

### **NUTRITION SPOT**















oday's topic is all about oils. Since heart disease is the leading cause of death in the USA, it's critical to keep the intake of saturated fat to 6-10% of total daily calories depending on one's risk of heart disease. The best way to do this is substitute unsaturated oils for saturated oils in cooking & other preparations of foods. The best oil for low saturation is canola oil. This oil is not only a fat low in saturated fats, it is the best for cooking. Canola oil, unlike some other cooking oils or fats has 93% of unsaturated fats. These fats are composed of an omega-3 and an omega-6 fat, "essential fats," as the body cannot make them on their own.

Canola oil comes from the crushed seeds of the canola plant which is a member of "Brassica" family that include broccoli, cabbage, and cauliflower. It was developed in Canada hence the name "can-ola" a contraction of "Canadian" and "ola" meaning oil. "Canola is often confused with rapeseed oil, but the 2 crops and their oils are distinctly different," says

Minnesota canola grower Rob Rynning.

Chefs consider canola oil a kitchen favorite for its neutral flavor, light texture and high heat tolerance (a smoke point of 468 degrees F) make it good for almost any foods cooked with it. Another plus for canola oil is the authorization of the FDA to allow a health claim on the label that "this oil has the ability to reduce the risk of heart disease when used in place of saturated fats".

So consider switching to canola oil in your day to day cooking to protect your heart, I have done this!
