher the average sugar load. Sort of knowing your average driving speed over 90 days. Normal, speeding or reckless. On the spot glucose monitoring with a home meter is exactly what it is, right now. Blood sugars on a monitor should be below 110 starting 2 hours after we have eaten or in the morning before we eat by 8:30 AM. Elevated right after we eat. Our physicians will tell us when to test, usually fasting (before we put anything and I mean anything in our mouths and swallow) or 2 hours after we have eaten (tells them how we cope with the sugar absorbed from what we have eaten.) People who just test anytime to see what their blood sugar is are wasting a valuable test strip for sure. Next month, medications and treatments. Chew well my friends.

VETERAN'S CORNER

ecently I have been asked by many in the park why the Veterans in the park are so upset because the owner of Lincolnshire decided that we could no longer fly the POW/MIA Flag at the pool. I guess to answer that question I would have to give you a brief history of the POW flag and why it is so special to our Veterans here in the park and across the USA.

The POW/MIA flag was created for the National League of Families of American Prisoners and Missing in Southeast Asia and officially recognized by the United States Congress in conjunction with the Vietnam War POW/MIA issue, "as the symbol of our Nation's concern and commitment to resolving as fully as possible the fates of Americans still prisoner, missing and unaccounted for in Southeast Asia, thus ending the uncertainty for their families and the Nation."

The original design for the flag was created by Newt Heisley in 1972. The National League of Families then-national coordinator, Evelyn Grubb, wife of a POW, oversaw its development and also campaigned to gain its widespread acceptance and use by the United States government and also local governments and civilian organizations across the United States.

In 1971, while the Vietnam War was still being fought, Mary Helen Hoff, the wife of a service member missing in action and member of the National League of Families of American Prisoners and Missing in Southeast Asia, recognized the need for a reference symbol about U.S. POW/MIAs, some of whom had been held in captivity for as many as seven years.

The flag is black, and bears in the center, in black and white, the emblem of the league. The emblem was designed by Newton F. Heisley, and features a white disk bearing in black silhouette the bust of a man (Jeffery Heisley), watch tower with a guard on patrol, and a strand of barbed wire; above the disk are the white letters POW and MIA framing a white 5-pointed star; below the disk is a black and white wreath above the white motto: "You are not Forgotten." The POW/MIA was flown over the White House for the first time in September 1982. The flag has been altered many times; the colors have been switched from black with white – to red, white and blue – to white with black; the POW/MIA has at times been revised to MIA/POW.

On March 9, 1989, a league flag that had flown over the White House on the 1988 National POW/MIA Recognition Day was installed in the U.S. Capitol rotunda as a result of legislation passed by the 100th Congress. The league's POW-MIA flag is the only flag ever displayed in the rotunda, and the only one other than the Flag of the United States to have flown over the White House. The leadership of both houses of Congress hosted the installation ceremony in a demonstration of bipartisan congressional support.

On August 10, 1990, the 101st Congress passed U.S. Public Law 101-355, recognizing the National League of Families POW/MIA flag and designating it "as a symbol of our Nation's concern and commitment to resolving as fully as possible the fates of Americans still prisoner, missing and unaccounted for in Southeast Asia, thus ending the uncertainty for their families and the Nation." Beyond Southeast Asia, it has been a symbol for POW/MIAs from all U.S. wars.

On November 7, 2019, the National POW/MIA Flag Act was signed into law, requiring the POW/MIA flag to be flown on certain federal properties, including the US Capitol Building, on all days the flag of the United States is flown. Previously, the flag was only flown on Armed Forces Day, Memorial Day, Flag Day, Independence Day, National POW/MIA Recognition Day, and Veterans Day.

This is why the POW/MIA flag means so much to us Veterans as it represents our Family Members and Fellow Veterans that got left behind and are unaccounted for. To us it is a symbol and a reminder that we as Veterans will never forget.

I have been told that people think the owner must be unpatriotic but have also been told he said that none of his other parks fly two flags so he told the managers to take it down. Several years ago while sitting as a board member on the HOA representing the park on a discussion on rent increases I presented the owner with a power point slide of all his parks in Fl and the amenities that they have vs ours and showed him that we were the most expensive Lot rents of all his parks and paid for our water and sewer. His answer to me was that we pay the most because we are his flagship park. So, I challenge Mr. Rickert since we are your so-called Flagship Park and thus, we have the Honor of paying the highest Lot Fees and other fees of all your parks. Then do the patriot and right thing and let us fly our POW/MIA Flag as we have been doing here for the last several years. It would mean a lot to your Veterans that live here in Lincolnshire. For those of you who asked I hope this answers your question.
