

Did you know??

The power to control "Elder Abuse" is in everyone's hands. You can go on line to the Department of Florida Elder Affairs at http://elderaffairs.state.fl.us to obtain information on their services and activities. The common definition of an Elder is anyone over 65.

There are two (3) specific areas for concern. They are <u>Abuse</u>, <u>Exploitation and Neglect (self or secondary)</u>. The Department defines <u>Abuse</u> as: "those actions that include inducing fear, anxiety, agitation, anger and many other psychological conditions in older people". In short, the Department of Elder Affairs states: "No one has the right to hit you, treat you like a child or humiliate you" and "No one has the right to take your money or to hurt you". The Department defines Exploitation as: "A broad range of conduct, from <u>Deception</u> to <u>Intimidation</u>". <u>Bullying elders is a form of intimidation</u>. <u>Neglect</u> is being deprived of the basics in human living like a clean and safe home, good food and being part of a social community including family and friends. Self-neglect is essentially harming oneself by denying the basics of the above to yourself. Isolation is a tragic outcome. Secondary neglect is where those responsible for a person's care deny the essentials of being safe and secure. Neglect can be as close as next door.

The Department further defines Emotional or Psychological Abuse as <u>verbal berating</u>, <u>harassment</u>, <u>intimidation</u>, <u>threats of punishment</u> or deprivation, criticism, <u>demeaning comments</u>, <u>coercive behavior</u> and isolation from family and friends.

If our internal voice says something is wrong then it usually is. Reporting is our responsibility as a member of a community, friend, and family member especially as a Good Samaritan.

Florida Law requires that any person who knows, or has reasonable cause to suspect, that a vulnerable adult has been or is being abused, neglected, or exploited shall immediately report such knowledge or suspicion to the Florida Abuse Hotline on the toll-free telephone number, 1-800-96-ABUSE (1-800-962-2873).


So I would like to make some suggestions to the people and their friends.

- **4.** When you go around us: give us at least 5 feet.





VETERAN'S CORNER

VA INFO

- 1. The VA now recognizes Hypothyroidism as a compensable side effect of Agent Orange.
- 2. Dozens of Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) workers rallied July 1 outside the Fayetteville VA Medical Center in Fayetteville, NC protesting a proposed overhaul of veterans' medical care. The Commission on Care, a panel created by Congress two years ago amid concern over long wait times for care at VA centers nationwide, is expected to recommend soon privatizing care for millions of veterans. The American Federation of Government Employees (AFGE) says the move would close 12 to 15 VA hospitals. The AFGE has organized similar protests recently at VA centers across the country. For more information, visit the AFGE website and read the Opinion Page in the New York Times.
- 3. The most comprehensive study yet made of veteran suicide concludes that on average 20 veterans a day are taking their own lives. The average daily tally is two less than the VA previously estimated, but is based on a more thorough review of Defense Department records, records from each state and data from the Centers for Disease Control, according to the Department of Veterans Affairs. "One veteran suicide is one too many, and this collaborative effort provides both updated and comprehensive data that allows us to make better informed decisions on how to prevent this national tragedy," said Dr. David J. Shulkin, VA Under Secretary for Health. "We as a nation must focus on bringing the number of veteran suicides to zero." For more details.

1. Fraud against TRICARE beneficiaries is in the news. Be safe; do not share your military ID or other personal or family information with an unknown person. Fraudsters often target TRICARE beneficiaries, including active duty service members. Examples include fake surveys used to collect personal information or offering gift cards to get your information. If you think you are the victim of TRICARE related fraud, you can report it to the Defense Health Agency. TRICARE usually does not contact you asking for personal information. Only provide that information to a trusted entity.




